## **Leader Conversation Guide**

### Main Idea:

**Faithfulness** is the steady, dependable character of God **formed in us** as we abide in Jesus. In a fickle culture, Spirit-produced faithfulness (trustworthy, reliable, dependable, loyal, constant) becomes living proof of the gospel and a powerful witness to others.

### **Make It Practical:**

- **Fruit, not force.** Faithfulness grows from **abiding**, not from rule-keeping (Gal 5).
- Acts vs. Fruit. The acts of the flesh exhaust; the fruit of the Spirit refresh (Gal 5:16–23).
- God's nature reflected. We are faithful because God is faithful (Lam 3:22–23).
- **Define it clearly:** trustworthy in public/private, reliable in commitments, dependable in actions, loyal in relationships, constant over time.
- Aim of our lives: to hear, "Well done, good and faithful servant" (Matt 25:21).
- Three simple truths:
  - 1. Faithfulness grows in relationship with Jesus (John 15:16).
  - **2. Faithfulness grows in a healthy garden**—planted in God's house and godly community (Ps 1:3).
  - **3. Faithfulness grows in small moments**—being faithful in little (Luke 16:10).

## **Key Scripture:**

Galatians 5:16–18 NIV — Walk by the Spirit... led by the Spirit, not under the law.

Galatians 5:22–23 NIV — "...the fruit of the Spirit is... faithfulness..."

**Colossians 1:10 NIV** — "...please him in every way: **bearing fruit**... growing in the knowledge of God."

Colossians 2:6–7 NIV — "...continue to live your lives in him... strengthened in the faith..."

**Lamentations 3:22–23 NIV** — "Great is your **faithfulness**."

Matthew 25:21 NIV — "Well done, good and faithful servant..."

**John 15:16 NIV** — Chosen and appointed to **bear fruit that will last**.

**Psalm 1:3 NIV** — Planted... **yields its fruit** in season.

Luke 16:10 ESV — "One who is faithful in a very little is also faithful in much."

## **Talk About It:**

- 1. Where do you most **feel the tension** between flesh-impulses and Spirit-led faithfulness right now (home, work, private life)?
- 2. Of the five descriptors—trustworthy, reliable, dependable, loyal, constant—which one is the Spirit highlighting for growth? Why?
- 3. **Relationship with Jesus:** What is one daily abiding practice you will guard this week (Word, worship, prayer, obedience, generosity, serving)?
- 4. **Healthy garden:** Who are the **faithful people** you're planted with (church membership, small group, serve team)? What "planting" step is next for you?
- 5. **Small moments:** Identify three "little things" (punctuality, follow-through, unseen tasks, clean communication) where you can practice faithfulness starting today.
- 6. How might consistent faithfulness in your lane become a **witness** to someone far from God? Share a name and a plan to bless/serve them this week.
- 7. What would "**Well done**" look like in your current season by next month? Name one measurable commitment and a teammate to keep you accountable.

# **Prayer:**

Father, thank You that **great is Your faithfulness**. Holy Spirit, as we abide in Jesus, **form faithfulness in us**—make us trustworthy, reliable, dependable, loyal, and constant. Strengthen us to be faithful in the **small things**, planted in Your house, so our lives bear **fruit that lasts** and point people to You. In Jesus' name, amen.

# **Leader Tips:**

- **Frame the win:** "This week we're not trying to *do more*; we're learning to **abide** so faithfulness **grows**."
- **Model vulnerability:** Share a recent "small moment" where you chose faithfulness (or missed it) and what you learned.
- Make it sticky: Have everyone write one sentence: "By next Sunday I will be faithful in \_\_\_\_\_." Collect and text gentle midweek reminders.
- **Celebrate quiet heroes:** Call out unseen faithfulness in your group (setup, follow-up texts, arriving early, praying consistently).
- Close with commissioning: Lay hands (same-gender clusters) and pray John 15:16 over each person: fruit that will last.
