THE DEDICATION

NEHEMIAH 12:27-47 | PASTOR CHUCK KLEINHESSELINK

Dedication and Celebration -

"At the dedication of the wall of Jerusalem, the Levites were sought out from where they lived and were brought to Jerusalem to celebrate joyfully the dedication with songs of thanksgiving and with the music of symbols, harps, and lyres" (v.27).

The Choir Sang -

"I had the leaders of Judah go on top of the wall. I also assigned two large choirs to give thanks" (v. 31).

Great Rejoicing -

"And on that day they offered great sacrifices, rejoicing because God had given them great joy. The women and children also rejoiced. The sound of rejoicing in Jerusalem could be heard far away" (v. 43).

Temple Service -

"At that time men were appointed to be in charge of the storerooms for the contributions, firstfruits, and tithes" (v. 44).

Discussion Questions:

1. The people of Jerusalem and surrounding area were called to join in the festivities. What was the source of their excitement?
2. We read that the "sound of rejoicing in Jerusalem could be heard far away." What kind of reaction could this have evoked on those who opposed the building of the wall?
3. After the dedication, there was plenty of work to do. Men were appointed to oversee storeroom contributions, firstfruits, and tithes. Today, in God's House, it takes more than a few people to accomplish the work that needs to be done. Take the opportunity this week to thank the many individuals at FRC who faithfully work to ensure that God's priorities in church are being accomplished.
