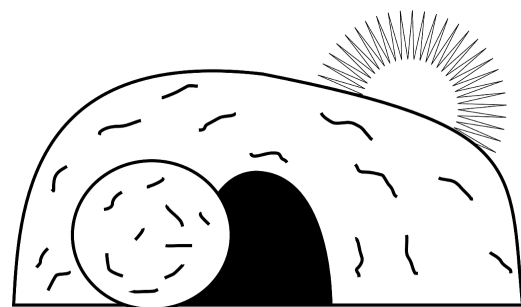

Why Do We Celebrate EASTER?

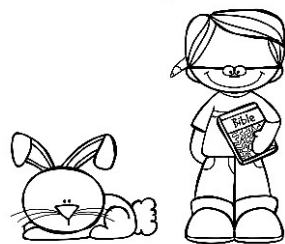
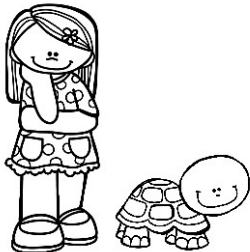
Easter is a special holiday that we celebrate to remember that Jesus Christ, the Son of God, came to save us from our sins.

Two men believed in Jesus, even when He was dying.

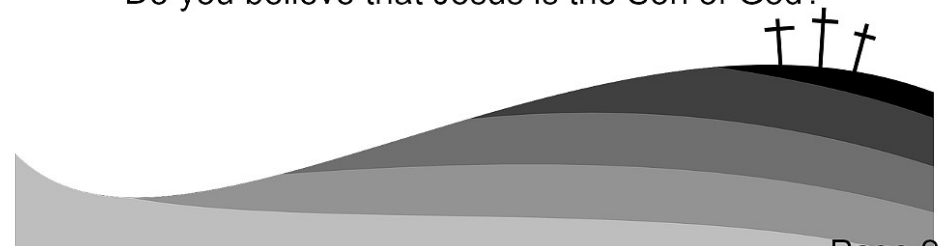
Read Luke 23:33-47

Do you believe that Jesus is the Son of God?



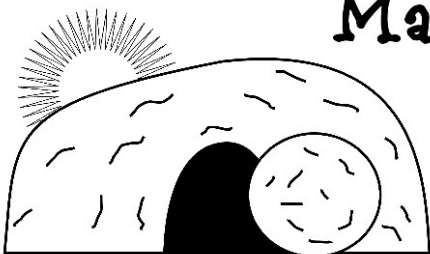
Now after the Sabbath, toward the **dawn** of the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to see the **tomb**.
