



RECOVERY FROM HARDSHIP





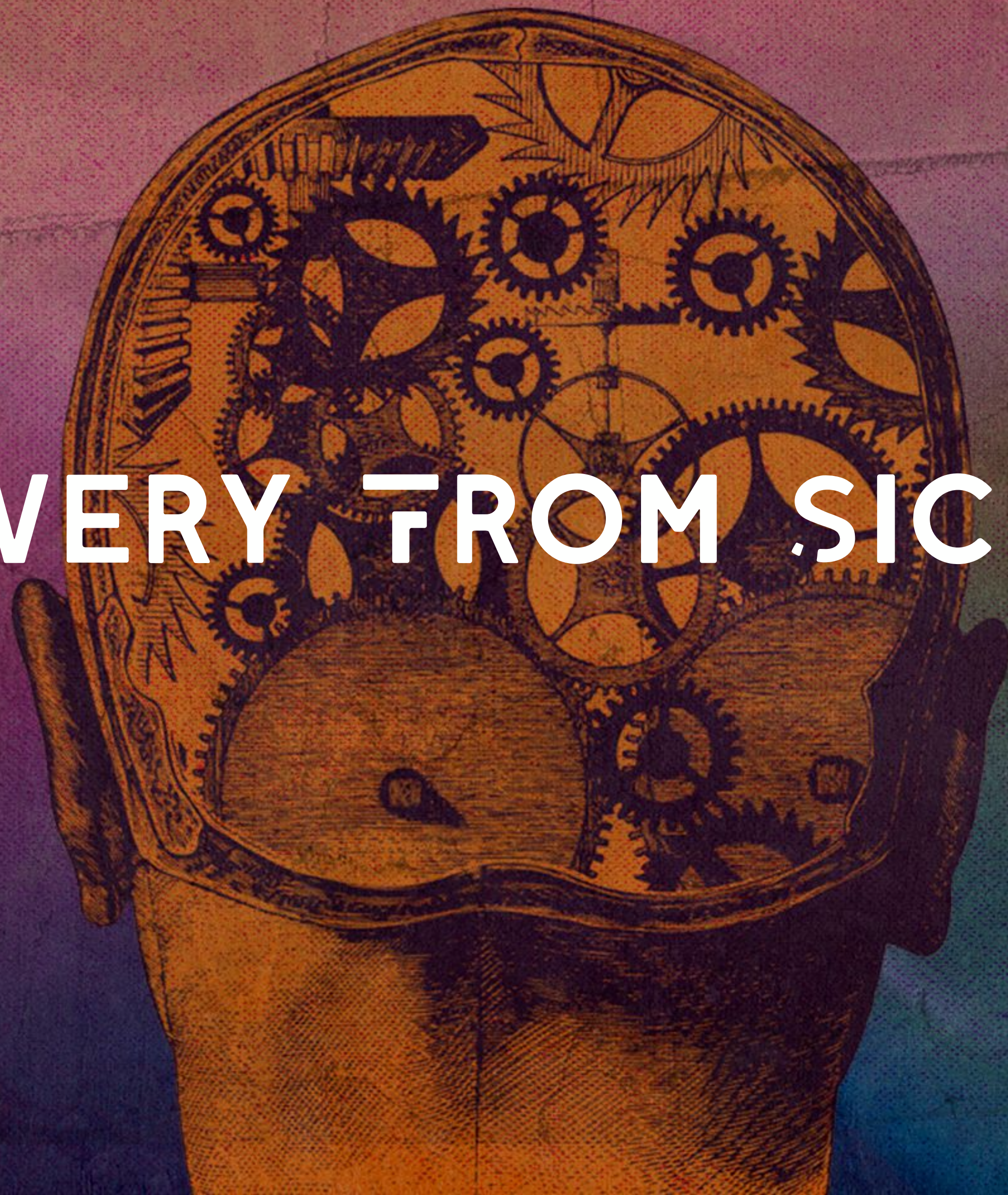



RECOVERY FROM SICKNESS





RECOVERY FROM EMPTINESS

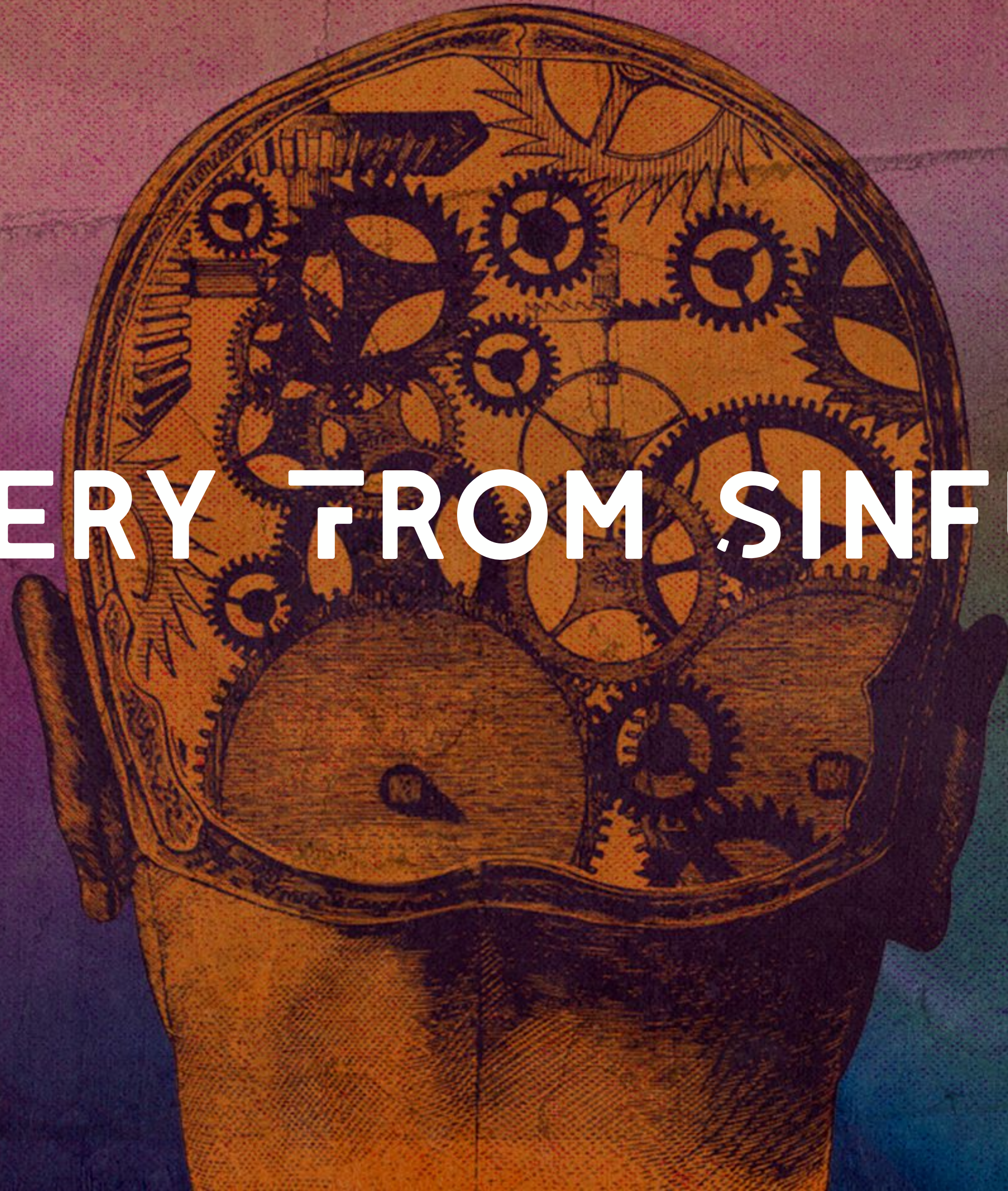
