**We walk by faith,
not by sight.**



What does this Scripture mean?

- 1. There are many people and things that try to make us follow them by how big and flashy they are.**
- 2. As Christians, we are not supposed to put all our trust in what people tell us and show us, because they can be lying to us!**
- 3. Instead, we put our faith in Jesus who, because He went back into heaven, we can't see right now!**
- 4. Even though we have not seen Him with our eyes or touched Him with our hands, we can believe in Jesus and live for Him!**

Remember: Even when we struggle with our faith, we can take comfort in the scriptures – the full witness of Jesus on Earth!



How To Follow Jesus Well

When we read the Bible, we learn what God wants us to do!

When things seem to be going wrong, remember that the God of all creation is guiding your steps!

Don't be distracted by what people around you are doing. Follow Jesus!



CROSS CONNECTION

Jesus' death on the cross and resurrection from the dead wasn't a mystical story or myth – it was an actual historical event that was seen, written down, and shared with us over time! Even though we were not there two-thousand years ago, God has given us a reliable record of what Jesus did for us!
