[13] **waiting** for our blessed hope, the **appearing of the glory** of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,

- This in-between time is characterized by actively waiting for Christ's return.
- Our salvation is complete when Christ returns.

1 Corinthians 13:12

For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I have been fully known.

Because of Who Jesus Is

[14] who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to *purify for himself* a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works.

John 8:10-11

Jesus stood up and said to her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?" [11] She said, "No one, Lord." And Jesus said, "Neither do I condemn you; go, and from now on sin no more."

Christ's blood was shed to save us *from* our sins *for* Him, not *for* our sins *from* Him.
