The Doctrine of the Holy Trinity:

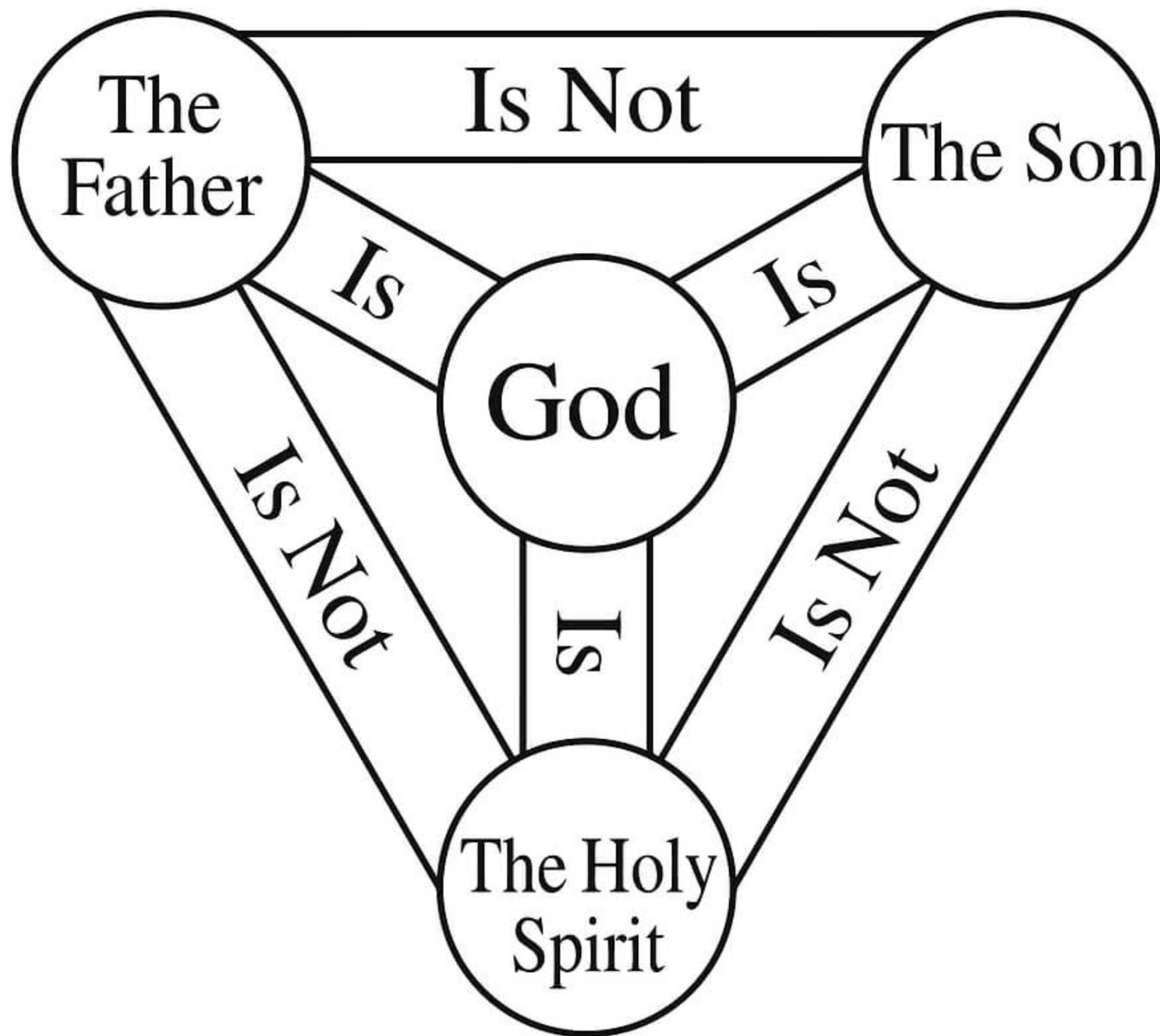
There is one God, who is Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

The Holy Trinity

Definition

There is one God who eternally exists as three distinct Persons - the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Each one is God, yet each is Unique and distinct from the others.





The Holy Trinity

God the Father

God the Father's Role:

Authority over all things, the one we pray to, the sender/planner.

God the Father is God:

Isaiah 44:6, Malachi 3:6

God the Father is Unique:

Matthew 11:27, John 14:26



The Holy Trinity

God the Son

God the Son's Role: The Word made flesh, Savior, mediator between God and humanity.

God the Son is God: John 1:1, Colossians 2:9

God the Son is Unique: Luke 22:42, John 15:26



The Holy Trinity

God the Holy Spirit

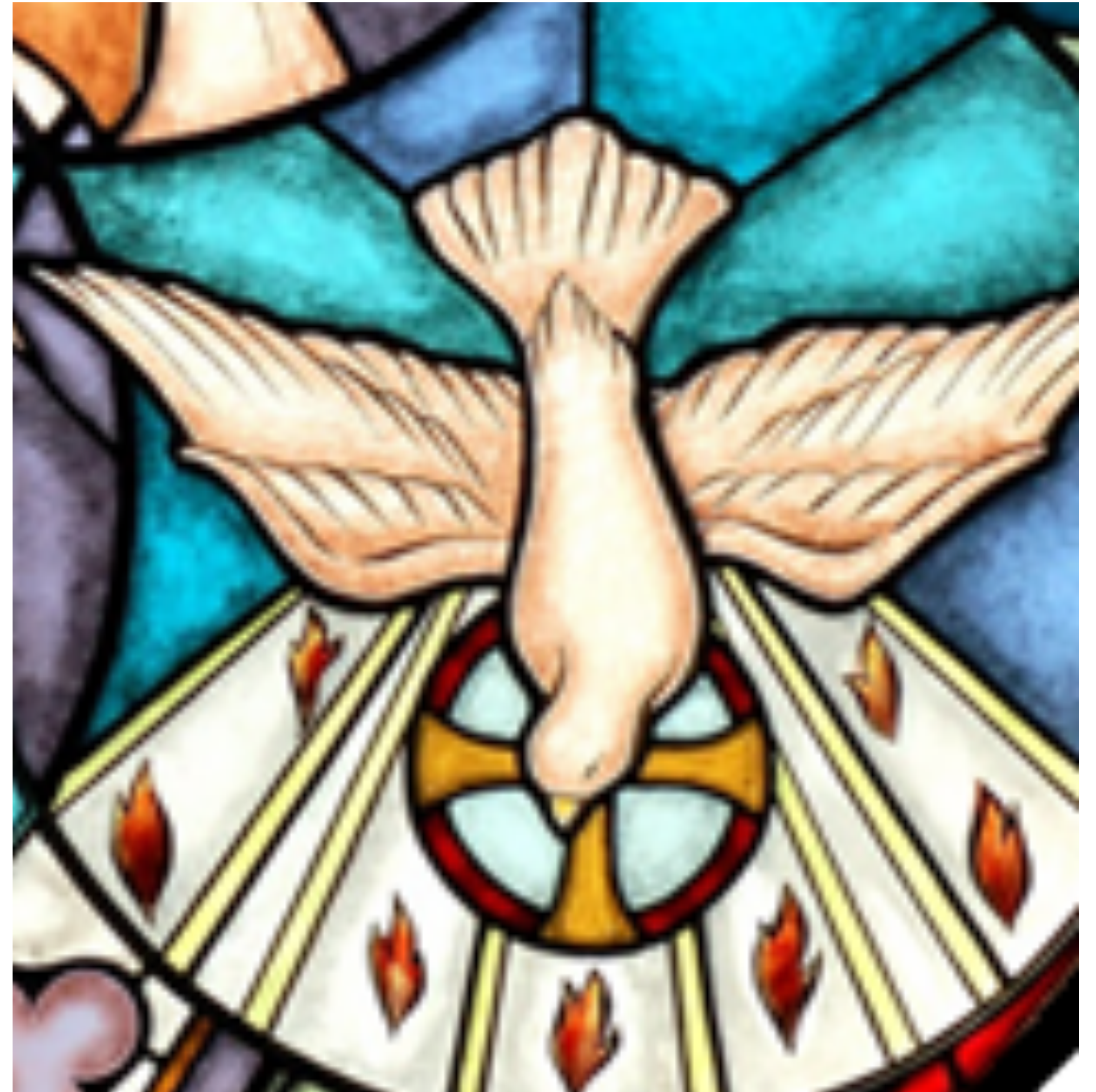
God the Spirit's Role:

Comforter, teacher, the one who lives within us, convicts us of sin.

God the Spirit is God: Acts 5:3-4, 1 Corinthians 2:10-11

God the Spirit is Unique:

John 16:13-14, John 14:26



Why Does the “Holy Trinity” Matter?

- 1. God died for you:** If Jesus is God, it means God didn't send someone else to die in His place, but suffered himself.
- 2. God is always with you:** If the Holy Spirit is God, it means God doesn't stand watching us but dwells within believers.
- 3. God creates out of love:** If God is three distinct persons, it means God didn't create us because He was lonely but because the Trinity overflowed with love!
- 4. God doesn't need you, but wants you.** God already has perfect relationship within the Trinity, but chooses to invite you in.
- 5. The Trinity shows us what a perfect relationship looks like:** Mutual Love, Honor, and unity without losing uniqueness.
