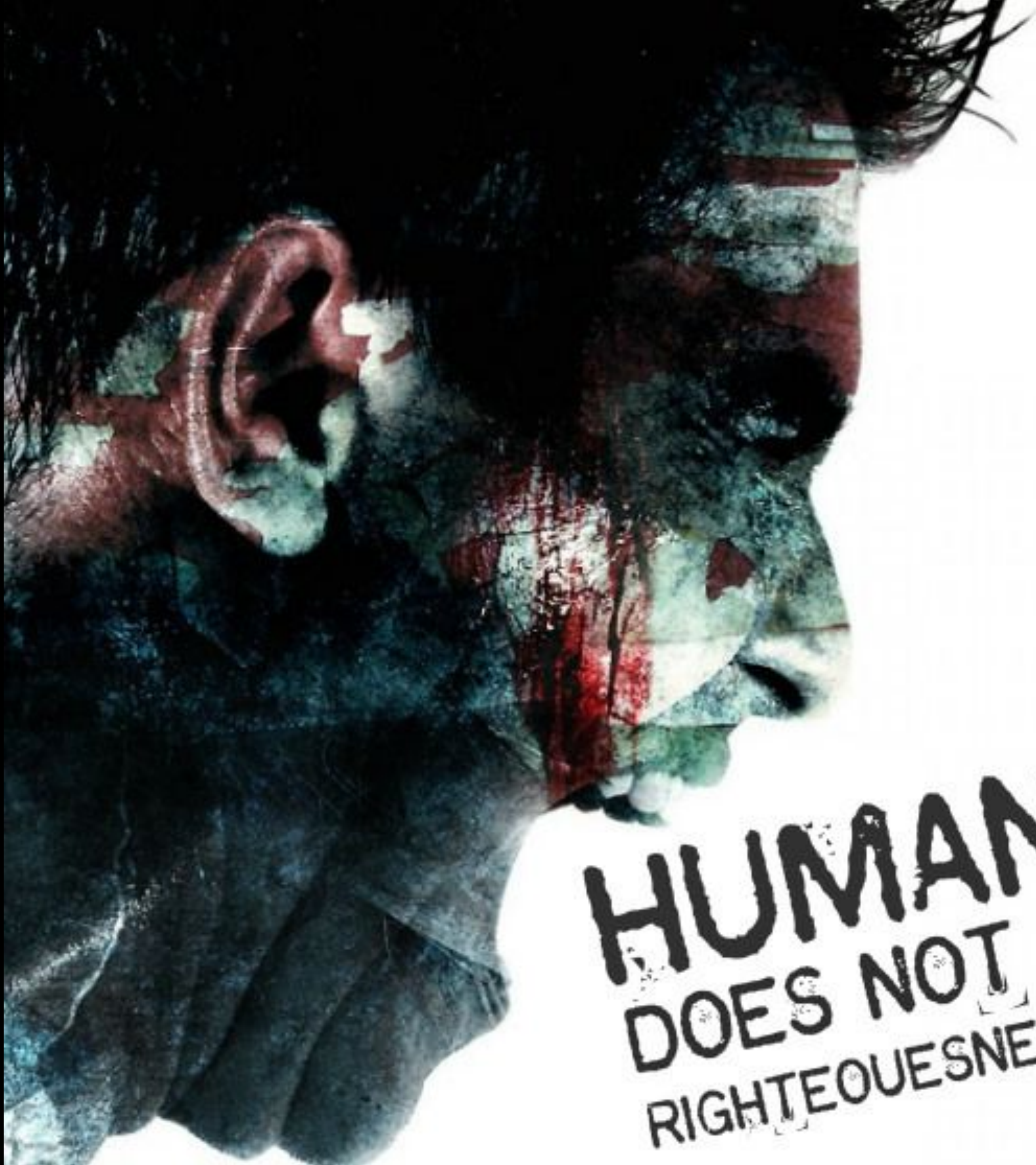
**Genesis 49:5 Simeon and Levi are brothers;

**Genesis 49:8 “Judah, your brothers shall
praise you;
your hand shall be on the neck of your
enemies;
your father’s sons shall bow down before
you.**

**9 Judah is a lion’s cub;
from the prey, my son, you have gone up.
He stooped down; he crouched as a lion
and as a lioness; who dares rouse him?**

**49:10 The scepter shall not depart from Judah,
nor the ruler's staff from between his feet,
until tribute comes to him;
and to him shall be the obedience of the peoples.**

**11 Binding his foal to the vine
and his donkey's colt to the choice vine,
he has washed his garments in wine
and his vesture in the blood of grapes.**

**12 His eyes are darker than wine,
and his teeth whiter than milk.**

JUDAH = PRAISE

- 1. God was praised for him. 29:35 *And she (Leah) conceived again and bore a son, and said, “This time I will praise the LORD.” Therefore she called his name Judah.***
- 2. God was praised by him. 38:26 *Then Judah identified them and said, “She is more righteous than I, since I did not give her to my son Shelah.” And he did not know her again.***
- 3. God was praised in him. 44:33 *Now therefore, please let your servant remain instead of the boy as a servant to my lord, and let the boy go back with his brothers.***
