What does this Scripture mean?

- 1. When you accept Jesus as your Savior, you also accept Him as your Lord, which means the person who rules us!**
- 2. Because Jesus is our Lord, we are called to make sure everything we do – big and small – we do for Jesus.**
- 3. This might cause us to not do things we want to do. It also might cause us to do things we might not want to do!**
- 4. No matter what we are doing, if we are doing it for Jesus, give thanks to God the Father for saving and leading you through Jesus!**

Remember: Jesus can either be our Savior and Lord, or neither, so follow Him every day of your life!



How To Follow Jesus Well

**Even when times are tough,
remember to thank God the
Father for giving you an
eternal home in Jesus!**

**The only place we can find
what Jesus commands us to
do is in the Bible, so read it!**

**When you make a mistake,
don't get scared that the
Father will punish you – ask
Him for forgiveness and He
will forgive you!**



CROSS CONNECTION

**When Jesus died on
the cross and came
back to life three days
later, God the Father
announced that Jesus
is now the Lord over
all creation. With His
blood, Jesus bought
all things from the
devil back to Himself!**
