

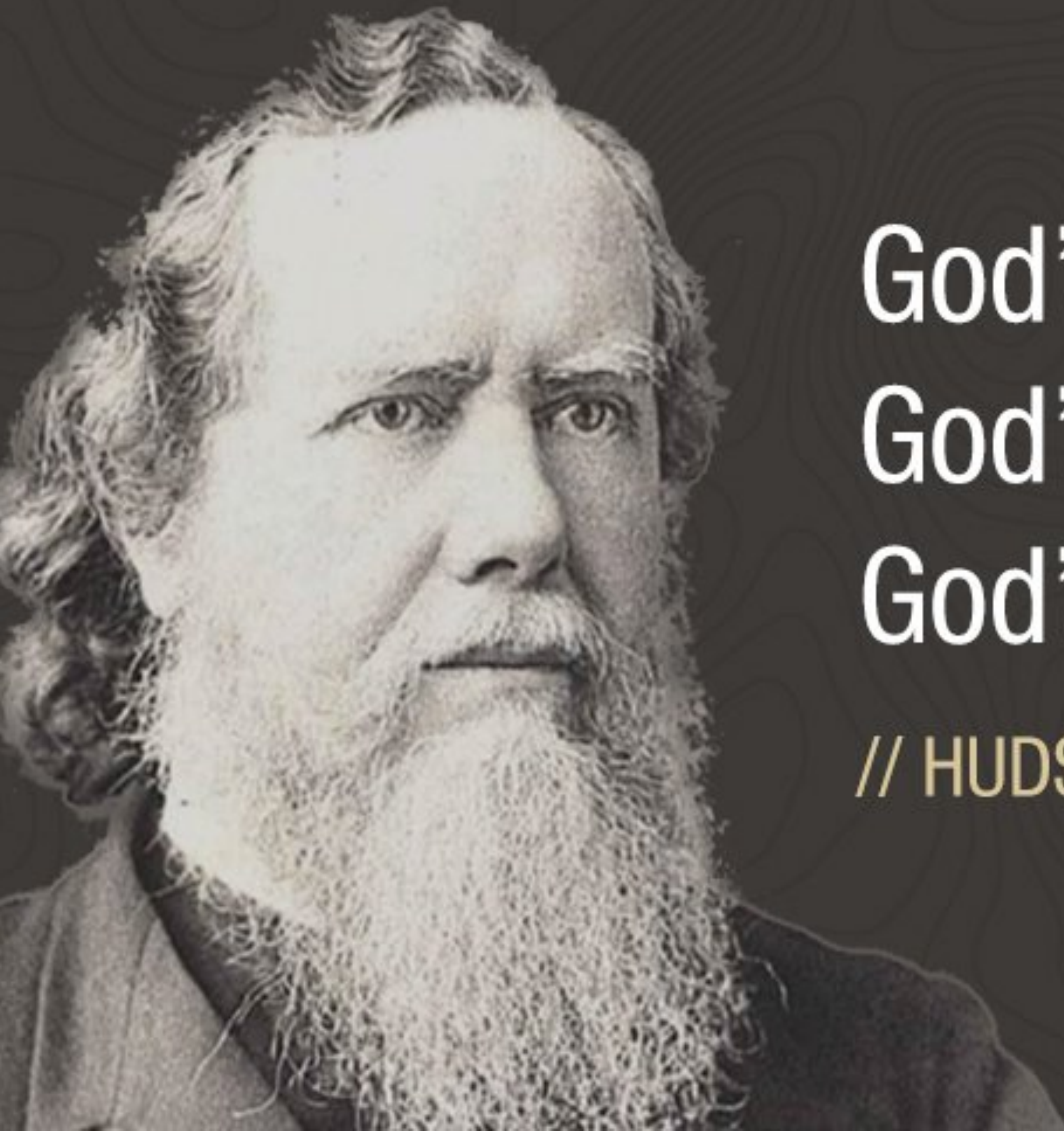

The heart of man resembles a field in which he sows, by the mere exercise of his will, a future harvest of good or evil.

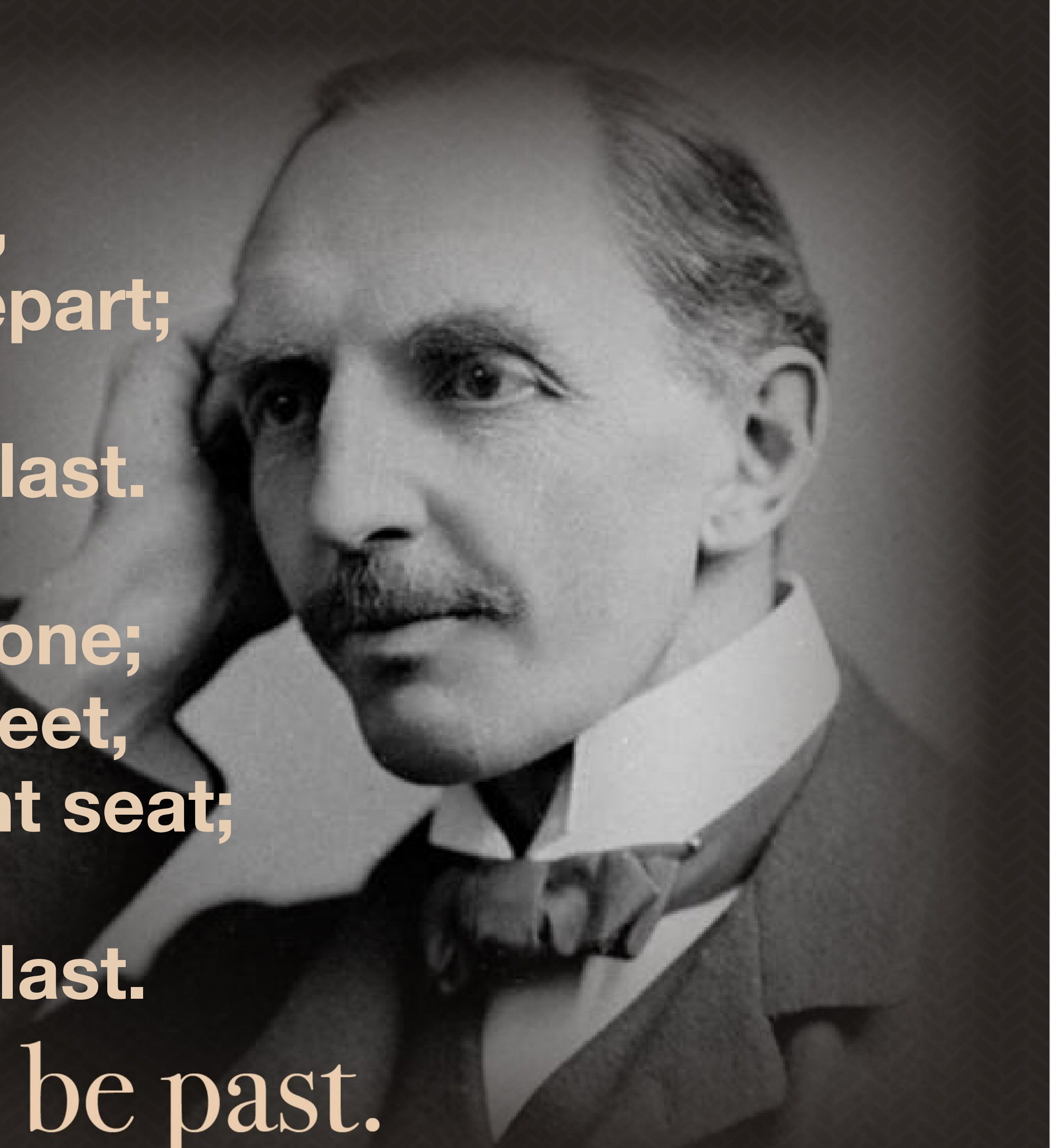
1. Two little lines I heard one day,

Only what's done for Christ will last.





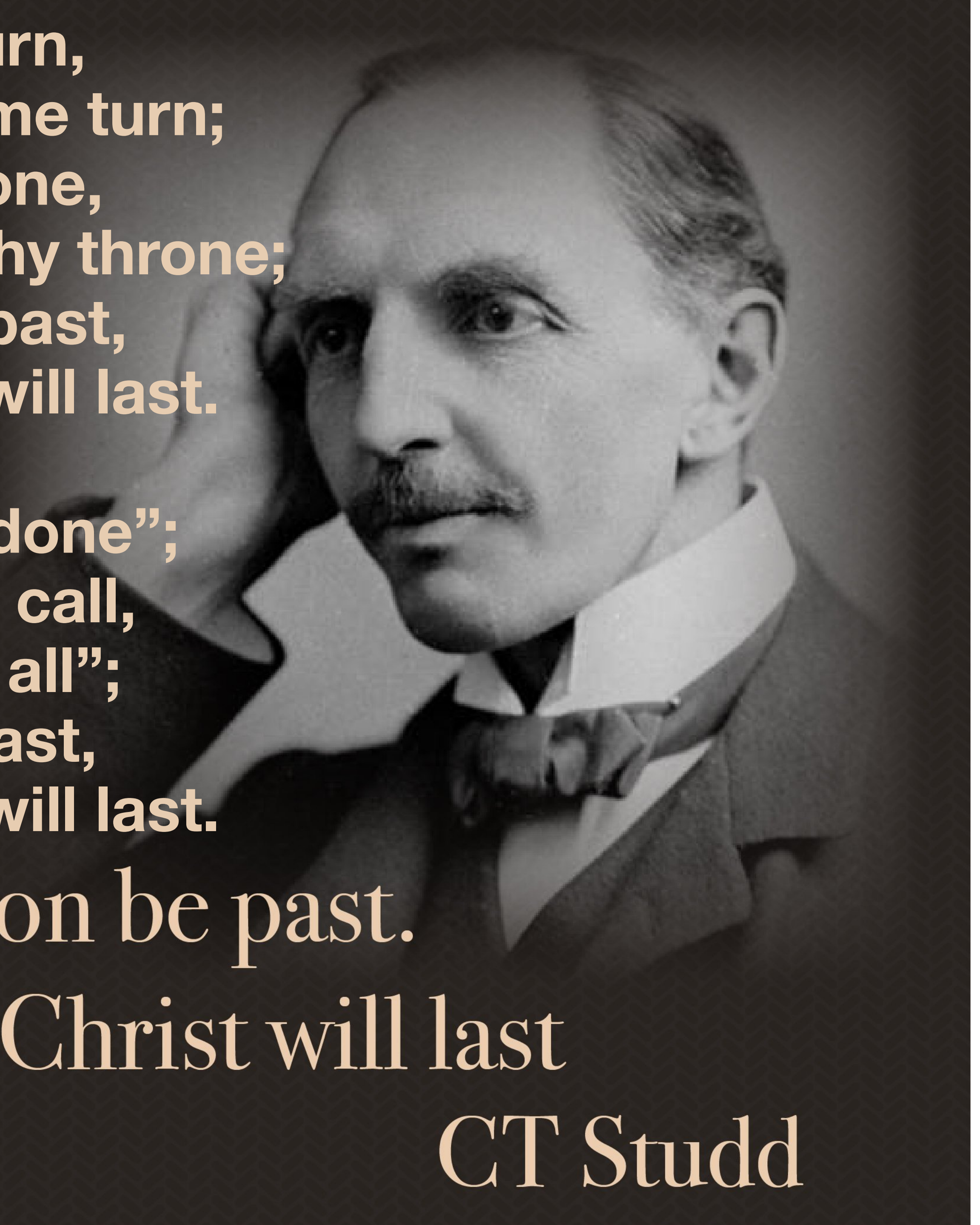
