What does this Scripture mean?

- 1. When we enter into a covenantal relationship with Jesus Christ, who we once were – our sins, our mistakes, our wrong desires – are put to death with Jesus on the cross!**
- 2. Now, when The Father looks at us, He sees not our mistakes and sins, but Jesus Christ's perfect life!**
- 3. Of course, we are still literally living, but this just means that we are no longer to live the life we want, but the life that Christ shows us to live!**


Remember: Jesus didn't just die for us to go to heaven – He died for us to live for the Kingdom of Heaven now!

CROSS CONNECTION

When Jesus died on the cross, He took on Himself the sins of all who call upon His name. However, He didn't just take our sins, but gave us His righteousness, which means His goodness before The Father. His death not only forgave us, it made us good!
