We should understand where we are and where we're going, and must meet people where they are.

CHOSE - EKLEGOMAI to select or choose for oneself

Salvation has always been about God's initiative, not human achievement.

Paul was showing that God has been actively involved in human history, preparing the way for something greater.

The connection between David and Jesus isn't coincidental; it's covenantal.



John the Baptist was a bridge between the old covenant and the new, the last of the Old Testament prophets and the first to point directly to Jesus.

SALVATION - SOTERIA

deliverance, preservation, safety

Paul boldly declares that the residents of Jerusalem and their rulers didn't recognize Jesus or understand the prophetic voices read every Sabbath.



Jesus didn't merely come back to life to die again later like Lazarus. He conquered death itself, rising with a glorified body that would never see decay.

The transformation of these witnesses from cowering disciples to bold proclaimers is itself evidence of the resurrection's reality.

CORRUPTION - DIAPHTHORA

decay or decomposition

Paul argues that David couldn't have been talking about himself because David died, was buried, and his body decayed.

The Bible isn't a collection of disconnected religious writings; it's one unified story of redemption with Jesus Christ as its central figure.
