THE FLAME AND THE SWORD: GOD'S SPIRIT AND WORD “IN SPIRIT AND IN TRUTH” SUPPORTING SCRIPTURES

John 14:6 AMPC Jesus said to him, I am the Way and the Truth and the Life; no one comes to the Father except by (through) Me.

John 1:1-3 (NIV)

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. **Through Him all things were made, and without Him nothing was made that has been made.**

Genesis 1:2 (NIV)

Now the earth was formless and void, and darkness was over the [face] surface of the deep. And the *Spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters.*

1 Corinthians 2:10-11

But God has revealed it to us by the Spirit. The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God. For who among men knows the thoughts of man except his own spirit within him? So too, no one knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God.

2 Corinthians 3:17 (NIV)

Now the Lord is the Spirit, and *where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.*

Galatians 5:25 (NIV)

Since we live by the Spirit, let us walk in step with the Spirit.

Ephesians 2:18 (NIV)

For through Him we both have access to the Father by one Spirit.

Philippians 3:3 (NIV)

For it is we who are the circumcision, we who worship **by the Spirit of God**, who glory in Christ Jesus, and who put no confidence in the flesh—

Hebrews 12:9 (NIV)

Furthermore, we have all had earthly fathers who disciplined us, and we respected them. Should we not much more **submit to the Father of our spirits and live?**

Romans 8:9 (NLT)

You, however, are controlled not by the flesh, but **by the Spirit**, if the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Christ.

1 Samuel 16:7 (NIV)

But the LORD said to Samuel, “Do not consider his appearance or height, for I have rejected him; the LORD does not see as man does. For man sees the outward appearance, **but the LORD sees the heart.**”

1 John 1:5 (NIV)

And this is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you: God is light, and in Him there is no darkness at all.

1 John 4:8 (NIV)

Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love.

LUKE 17:20 (Berean Standard Bible) When asked by the Pharisees **when the kingdom of God would come**, Jesus replied, “**The kingdom of God will not come with observable signs.** 21 Nor will people say, ‘Look, here it is,’ or ‘There it is.’ For you see, the kingdom of God is in your midst.” 22 Then He said to the disciples, “The time is coming when you will long to see one of the days of the Son of Man, but you will not see it....

Matthew 3:2 (NIV) ...and saying, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven **is** near.”

Matthew 6:10 (NIV) Your kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

Romans 14:17 (NIV) For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of **righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit.**

Romans 10:8-10 (NIV): “The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart: that is, **the word of faith**, which we preach: because if thou shalt confess with thy mouth Jesus as Lord, and shalt believe in thy heart that God raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.”

Jeremiah 1:9: Then the LORD put forth his hand, and touched my mouth. And the LORD said unto me, **Behold, I have put my words in thy mouth.**

Matthew 15:11 (AMPC) It is not what goes into the mouth of a man that makes him unclean and defiled, but what comes out of the mouth; this makes a man unclean and defiles [him].

Exodus 3:14 (NIV) God said to Moses, “**I AM WHO I AM**. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: ‘I AM has sent me to you.’”

Luke 17:21: “the kingdom of God is within you” or “in your midst;”

(in AMPC: Nor will people say, Look! Here [it is]! or, See, [it is] there! For behold, the kingdom of God is within you [in your hearts] and among you [surrounding you].)

Proverbs 20:12 The hearing ear, and the seeing eye, the LORD hath made even both of them.

Matthew 13:16 Blessed are your eyes, for they see, and your ears, for they hear.

Matthew 13:9 AMPC: He who has ears [to hear], let him be listening and let him consider and perceive and comprehend by hearing.

Acts 28:27: For the heart of this people is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes have they closed; lest they should see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them. (Also in Isaiah 6:10)

Matthew 11:15: He that hath ears to hear, let him hear.

Revelation (7 times): Each letter to the churches ends with “He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.” (**Revelation 2:7 (the overcomers)**, 11, 17, 29; 3:6, 13, 22).

Deuteronomy 6:4

Hear, O Israel: the Lord our God is one Lord [the only Lord]. [Notes: This well-known declaration states who God is—he alone is ADONAI and he alone is God.]

Revelation 22:6 (NIV)

Then the angel said to me, “**These words are faithful and true.*** The Lord, the God of the spirits of the prophets, has sent His angel to show His servants what must soon take place.”

Rev 19:11 (AMPC) After that I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse [appeared]! **The One Who** was riding it **is called Faithful** (Trustworthy, Loyal, Incorruptible, Steady) **and True**, and He passes judgment and wages war in righteousness (holiness, justice, and uprightness).
