

Well- placed shame:

- **Objective**
 - **My sin that should lead me to repentance**
 - **Result of dishonoring God**
 - 1 Cor 15:34
 - **Right and appropriate response to sin**
- **God will lovingly bring us this type of shame**
 - **To honor His holiness**
 - **To bring us to repentance & relationship**
 - Luke 7:36-50
- **The solution is Faith**
 - **The Cross is the objective solution to objective shame**
 - Rom 10:11
 - **God has promised that He will forgive**
 - Prov 28:13
 - **God Has said He desires to be near us**

Misplaced shame:

- **Subjective experience –**
 - **measuring ourselves by a standard other than God's**
 - 2 Cor 12:9
 - **Someone else's sin's effect on us (suffering)**
 - **Acceptance is sought through pleasing others**
- **Where the Accuser loves to keep us**
 - **To separate us from God**
 - **To focus on oneself**
 - Luke 7:36-50
- **The Solution is Faith**
 - **Believing the promises of God**
 - **Believing God is who He says He is**
 - 2 Tim 1:12-14
 - **Believing we are who God says we are**
 - Rom 8:1
