***oikos*** *n*, extended household (Gr.)

1. the most natural and common environment for evangelism to occur
2. a group of eight to fifteen people with whom you share life most closely, your sphere of greatest influence
3. the people for whom God wants to prepare you to become an ideal instrument of His grace
4. a microcosm of the world at large, for whom God sent His Son--that all who place their faith in Christ would be delivered from the bondage of sin and enjoy life to the fullest

Church isn't a place to go; it's people you know

Church buildings aren't suppose to be landing strips; churches are suppose to be launch sites.

**TRUE OF FALSE**

**virtually 100% of the people in this country attend church— because church isn't a place they could go, it's people they already know!**

### **OIKISMS**

- **This is not about what you should do next. It's about what you should do period**
- **For two thousand years, the church has existed for only one reason—to change the world.**
- **Jesus didn't ask you to change the world. He only asked you to change yours!**
- **Lots of people hear what you say, but only your oikos knows if you own what you say!**
- **He will bring you a message through which you and all your household (oikos) will be saved. (Acts 11:14) The tactics that Jesus taught were simple —get saved and go home.**
- **We do not get to select our oikos. . . we simply identify the people God has already supernaturally and strategically placed in our lives.**
- **Who is in your world? Your Oikos?  
Make a list  
Pray for every one on the list every day  
Invest time and resources to develop those relationships.  
Invite them to church regularly.  
Prepare to clearly display God's character and defend your faith in**

**Christ.**
