Week of 2/27/22

Opener (10 minutes or less)

If you could write a book, what genre would you write it in? Mystery? Thriller? Romance? Historical fiction? Non-fiction?

DISCUSSION (50 minutes or less)

Begin your discussion time in prayer.

Scripture Reading: Romans 10:13-15

Questions:

- 1. What stands out to you from this passage? What stood out to you from the message this week?
- 2. When you think of all of us being called to share the good news of Jesus has God put a burden on your heart for someone, or somewhere?
- 3. Thinking of John's message and his examples: Is there someone you need to let go of, entrusting them to God and support His calling in their lives?

- 4. Have you had the opportunity to plant seeds and later see those seeds bear fruit?
- Share with the group the people in your life who have beautiful feet. Those people who shared Jesus with you and made an eternal impact.
- 6. Spend time in prayer thanking God for those people.

PERSONAL (30 minutes or less)

- 1. What is going on in your life (note prayer requests and praise reports)
- 2. Oikos the 8 to 15 people God supernaturally and strategically places in your life. <u>Any oikos moments you would like to share..</u>
- 3. Pray
