Why do you think people love John 3:16 so much?

Read John 3:1–21. Does reading the text in its context change how you understand John 3:16? In your own words, summarize the main message in one sentence.

Who could you share the bad and good news of John 3:16 with this week?

#### Read John 15:9-11

Do you believe God loves you? What makes you believe this on your best and worst days? According to John 3:16, in what way did God love the world? Do you feel loved by this day-to-day? Why or why not?

## John 3:22-36

How does John describe his role in the ministry of Jesus?

How does John's perspective protect him from jealousy and self-pity?

How does Jesus want to become greater in and through your life? Ask him for John's humility and joy as you become less and he becomes more.

Take some time to pray for one another and optionally close with the **John 3 prayer**.
