Compare the motivations for Christ going to the cross in Romans 3:25-26 and in 5:8.

Explain why the believer has assurance of salvation based on this passage. What does it mean to "rejoice in God"?

Look back over Romans 5:1-11 and consider all the blessings of justification by faith. Spend some time thanking God for this glorious salvation.
