

COMMUNITY GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE

Week of 9/21/25

Opener (10 minutes or less)

If you could magically add a new room to your house, what would it be and what would its purpose be?

DISCUSSION (50 minutes or less)

Begin your discussion time in prayer.

Scripture Reading: Revelation 3:14-22

Ouestions:

- Jesus introduces himself to the church in Laodicea as "the faithful and true witness," Why do you think Jesus chose these particular titles for Laodicia?
- 2. What does it mean for a church to be "lukewarm"?
- 3. How is their wealth a source of their spiritual deception? Where in our lives or culture do we see a similar disconnect between perceived success and spiritual reality?
- 4. Jesus counsels the church to "buy from me gold refined by fire, and white garments, and salve to anoint your eyes." What do these three symbolic items represent, and why are they the specific remedies for the church's poverty, nakedness, and blindness?
- 5. Jesus says, "Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline, so be zealous and repent." How does this statement reshape our understanding of divine love?
- 6. What does it mean for Jesus to be outside knocking? How does this image call for personal and corporate repentance?

PERSONAL (30 minutes or less)

- 1. Oikos the 8 to 15 people God supernaturally and strategically places in your life. Any oikos moments you would like to share..
- 2. What is going on in your life (note prayer requests and praise reports)
- 3. Pray

Revelation 3:14-22

14 "And to the angel of the church in Laodicea write: 'The words of the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of God's creation.

15 "I know your works: you are neither cold nor hot. Would that you were either cold or hot! 16 So, because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth. 17 For you say, "I am rich, I have prospered, and I need nothing," not realizing that you are wretched, pitiable, poor, blind, and naked. 18 I counsel you to buy from me gold refined by fire, so that you may be rich, and white garments so that you may clothe yourself and the shame of your nakedness may not be seen, and salve to anoint your eyes, so that you may see. 19 Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline, so be zealous and repent. 20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me. 21 The one who conquers, I will grant him to sit with me on my throne, as I also conquered and sat down with my Father on his throne. 22 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."
