Choose the ones that fit best for your group. Aim to spend the bulk of your time in the Get Spiritual and Get Practical sections.

GET TALKING: ICEBREAKERS

Was there anything in particular that stood out to you regarding the message tonight?

GET SPIRITUAL: DISCUSS THE TEXT

Paul’s aim was to know Christ. How do we know Christ in a present and continuous way?

How do believers experience the power of the resurrection (in part) during our life here and now?

As we look ahead to the finish line, like Paul, we press on to a final resurrection → physical, permanent, with unending peace, fullness of joy, and glory → how does the future resurrection give strength for believers to press on now, even in the midst of suffering?

GET PRACTICAL: APPLY THE TEXT

In verse 12 of chapter 3 Paul says although he has not yet already obtained the final resurrection he presses on, what do you think he means by press on?

If you know about Christ and do not yet know Christ, turn to Him now in repentance and faith, and you too will know Him and the power of His resurrection.

GET PRAYING: PRAY THE TEXT
