(Back to School)

a) Authority – we all live under authority

But I want you to know that the head of every man is Christ, the head of woman *is* man, and the head of Christ *is* God.

(1Co 11:3)

And the LORD will make you the head and not the tail; you shall be above only, and not be beneath, if you heed the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you today, and are careful to observe *them*.

(Deu 28:13)

Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God. Therefore whoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God, and those who resist will bring judgment on themselves.

(Rom 13:1-2)

- i) He is our authority
- ii) He has vested authority to institutions He has established
 - (1) Home
 - (2) Church
 - (3) Government
 - (4) Business
 - (5) Schools
- iii) PARENTS We have been given authority as God's agent over our children
 - (1) We must not direct them for our own convenience or agenda.
 - (2) We must direct them on God's behalf for their good, according to His will.
- b) Shepherding best description of the activity of the parent to a child
 - i) Not only shepherd the "what" of their child's actions, but also the "why"
 - ii) Must shepherd the child's thoughts, and teach them to learn discernment and wisdom

Parenting Defined – it's not all about discipline (teachable moments)

- i) Deu 6:1-7 "Now this *is* the commandment, *and these are* the statutes and judgments which the LORD your God has commanded to teach you, that you may observe *them* in the land which you are crossing over to possess, (2) that you may fear the LORD your God, to keep all His statutes and His commandments which I command you, you and your son and your grandson, all the days of your life, and that your days may be prolonged. (3) Therefore hear, O Israel, and be careful to observe *it*, that it may be well with you, and that you may multiply greatly as the LORD God of your fathers has promised you—'a land flowing with milk and honey.' (4) "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD *is* one! (5) You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. (6) "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. (7) You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.
- (1) Children must be made to understand life, themselves, and their own needs **from a** biblical perspective.

Bro Scott – "You have to read the bible for yourself."

(KJV) Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

(NKJV) Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

Be a Berean (Acts 17:10-12)

- Study
- Fast
- Praise
- Worship

- Hear the Lord
- Discern between truth and error
- Forgive
- Love

Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. (Col 3:2)

Introduce them to the spiritual realities of life and spiritual disciplines. You are the vigilant watchmen, the overseers, their covering of protection, their teacher, their guide, their law-giver...

Therefore the law was our tutor *to bring us* to Christ, that we might be justified by faith. (Gal 3:24)

My son, hear the instruction of your father, And do not forsake the law of your mother; For they *will be* a graceful ornament on your head, And chains about your neck. (Pro 1:8-9)

Hear, *my* children, the instruction of a father, And give attention to know understanding; For I give you good doctrine: Do not forsake my law. When I was my father's son, Tender and the only one in the sight of my mother, He also taught me, and said to me: "Let your heart retain my words; Keep my commands, and live. Get wisdom! Get understanding! Do not forget, nor turn away from the words of my mouth. Do not forsake her, and she will preserve you; Love her, and she will keep you. Wisdom *is* the principal thing; *Therefore* get wisdom. And in all your getting, get understanding. Exalt her, and she will promote you; She will bring you honor, when you embrace her. She will place on your head an ornament of grace; A crown of glory she will deliver to you." Hear, my son, and receive my sayings, And the years of your life will be many. I have taught you in the way of wisdom; I have led you in right paths. When you walk, your steps will not be hindered, And when you run, you will not stumble. Take firm hold of instruction, do not let go; Keep her, for she *is* your life.

(Pro 4:1-13)

Who *is* wise and understanding among you? Let him show by good conduct *that* his works *are done* in the meekness of wisdom. But if you have bitter envy and self-seeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth. This wisdom does not descend from above, but *is* earthly, sensual, demonic. For where envy and self-seeking *exist*, confusion and every evil thing *are* there. But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.

(Jas 3:13-17)

My son, keep your father's command, And do not forsake the law of your mother. Bind them continually upon your heart; Tie them around your neck. When you roam, they will lead you; When you sleep, they will keep you; And *when* you awake, they will speak with you.

(Pro 6:20-22)

Listen to your father who begot you, And do not despise your mother when she is old. Buy the truth, and do not sell *it, Also* wisdom and instruction and understanding. The father of the righteous will greatly rejoice, And he who begets a wise *child* will delight in him. Let your father and your mother be glad, And let her who bore you rejoice. My son, give me your heart, And let your eyes observe my ways.

(Pro 23:22-26)
