Rev 2:4 Nevertheless I have this against you, that you have left your first love.










- Decreased devotion to the Lord

Jer 3:22 "Return, you backsliding children, and I will heal your backslidings."


15:19 Therefore thus says the Lord: "If you return, then I will bring you back; you shall stand before Me; if you take out the precious from the vile,

They hold fast to deceit, they refuse to return.

Heb 3:7-11 Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says: "Today, if you will hear His voice, <sup>8</sup> Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion, in the day of trial in the wilderness, <sup>9</sup> Where your fathers tested Me, tried Me, and saw My works forty years. <sup>10</sup> Therefore I was angry with that generation, and said, 'They always go astray in their heart, and they have not known My ways.' <sup>11</sup> So I swore in My wrath, 'They shall not enter My rest.'"
