
Redemption is best illustrated by the O.T. kinsman redeemer who was most often called (in the Hebrew language) — the *Goel* (used some 100x in Scripture)

Goel = to buy back, redeem, or protect

For I know that my Redeemer lives, and He shall stand at last on the earth; Job 19:25




Their Redeemer is strong; the Lord of hosts is His name. He will thoroughly plead their case, Jer 50:34


And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross. Col 2:15







