

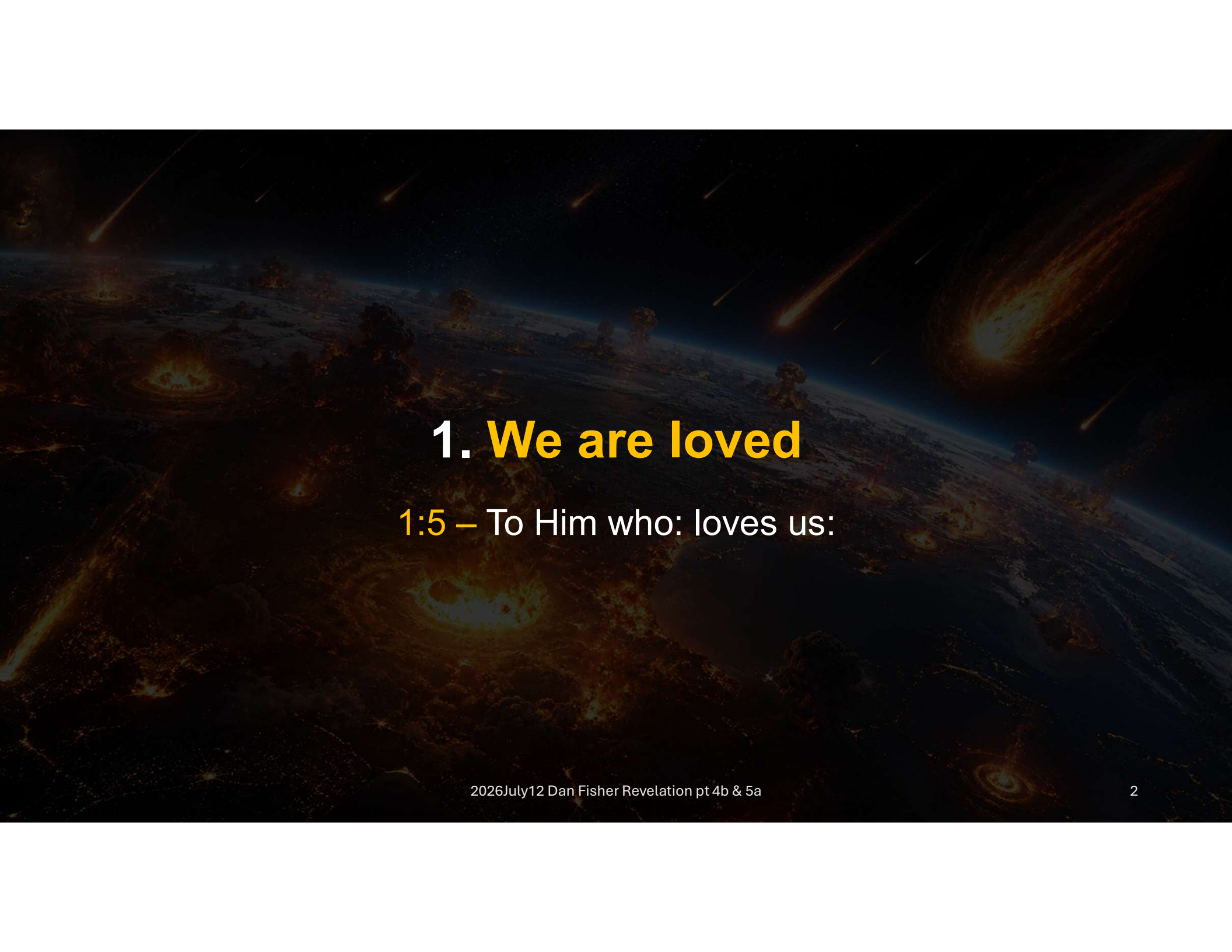

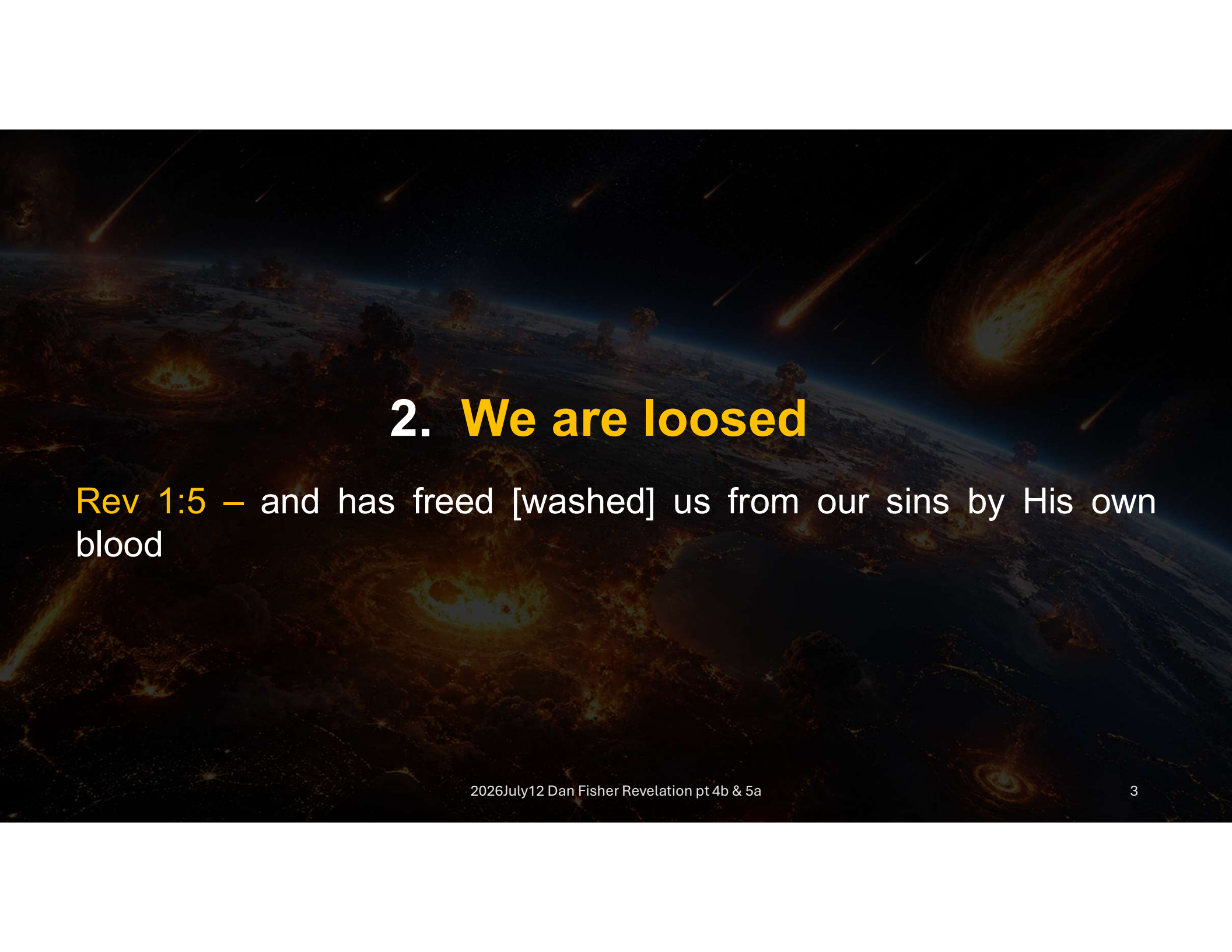

1. **We are loved**

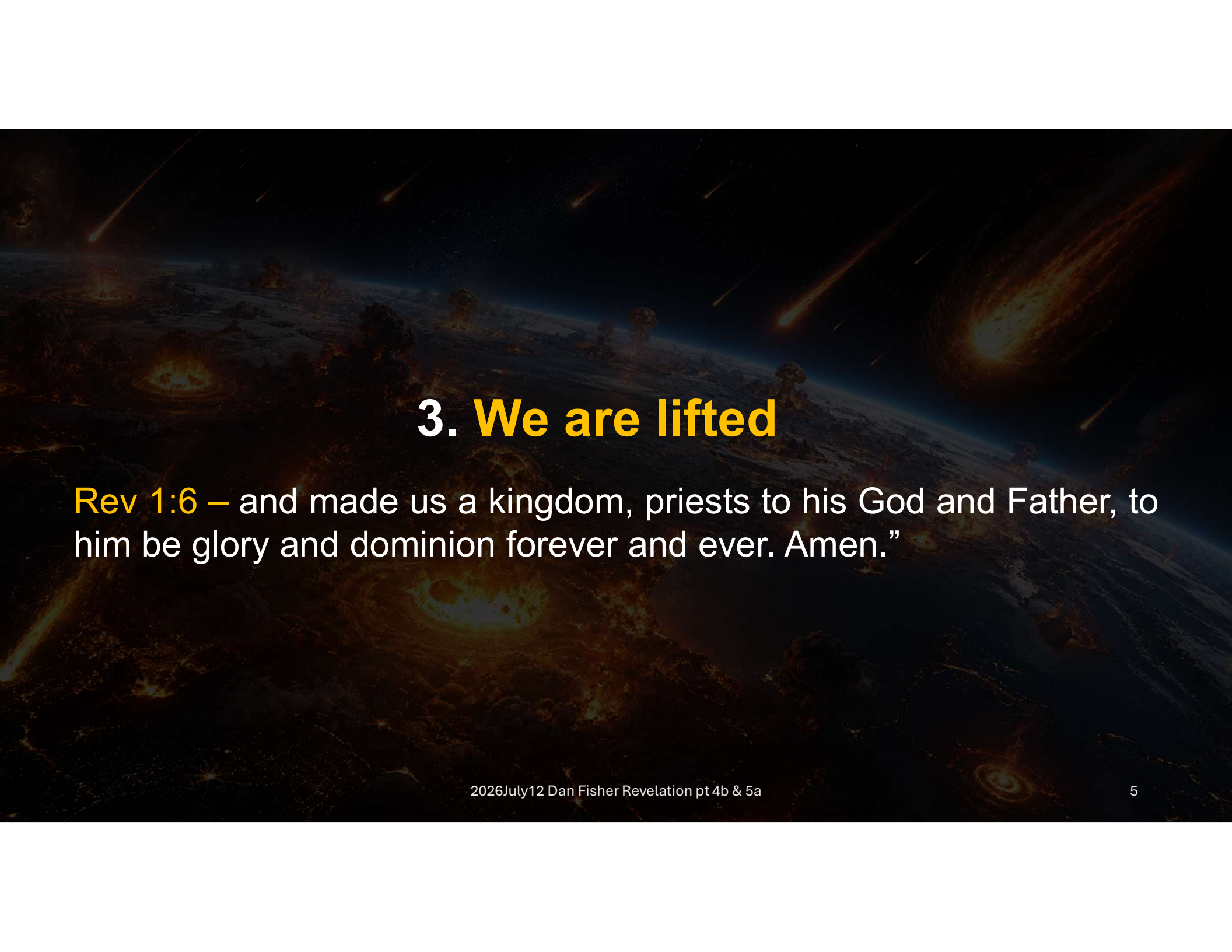
1:5 – To Him who: loves us:



2. We are loosed

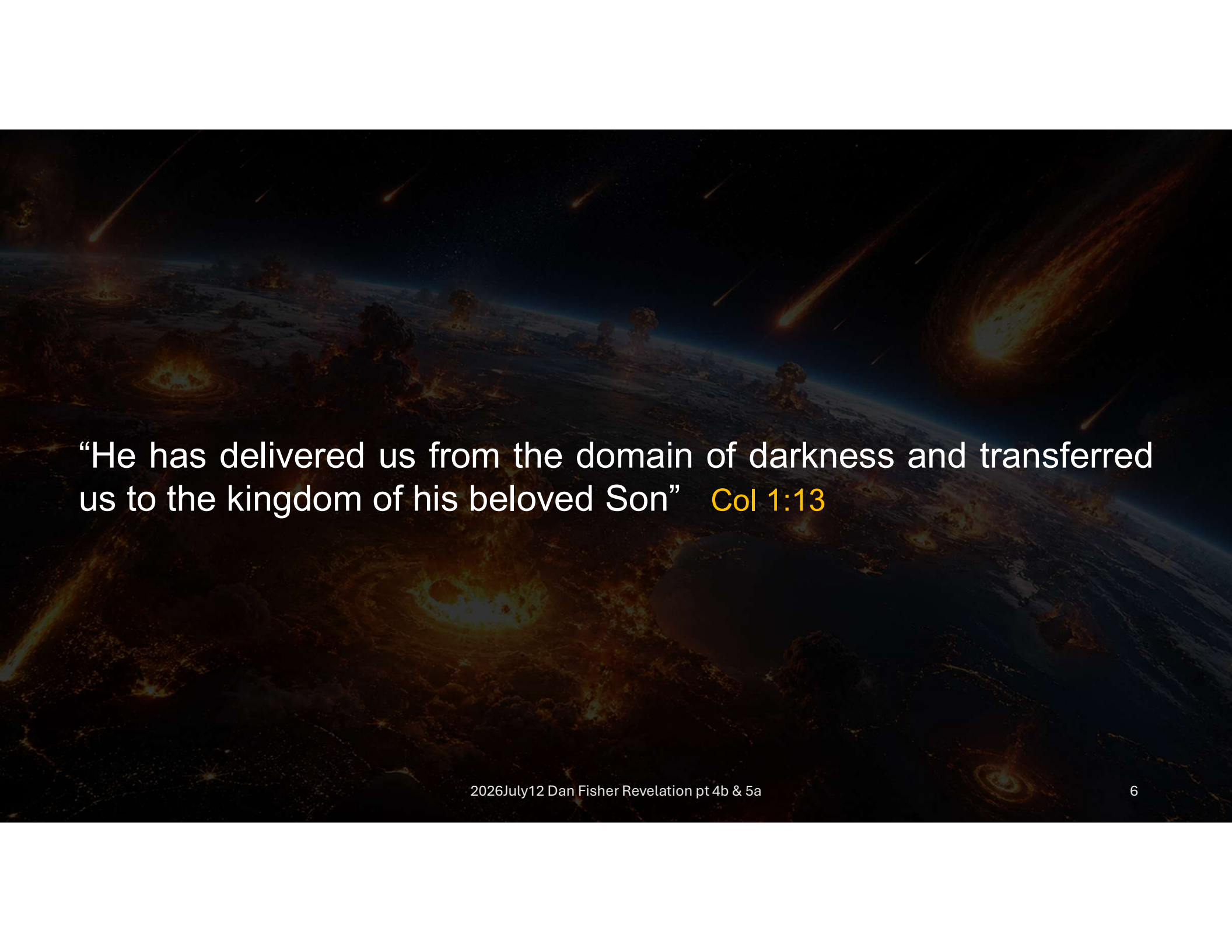
Rev 1:5 – and has freed [washed] us from our sins by His own blood

Kingdom of “bridges”

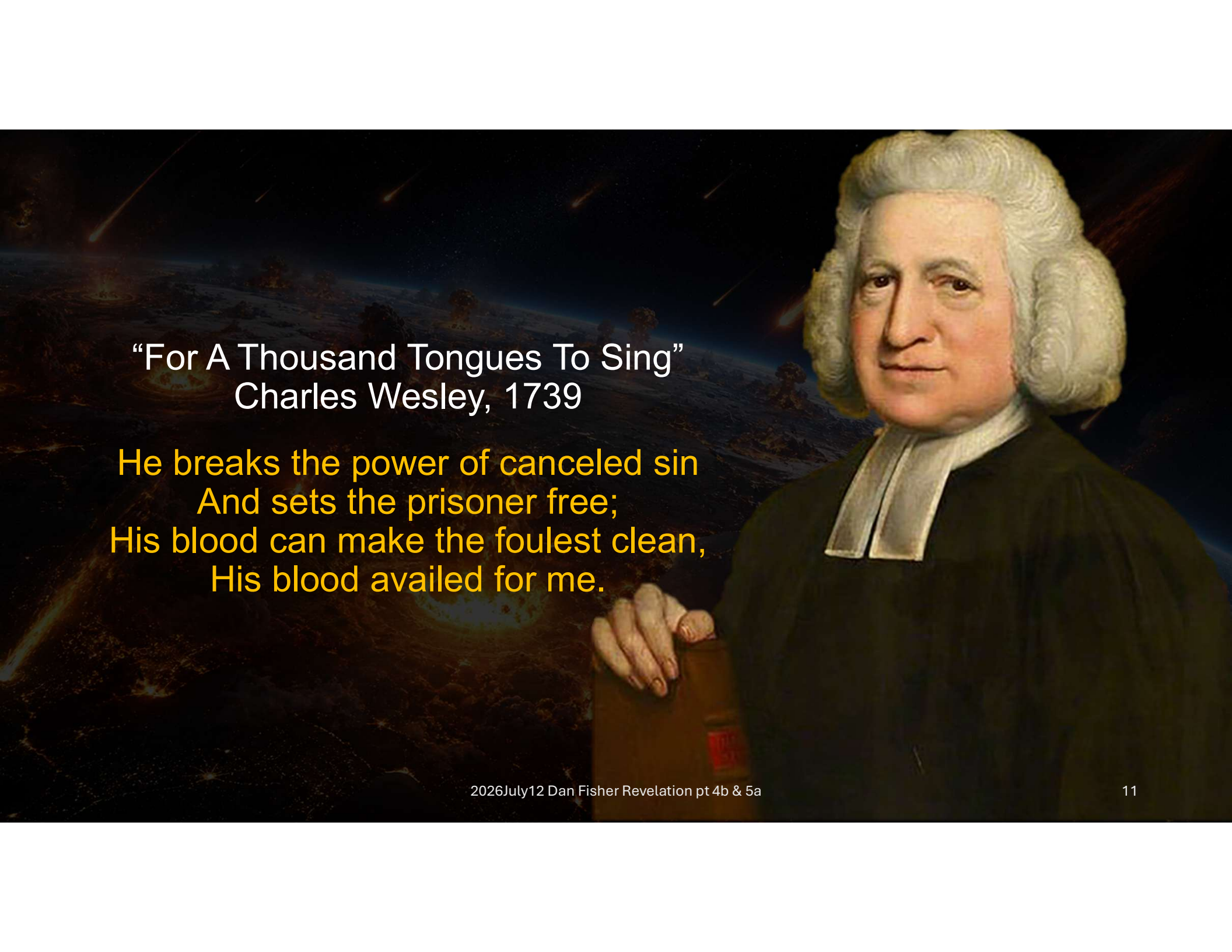


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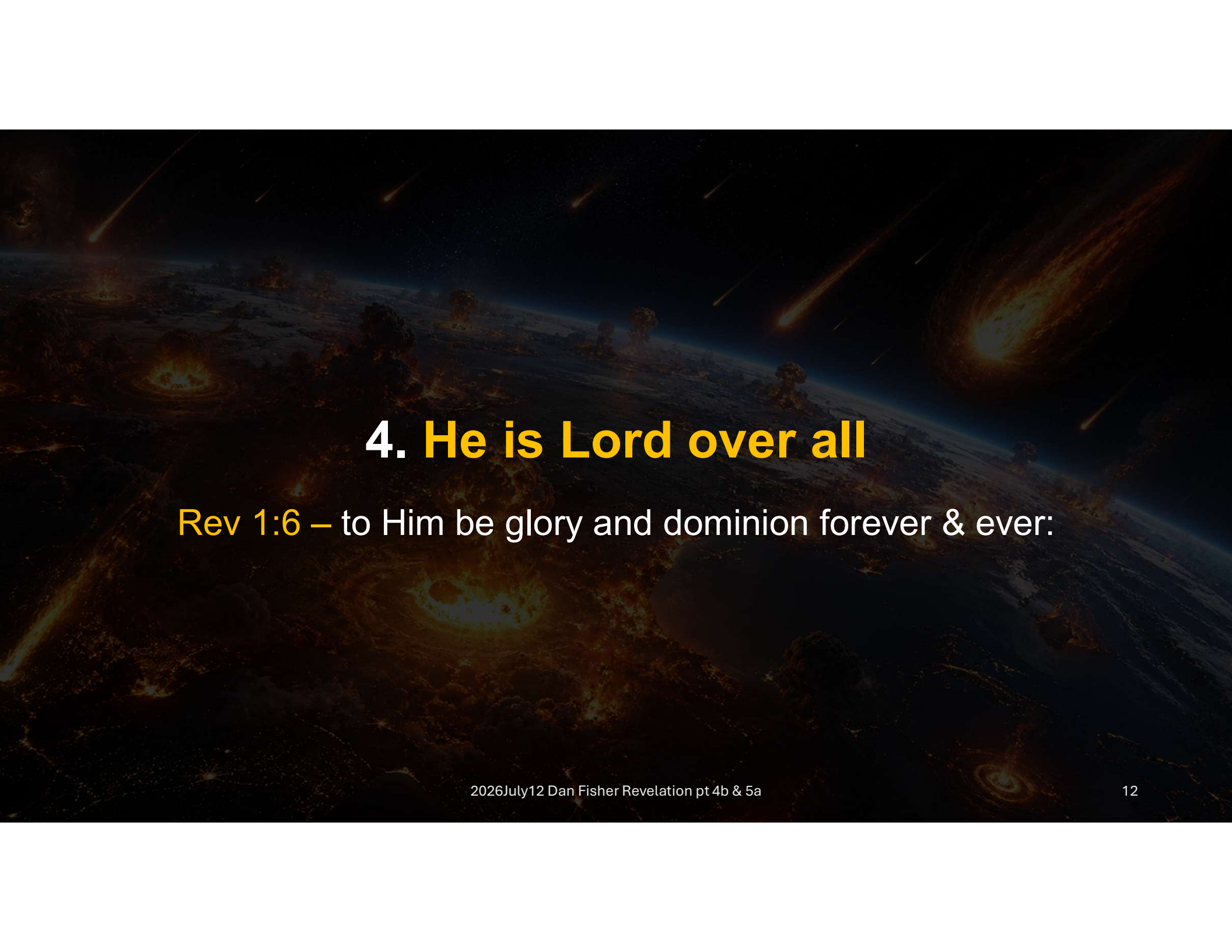

4. He is Lord over all

Rev 1:6 – to Him be glory and dominion forever & ever:

- The world will be His footstool

“The Lord said to my Lord, ‘sit at My right hand, ‘till I make Your enemies Your footstool’”? **Mt 22:44**

“For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he says himself: The Lord said to my Lord, sit at My right hand, ³⁵ ‘till I make Your enemies Your footstool. ³⁶Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ. (Ps 110:1)” **Acts 2:34-36**

- **He made all things & is the head of all things**

“For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. ¹⁷And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.” Col 1:16-17

“who is the head of all principality and power.” Col 2:10

“As I live, says the Lord, every knee shall bow to Me, and every tongue shall confess to God.” Rom 14:11



5. He will return

Rev 1:7 – Behold, he is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him, even those who pierced him, and all tribes of the earth will wail on account of him. Even so. Amen.

- 2nd coming prophecy

“The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh comes; and to Him shall be the obedience of the people.” Gen 49:10

Ps 2:6-9, Jer 23:5-8, Zech 14:4-9

“For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder. and His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. ⁷Of the increase of His government and peace there will be no end, upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, to order it and establish it with judgment and justice from that time forward, even forever. - With the clouds

Israel in wilderness, on Mt. Sinai, in the tabernacle/temple, Christ's ascension

- Rapture

"Then we who are alive, who are left, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord."

1 Thess 4:17

- 2nd coming

"Then will appear in heaven the sign of the Son of Man, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory." Mt 24:30

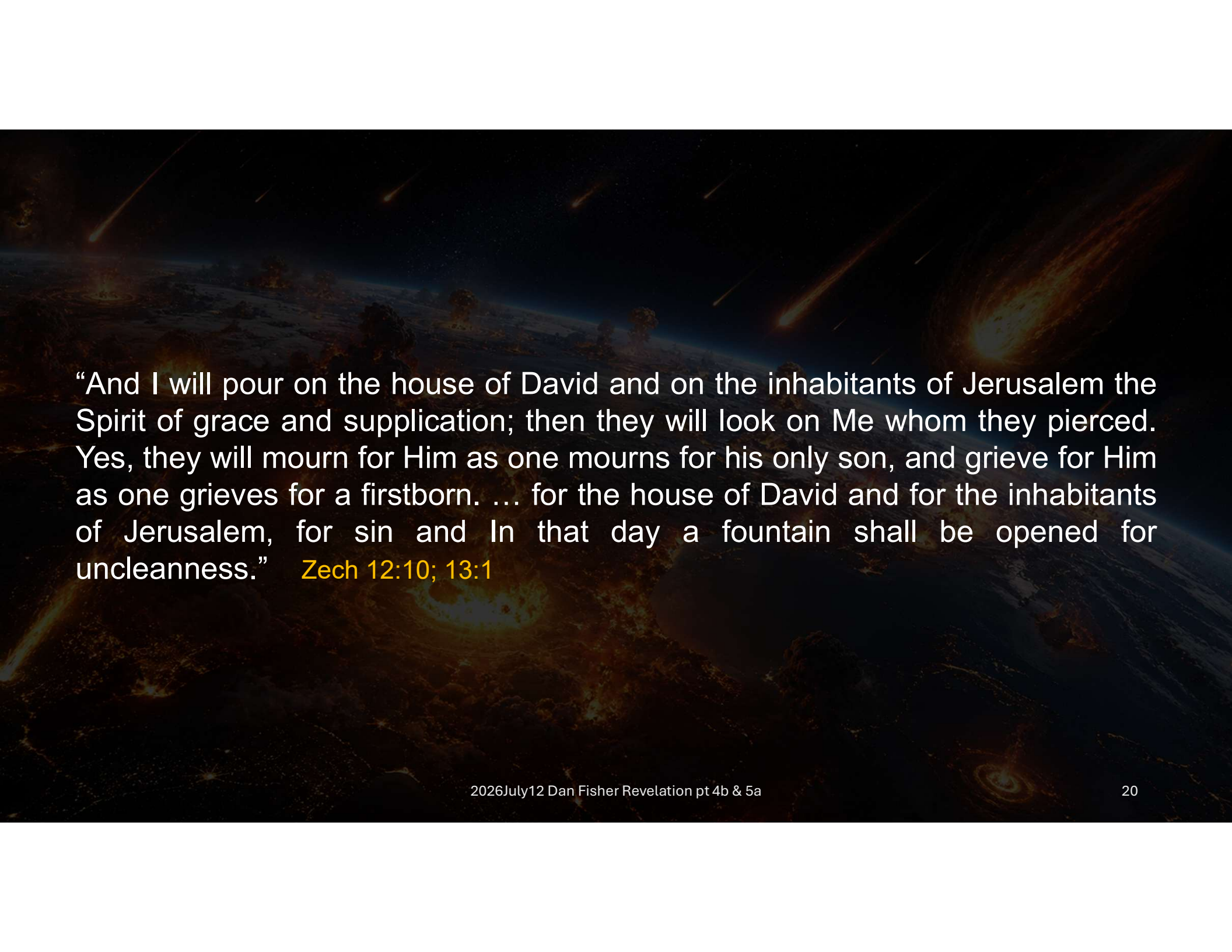
- every eye will see Him

“For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. ... Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. ³⁰Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. ³¹And He will send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they will gather together His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.” Mt 24:27,29-31

“But you denied the Holy One and the Just, and asked for a murderer to be granted to you, ¹⁵and killed the Prince of life, whom God raised from the dead, of which we are witnesses.” Acts 3:14-15

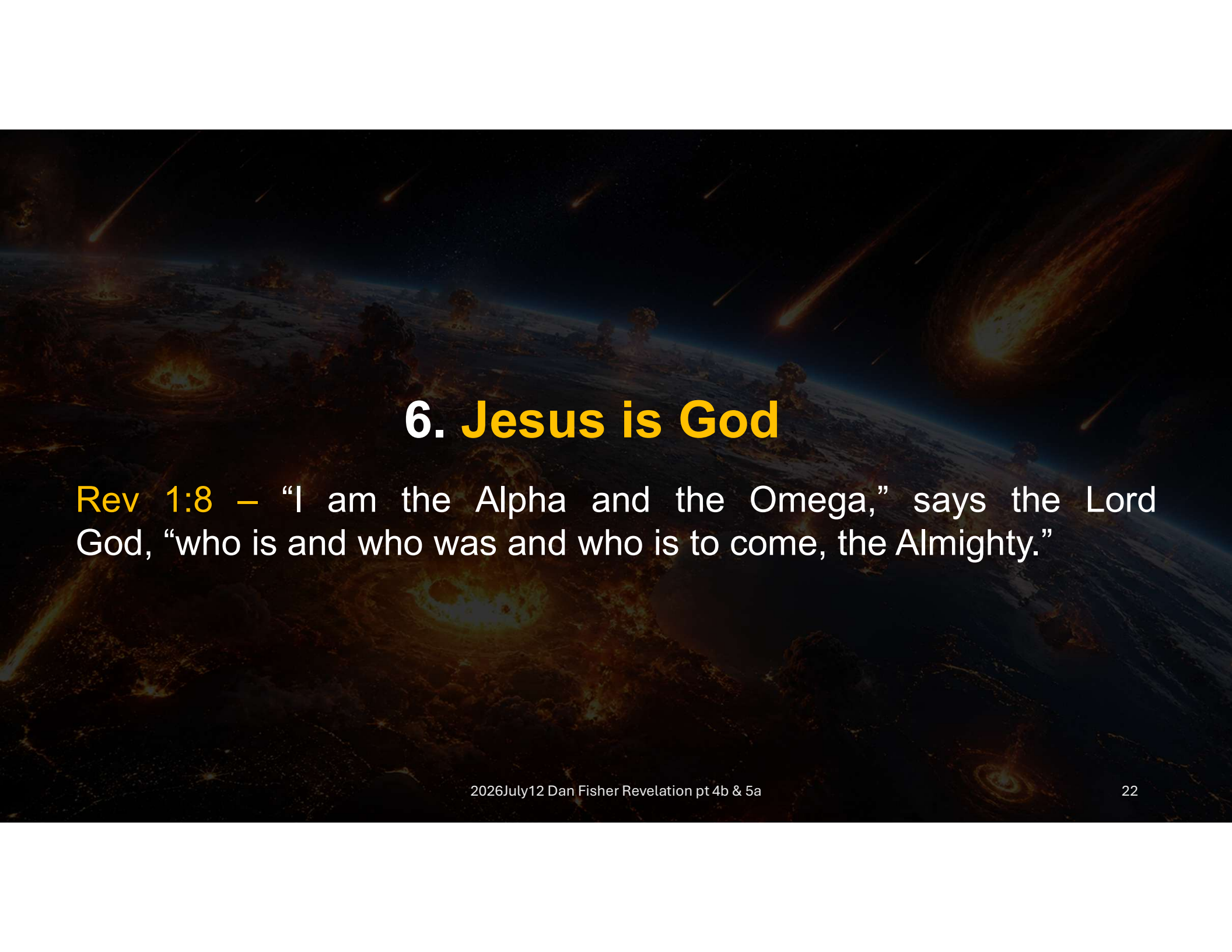
- All of the tribes of the earth will mourn

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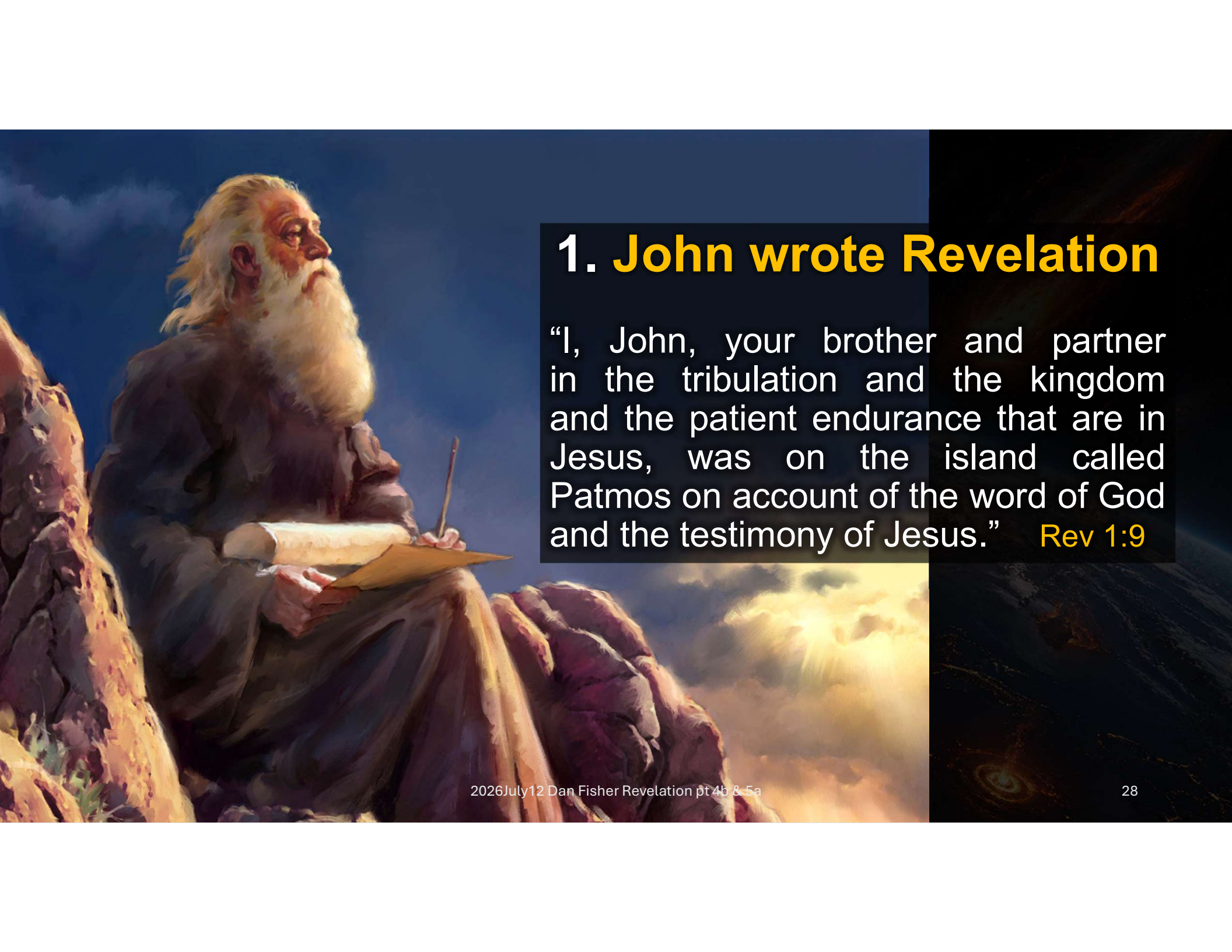

1. John wrote Revelation

“I, John, your brother and partner in the tribulation and the kingdom and the patient endurance that are in Jesus, was on the island called Patmos on account of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus.” **Rev 1:9**

- fellow companion in tribulation

“I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world.” Jn 16:33

“We must through many tribulations enter the kingdom of God.” Acts 14:22

“that no one be moved by these afflictions. For you yourselves know that we are destined for this. 4 For when we were with you, we kept telling you beforehand that we were to suffer affliction, just as it has come to pass, and just as you know.” 1 Thess 3:3-4

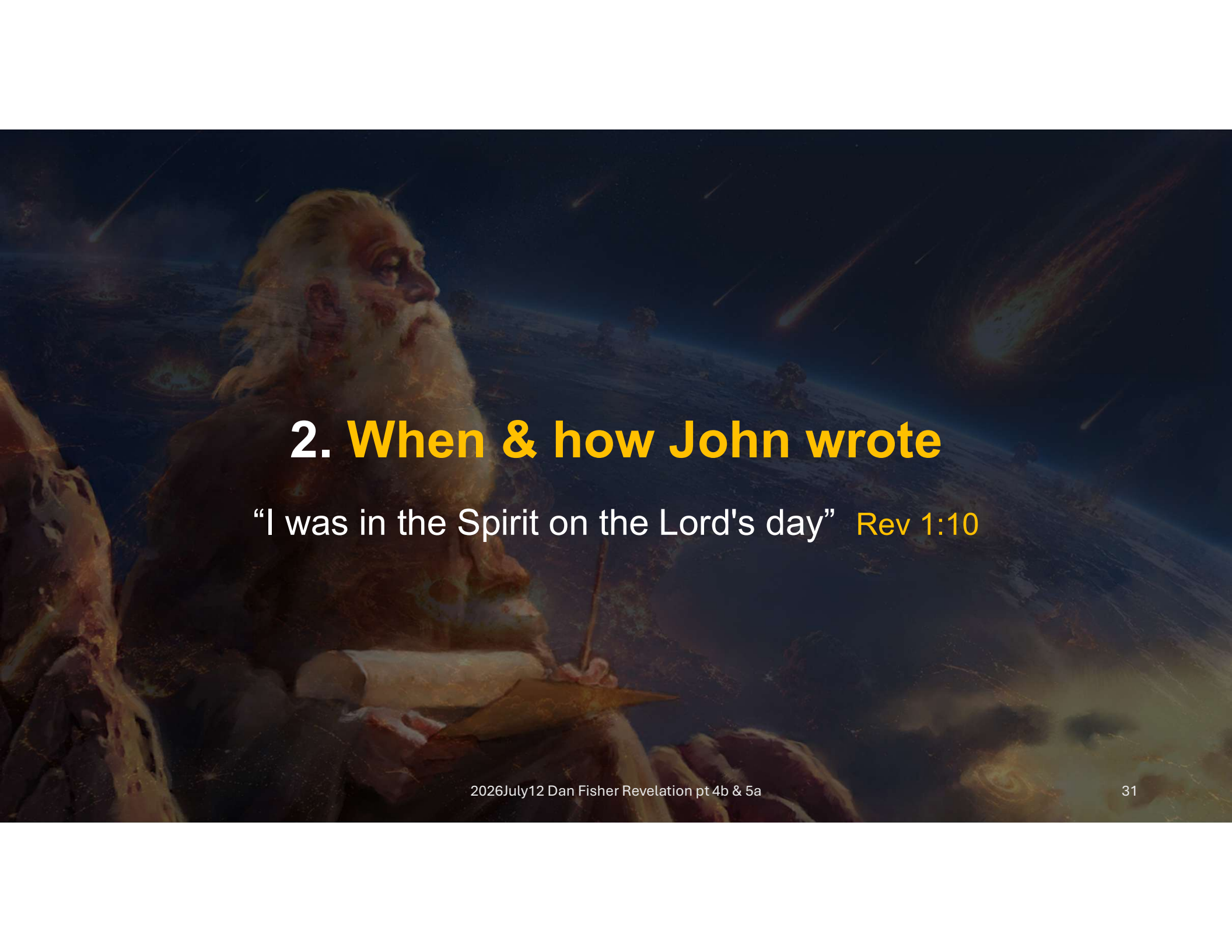
“Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, 4 and endurance produces character, and character produces hope,” Rom 5:3-4

- persecuted for the gospel

“Remember the word that I said to you: ‘A servant is not greater than his master.’ If they persecuted me, they will also persecute you. If they kept my word, they will also keep yours.” Jn 15:20

“Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.” Mt 5:10

“all who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted,” 2 Tim 3:12



2. When & how John wrote

“I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day” Rev 1:10

- in the spirit

“God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth.”

Jn 4:24

“Do you not know that you are God’s temple and that God’s Spirit dwells in you?” 1 Cor 3:16

“You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him.” Rom 8:9

“I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven – whether in the body or out of the body I do not know, God knows.”

2 Cor 12:2

But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.”

Gal 5:16

- on the Lord's day

“Therefore let no one pass judgment on you in questions of food and drink, or with regard to a festival or a new moon or a Sabbath. ¹⁷ These are a shadow of the things to come, but the substance belongs to Christ.” Col 2:16-17

Day of Pentecost on the first day of the week (Lev 23:15-22; Acts 2:1-4)

“Now when he rose early on the first day of the week” Mk 16:9

“On the first day of every week, each of you is to put something aside and store it up, as he may prosper, so that there will be no collecting when I come.”
1 Cor 16:2

“On the first day of the week, when we were gathered together to break bread, Paul talked with them [in Troas] , intending to depart on the next day, and he prolonged his speech until midnight.” Acts 20:7

- taking dictation

“saying, ‘Write what you see in a book and send it to the seven churches, to Ephesus and to Smyrna and to Pergamum and to Thyatira and to Sardis and to Philadelphia and to Laodicea.’” Rev 1:11

- Record what you see & hear
- Jesus’ message was contoured to seven churches

3. The voice of the Lord

“and I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet ... ¹² Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking to me, and on turning I saw seven golden lampstands, ¹³ and in the midst of the lampstands one like a son of man,” **Rev 1:10,12-13**

- like a trumpet

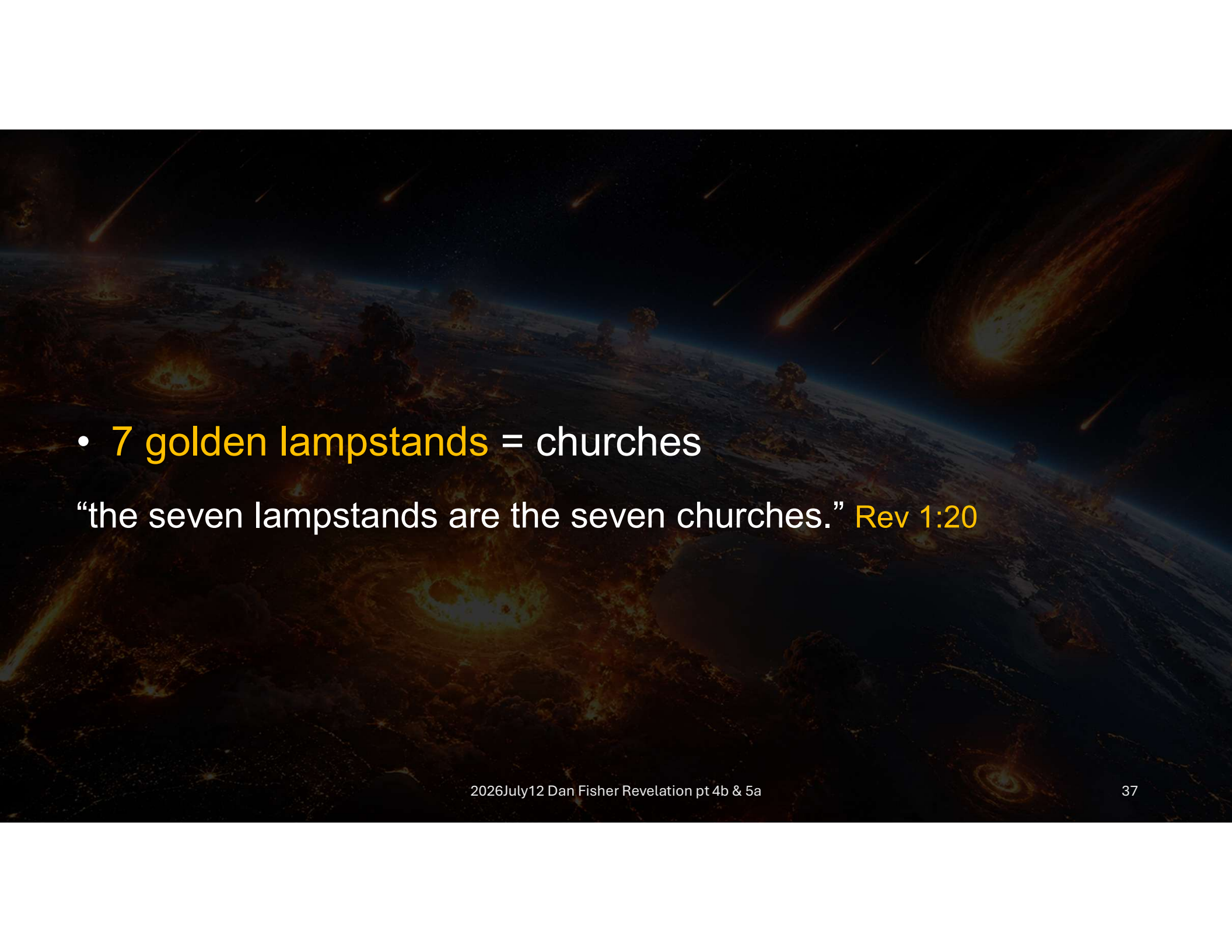
“And he will send out his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.”

Mt 24:31

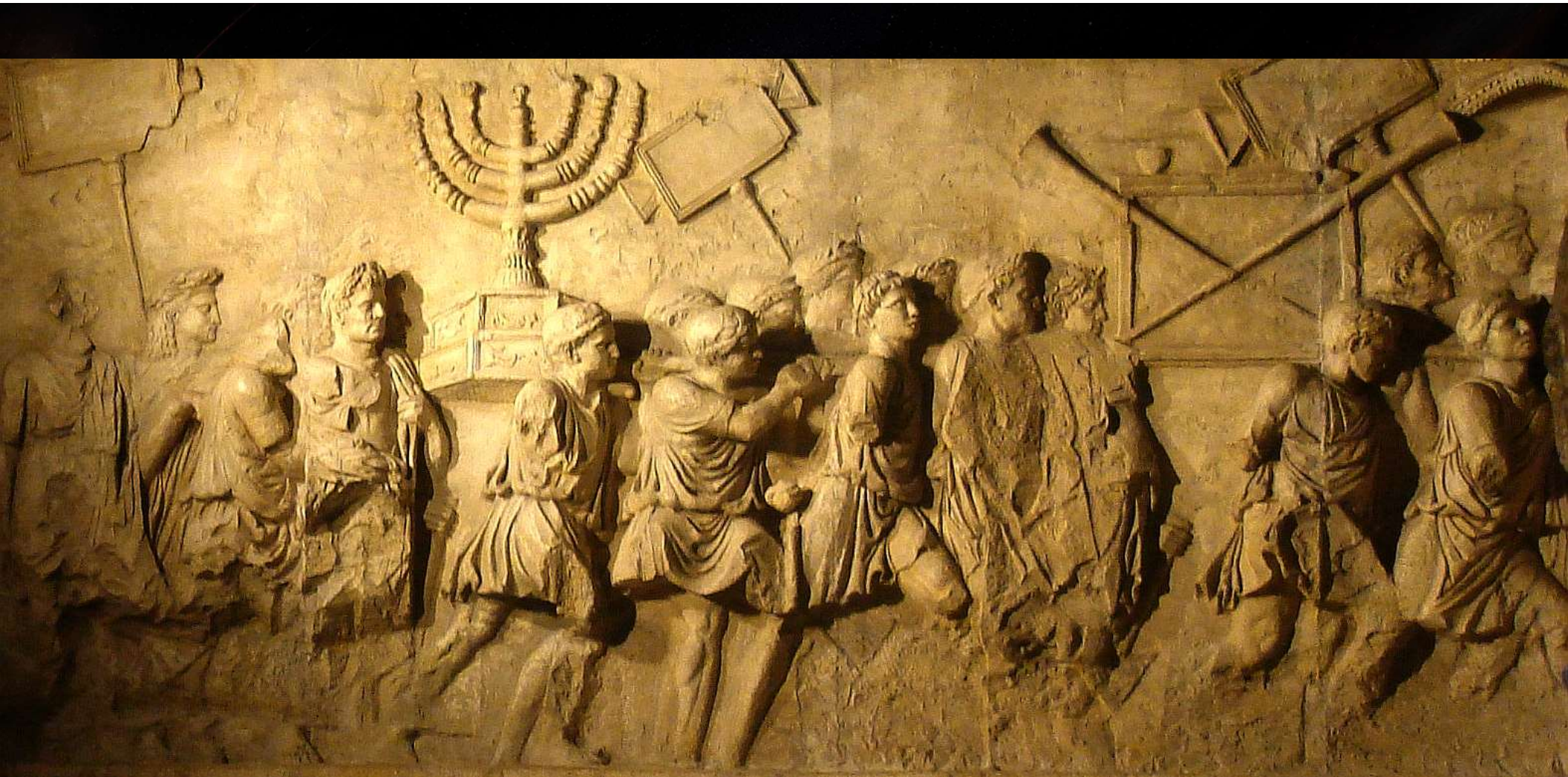
“in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed.” 1 Cor 15:52

“For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first.” 1 Thess 4:16

“and the sound of a trumpet and a voice whose words made the hearers beg that no further messages be spoken to them.” Heb 12:19

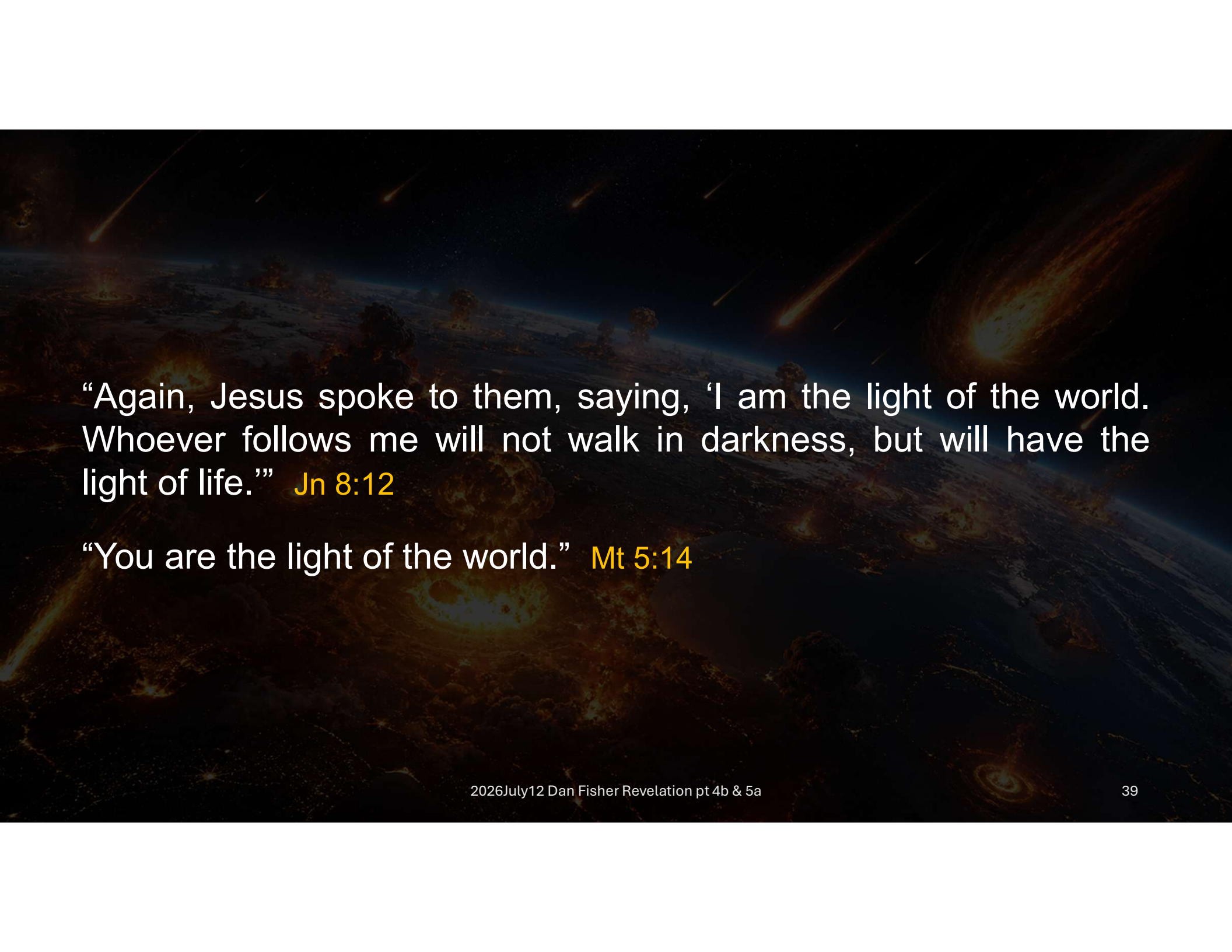
-

“the seven lampstands are the seven churches.” Rev 1:20

- in the “midst”

“For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I among them.”

Mt 18:20

“Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a man attested to you by God with mighty works and wonders and signs that God did through him in your midst, as you yourselves know” Acts 2:22

“that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and twisted generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, ” Phil 2:15



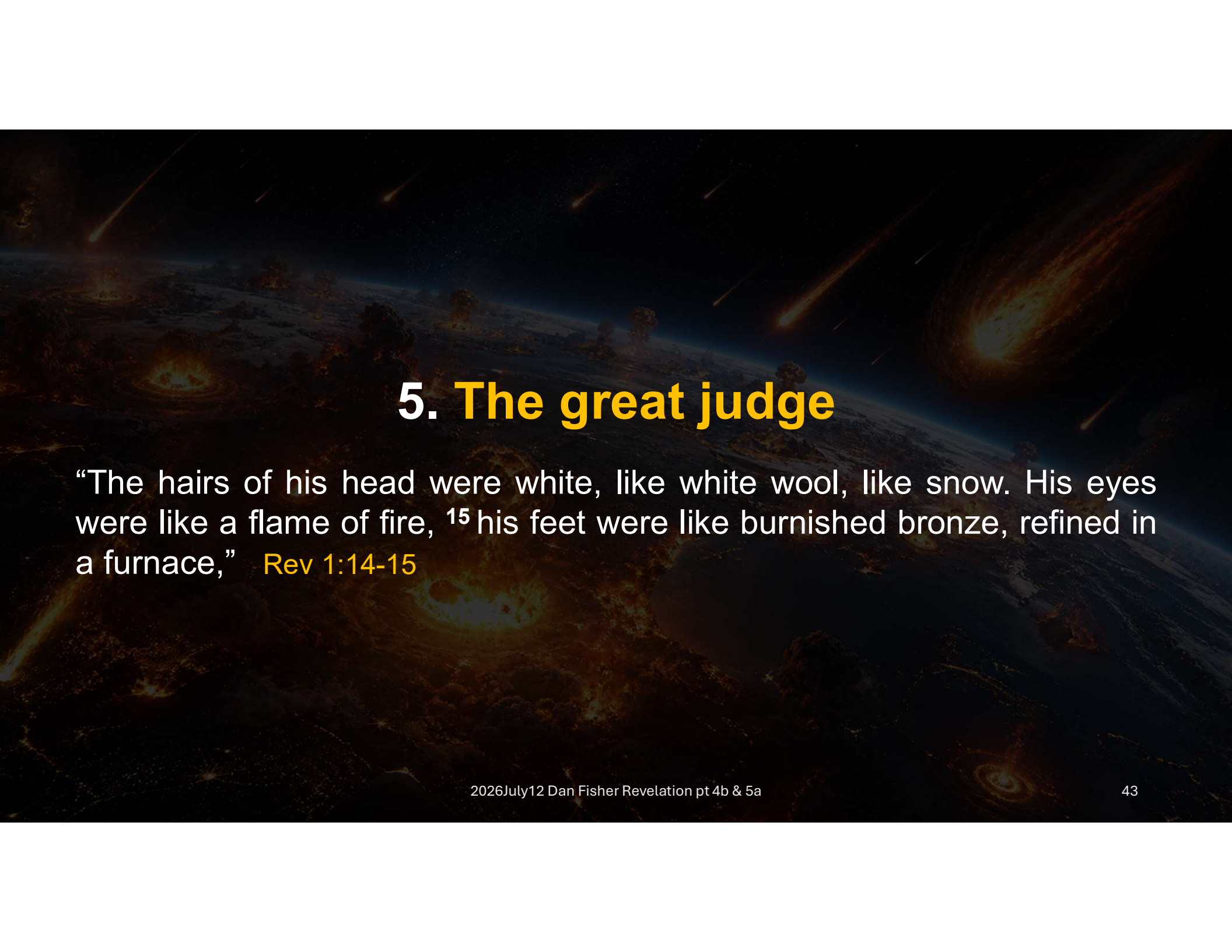
4. The great high priest

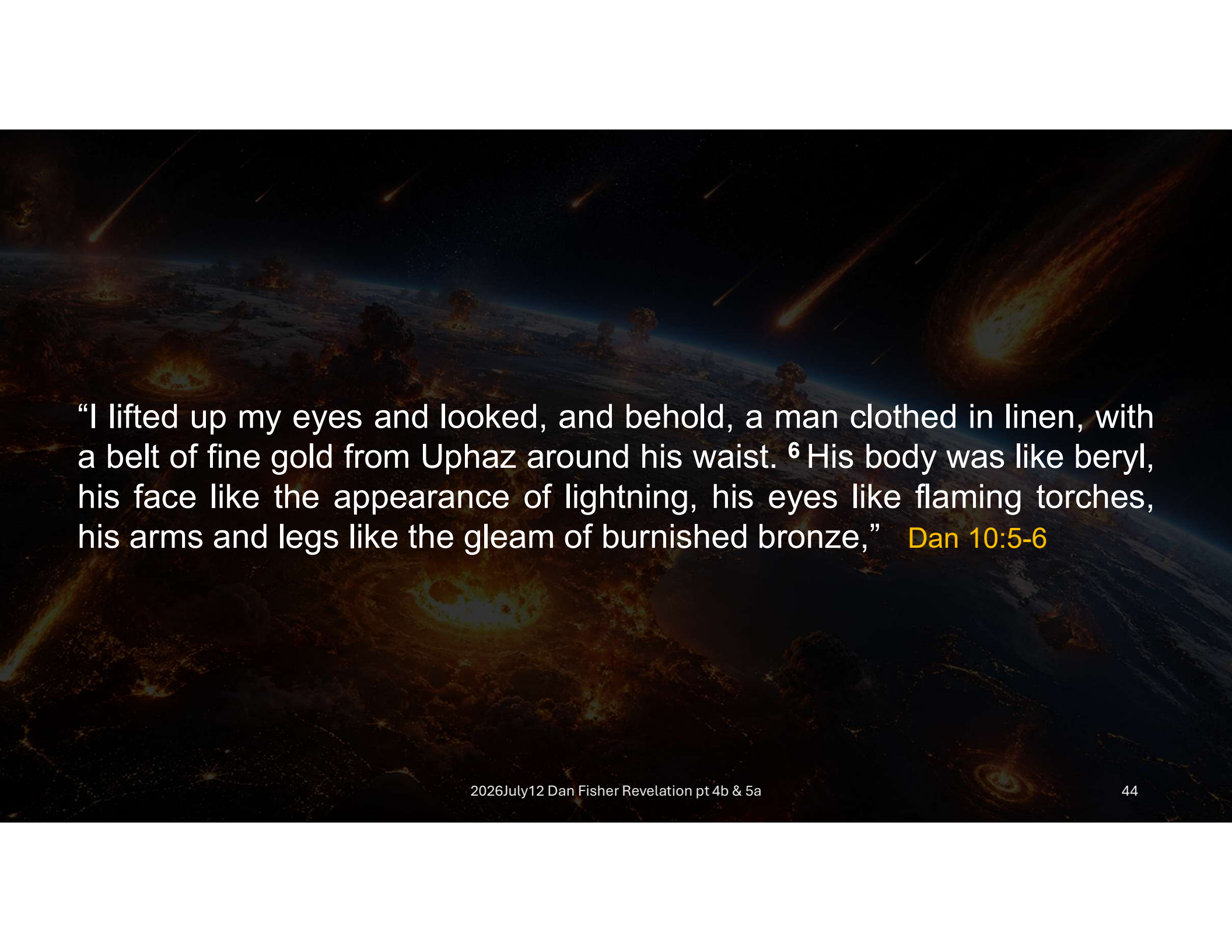
“Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.” **Heb 4:14**

5. The great judge

“The hairs of his head were white, like white wool, like snow. His eyes were like a flame of fire, ¹⁵ his feet were like burnished bronze, refined in a furnace,” Rev 1:14-15



“I lifted up my eyes and looked, and behold, a man clothed in linen, with a belt of fine gold from Uphaz around his waist. ⁶ His body was like beryl, his face like the appearance of lightning, his eyes like flaming torches, his arms and legs like the gleam of burnished bronze,” **Dan 10:5-6**

- White hair like wool

- White is often a symbol of – purity & wisdom
- Wool is from a sheep and is both symbolic of us (sheep) and of Jesus (Passover Lamb)

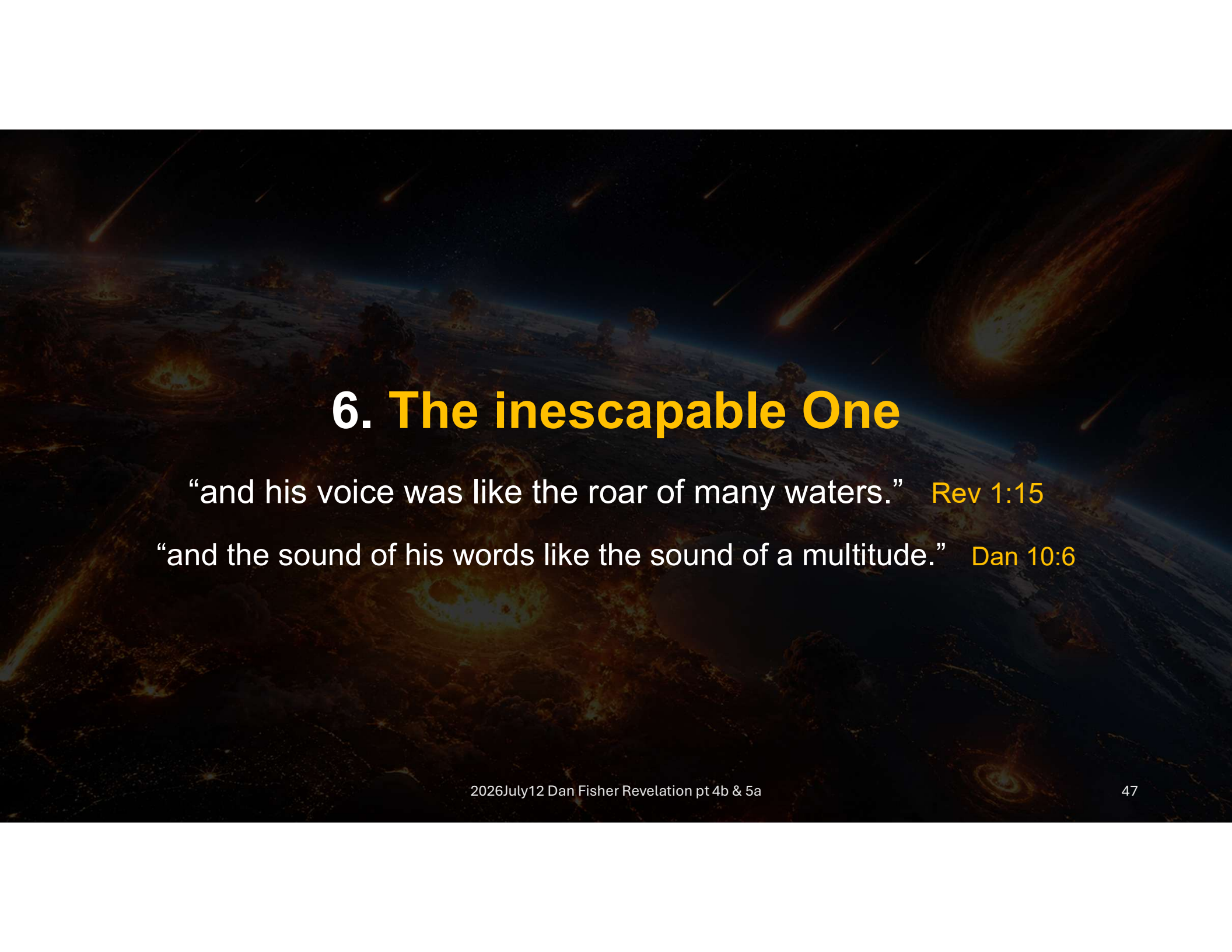
“Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!” Jn 1:29

“Come now, let us reason together, says the Lord: though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall become like wool.” Is 1:18

- **Eyes like fire, feet like bronze/brass**
 - bronze/brass is used in Scripture to represent judgment
 - bronze/brass results from a smelting process involving intense fire which symbolizes the fiery nature of God's justice and the payment for sin

Examples: brazen altar (Ex 27) & bronze serpent (Num 21)

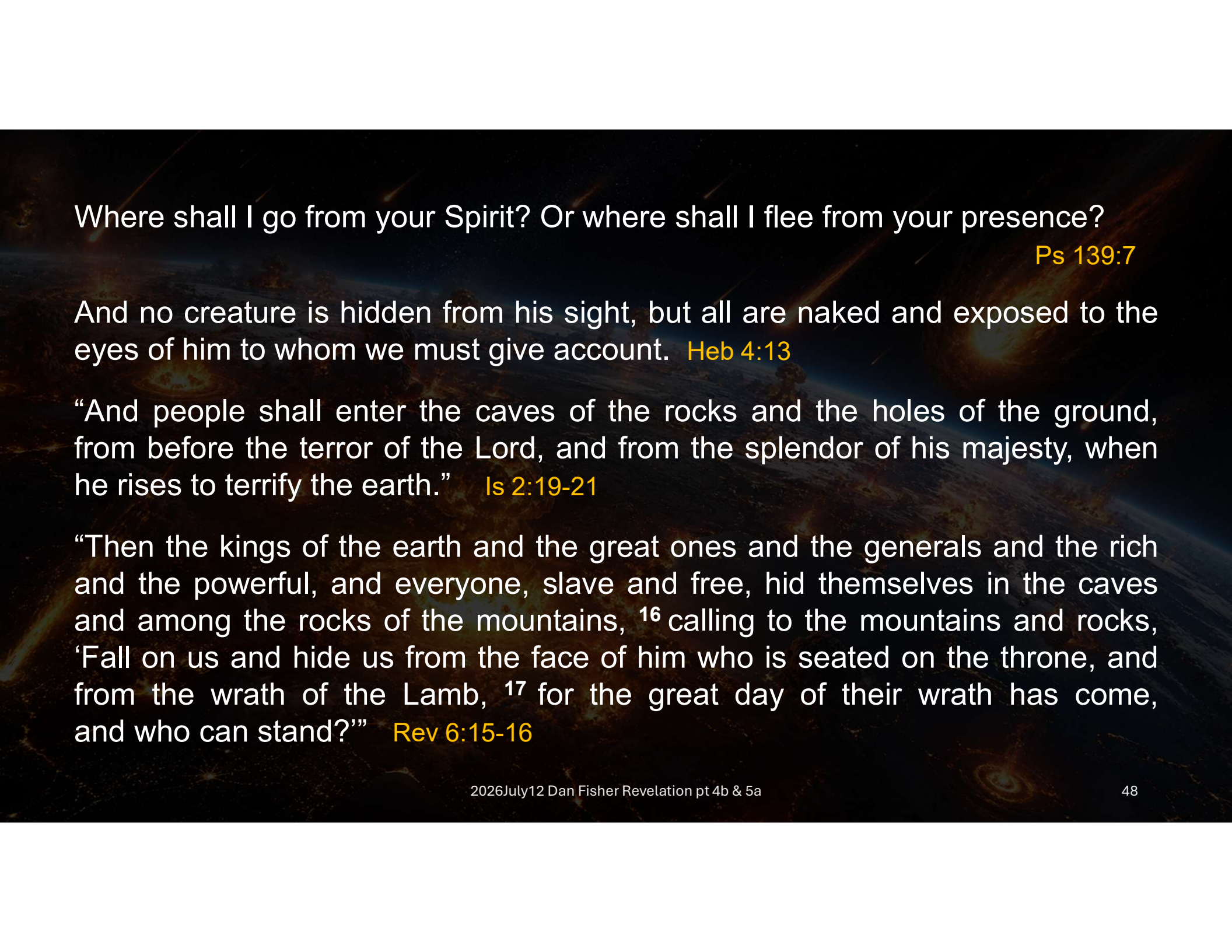

6. The inescapable One

“and his voice was like the roar of many waters.” Rev 1:15

“and the sound of his words like the sound of a multitude.” Dan 10:6



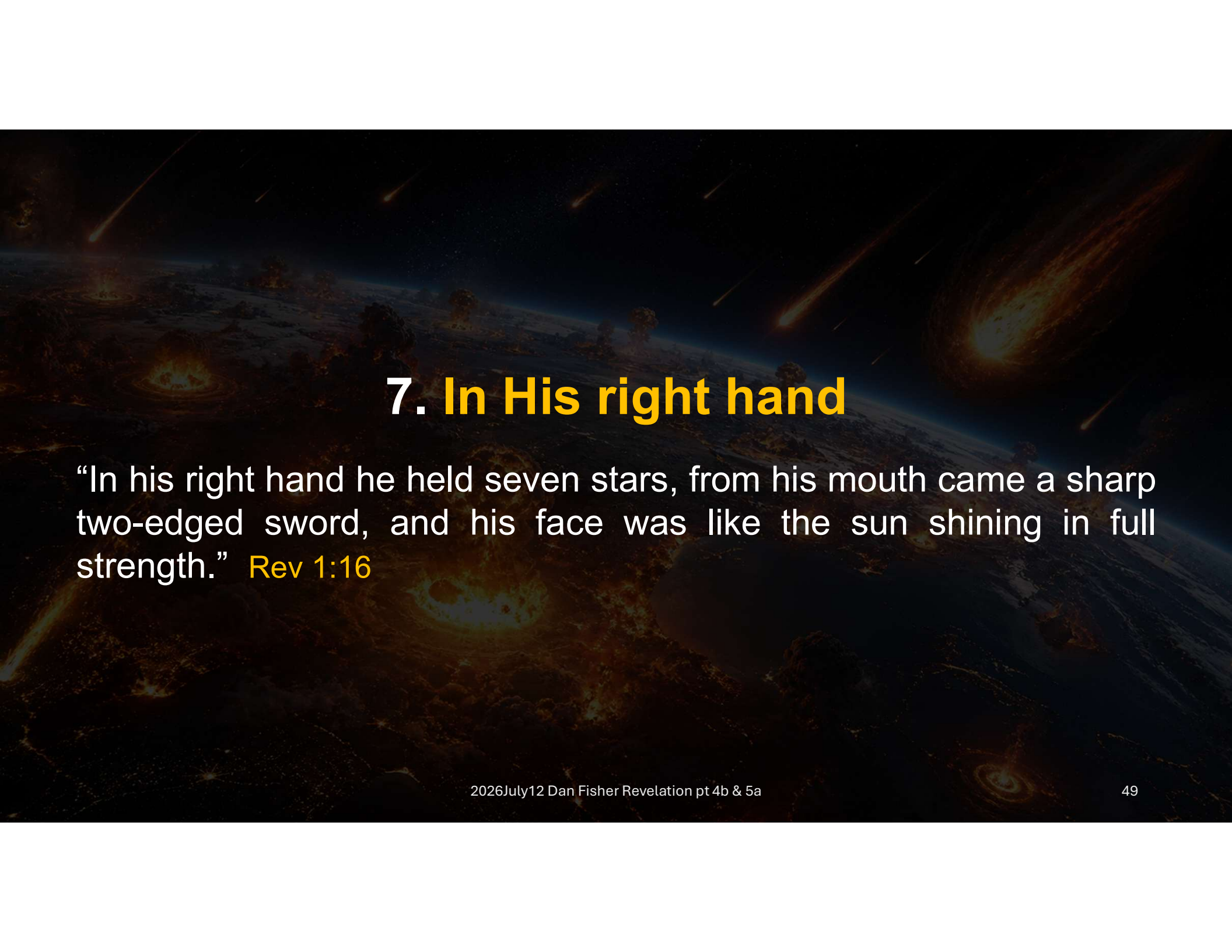
Where shall I go from your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from your presence?

7. In His right hand

- sword

“For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.” Heb 4:12

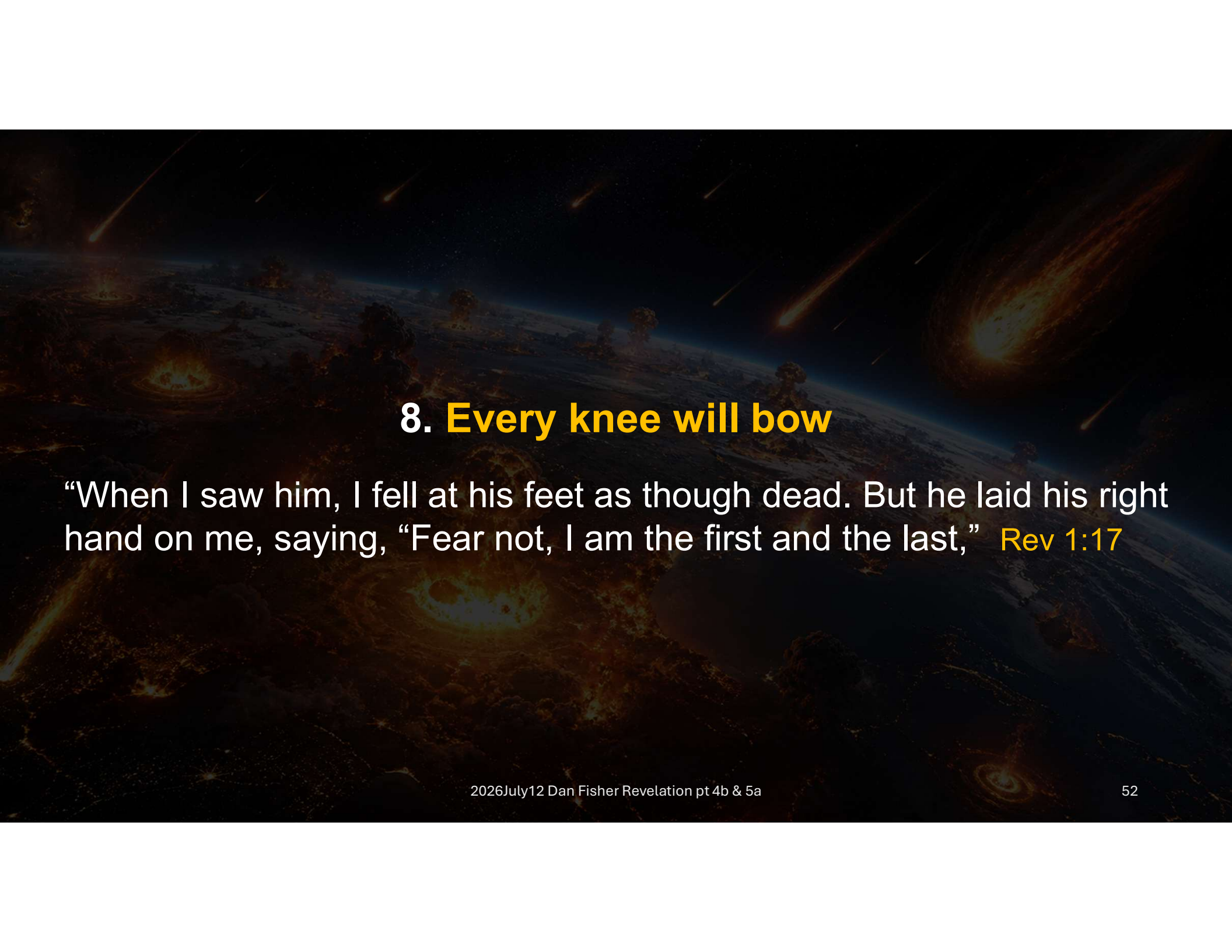
- countenance

“who alone has immortality, who dwells in unapproachable light, whom no one has ever seen or can see.” 1 Tim 6:16

“Aaron and all the people of Israel saw Moses, and behold, the skin of his face shone, and they were afraid to come near him.” Ex 34:30

“And he was transfigured before them, and his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became white as light.” Mt 17:2

“His appearance was like lightning, and his clothing white as snow.” Mt 28:3



8. Every knee will bow

“When I saw him, I fell at his feet as though dead. But he laid his right hand on me, saying, “Fear not, I am the first and the last,” **Rev 1:17**

- John fell like a dead man

“And for fear of him the guards trembled and became like dead men.” Mt 28:4

“Jesus said to them, “I am he,” they drew back and fell to the ground.” Jn 18:6

“Now as he went on his way, he approached Damascus, and suddenly a light from heaven shone around him. ⁴ And falling to the ground, he heard a voice saying to him, “Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?” Acts 9:3-4

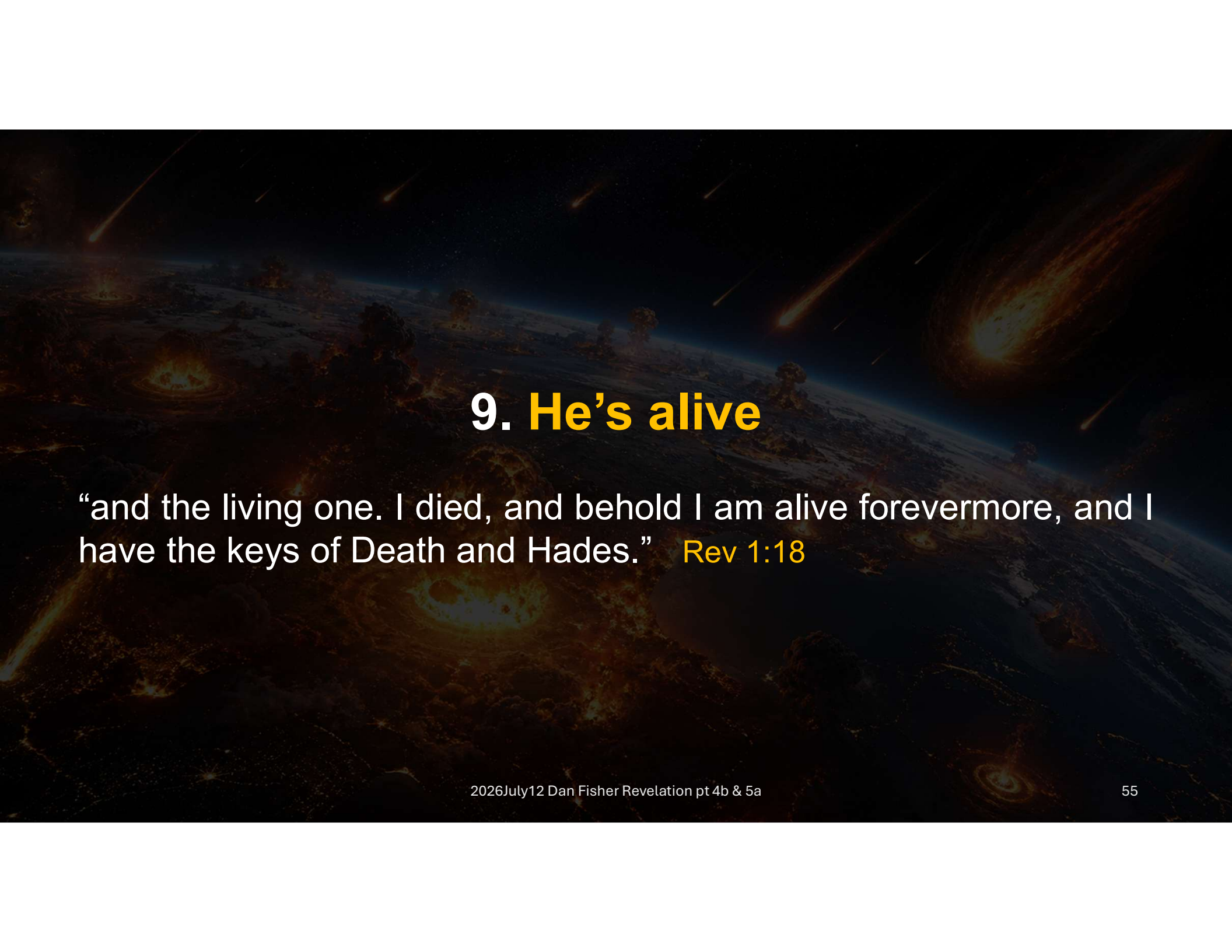

9. He's alive

“and the living one. I died, and behold I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of Death and Hades.” **Rev 1:18**

- graveyard dead

“For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, 4 that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures,” 1 Cor 15:3-4

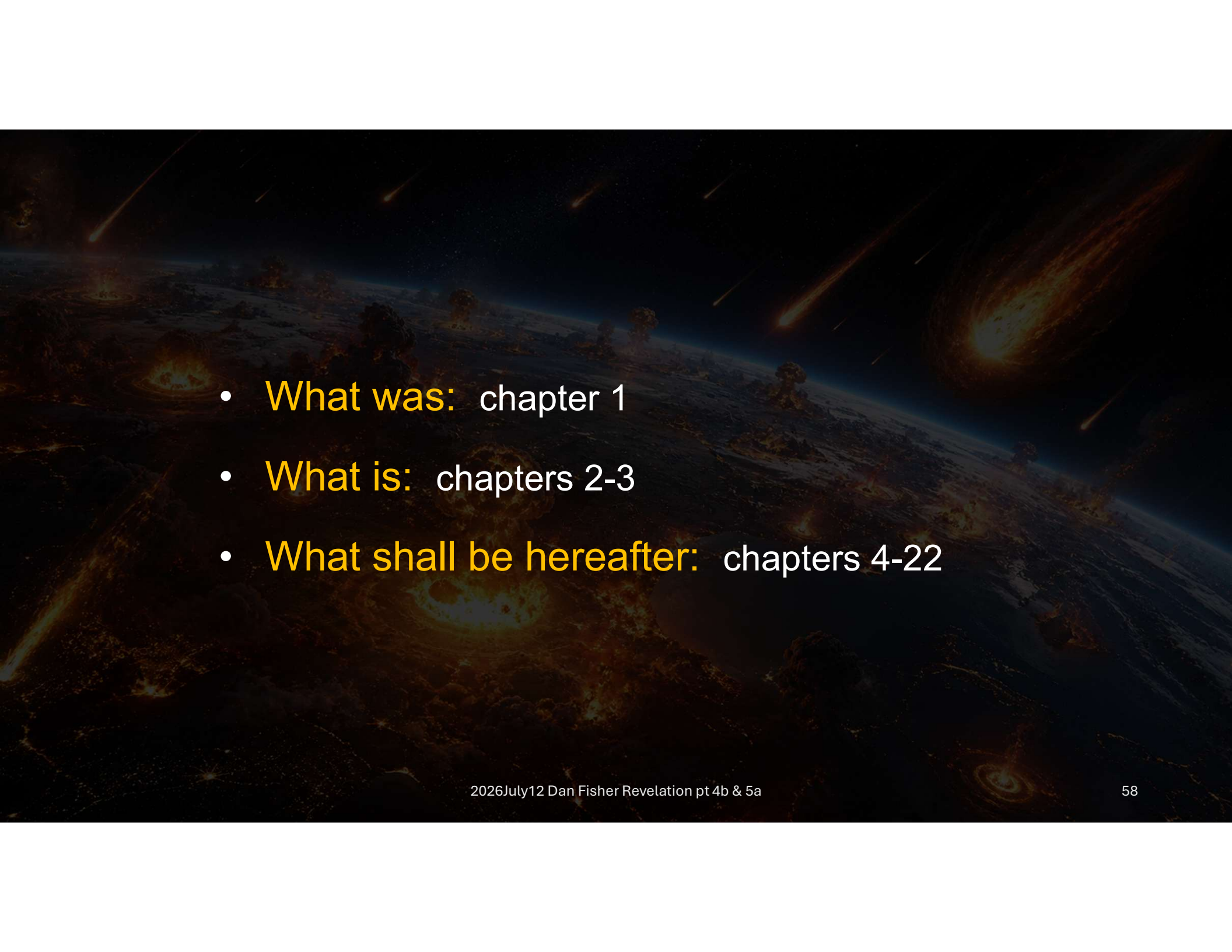
- the keys of hell and death

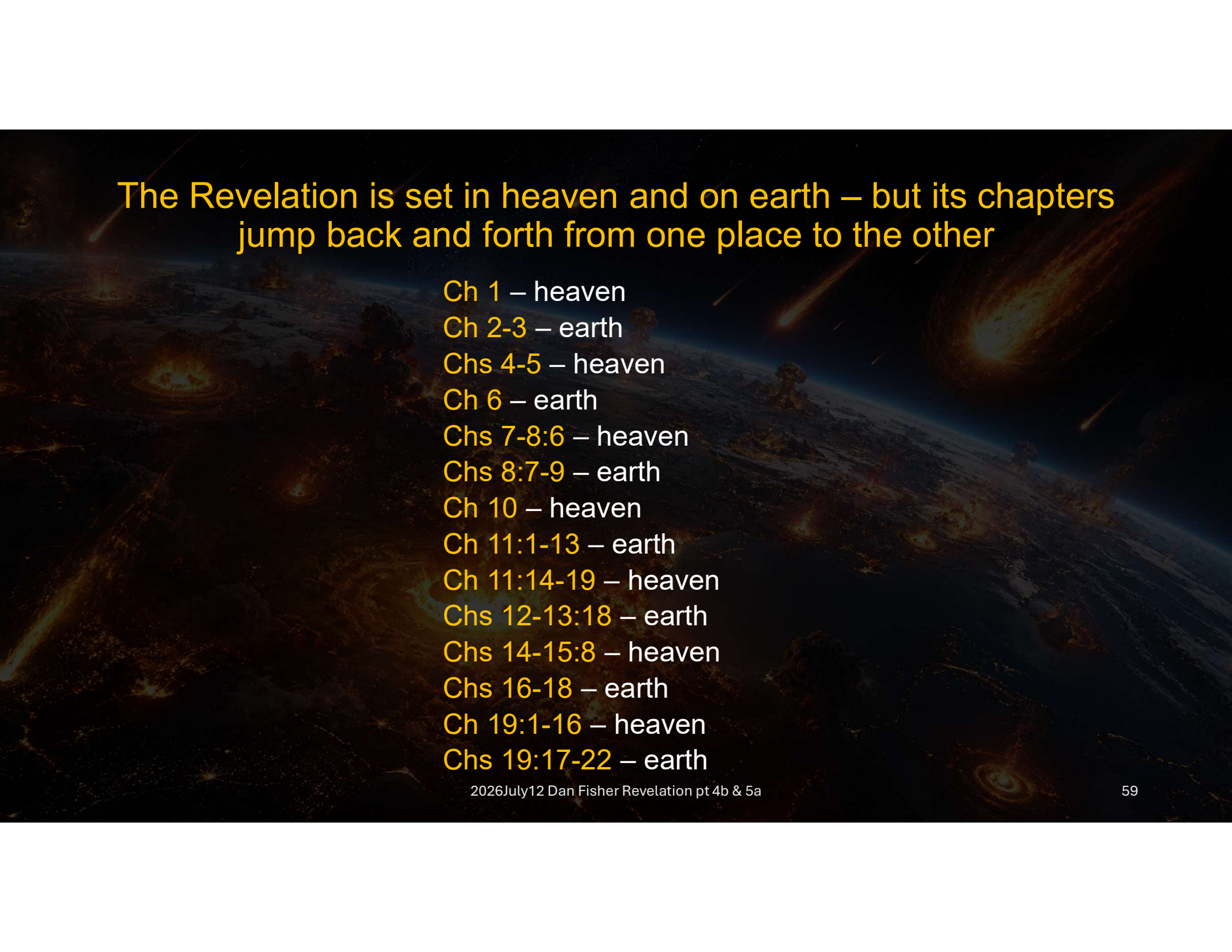
