




# Can evil stand in God's presence?

“You are of purer eyes than to behold evil, and cannot look on wickedness. Why do You look on those who deal treacherously, and hold Your tongue when the wicked devours a person more righteous than he?” **Hab 1:13**



1. God is both **omniscient** (all knowing) and **omnipresent** (all present), therefore He is always aware of and in the presence of sin and the sinful

“And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give account.” **Heb 4:13**

“Where shall I go from your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from your presence? <sup>8</sup> If I ascend to heaven, you are there! If I make my bed in Sheol, you are there!” **Ps 139:7-8**

- **He sees our obedience as well as our sin**

“If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. <sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. <sup>10</sup> If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.” **1 Jn 1:8-10**

“And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.” **Eph 4:30**

- He will be present when the lost are judged before the Millennium and when the lost of all the ages are judged at the Great White Throne


- He even sees those who are in hell


## 2. Satan has **access** to heaven and to God's throne


**4. There is coming a day when sin will
