

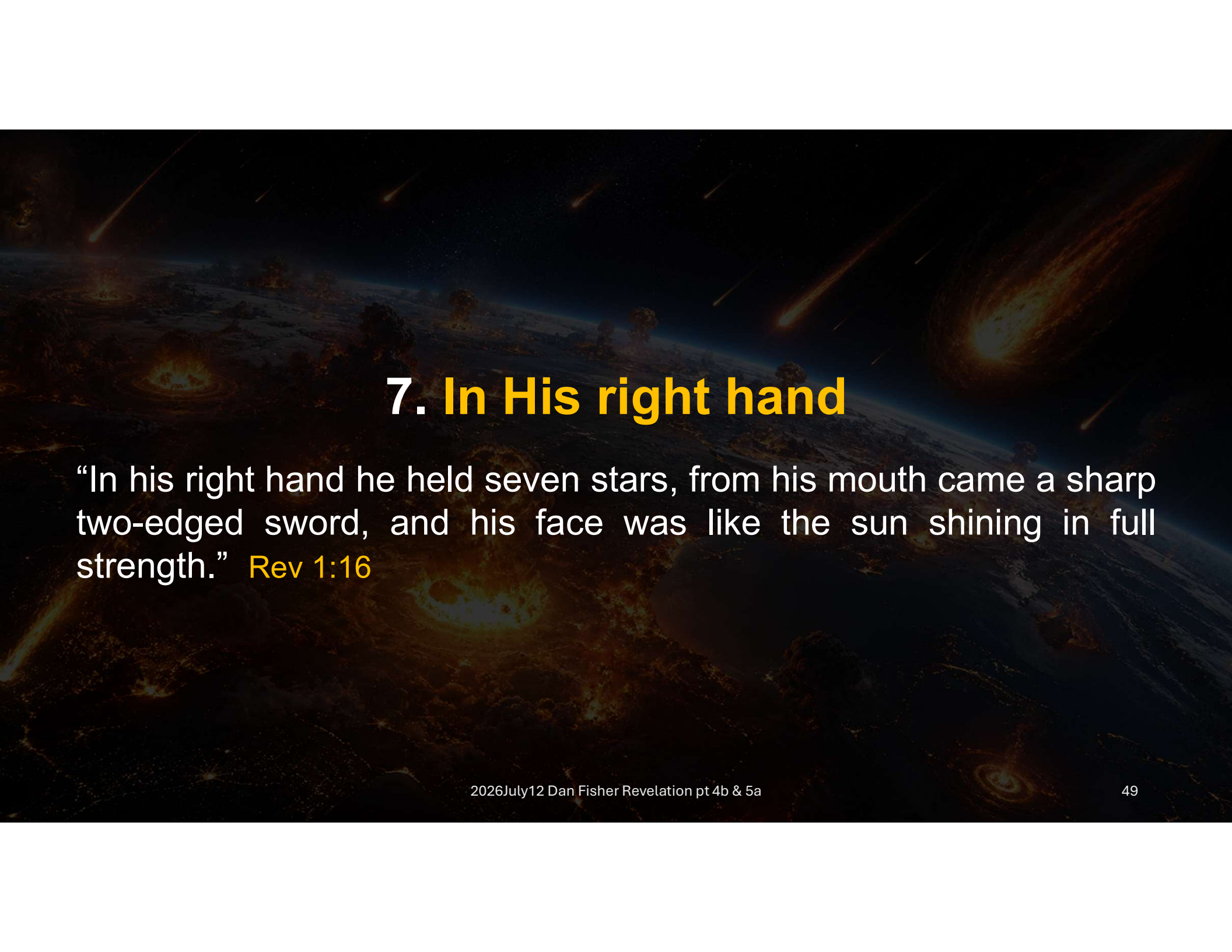

7. In His right hand

“In his right hand he held seven stars, from his mouth came a sharp two-edged sword, and his face was like the sun shining in full strength.” **Rev 1:16**

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- stars = angels = messengers = pastors

“the seven stars are the angels of the seven churches” Rev 1:20

- sword

“For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.” Heb 4:12

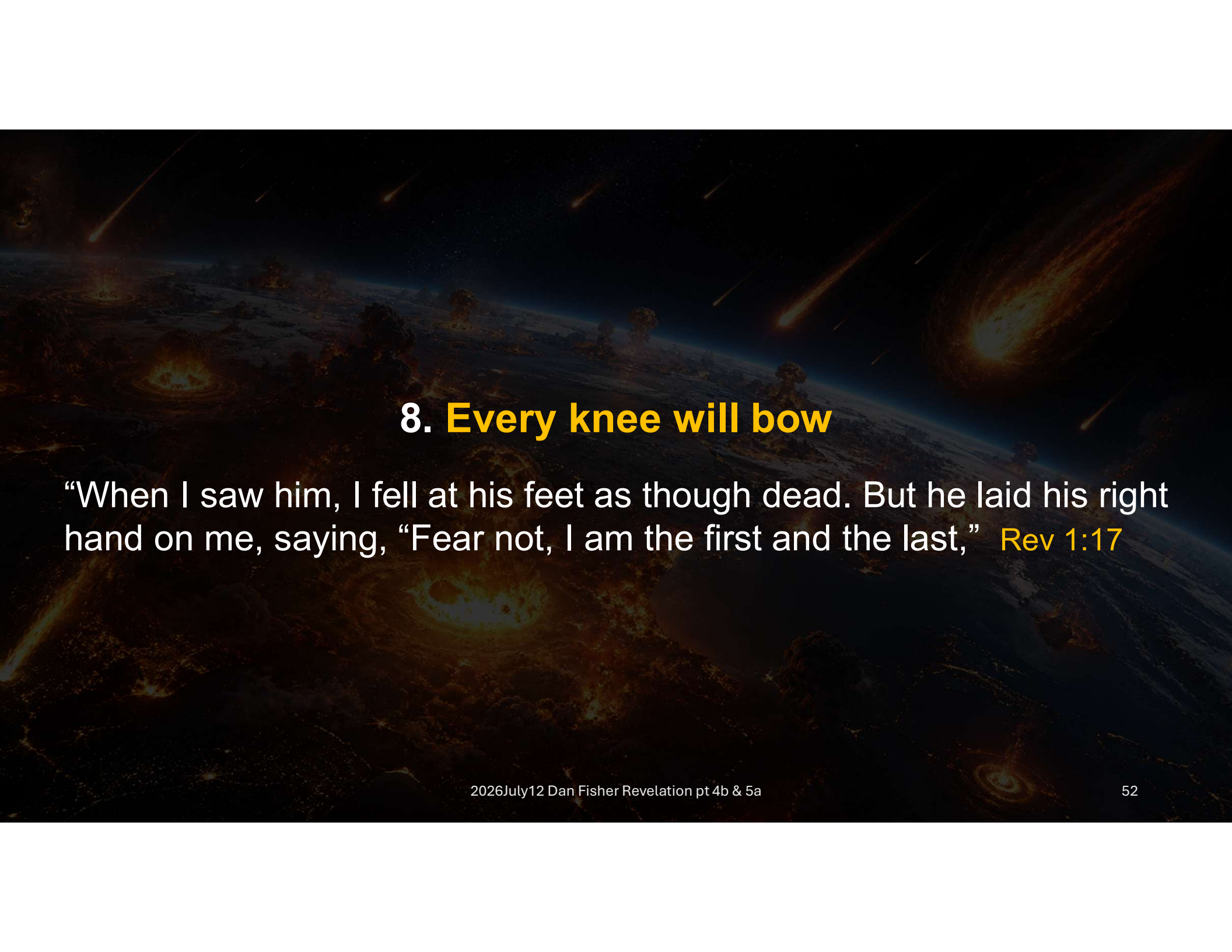
- countenance

“who alone has immortality, who dwells in unapproachable light, whom no one has ever seen or can see.” 1 Tim 6:16

“Aaron and all the people of Israel saw Moses, and behold, the skin of his face shone, and they were afraid to come near him.” Ex 34:30

“And he was transfigured before them, and his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became white as light.” Mt 17:2

- John fell like a dead man

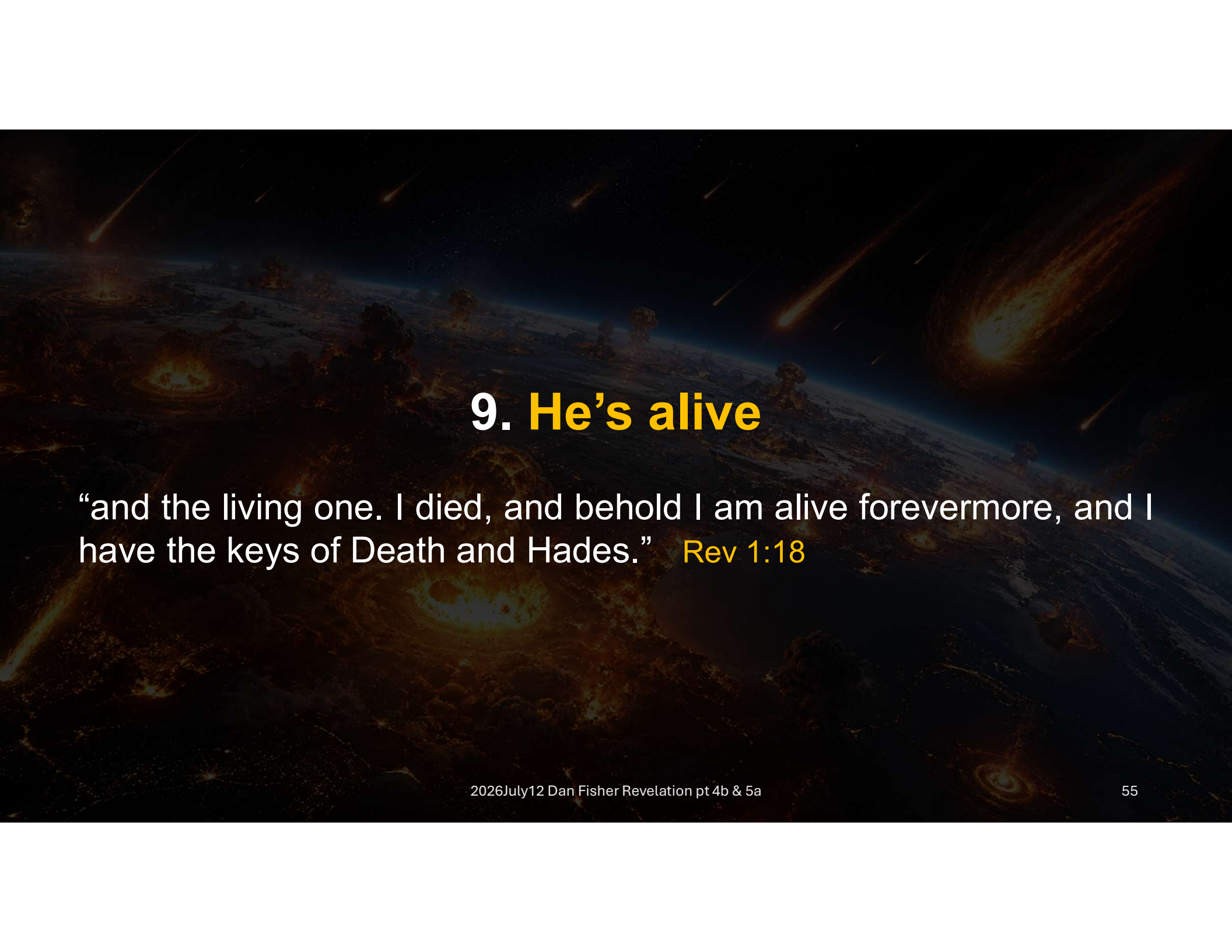

- graveyard dead

“For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, 4 that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures,” 1 Cor 15:3-4

- the keys of hell and death

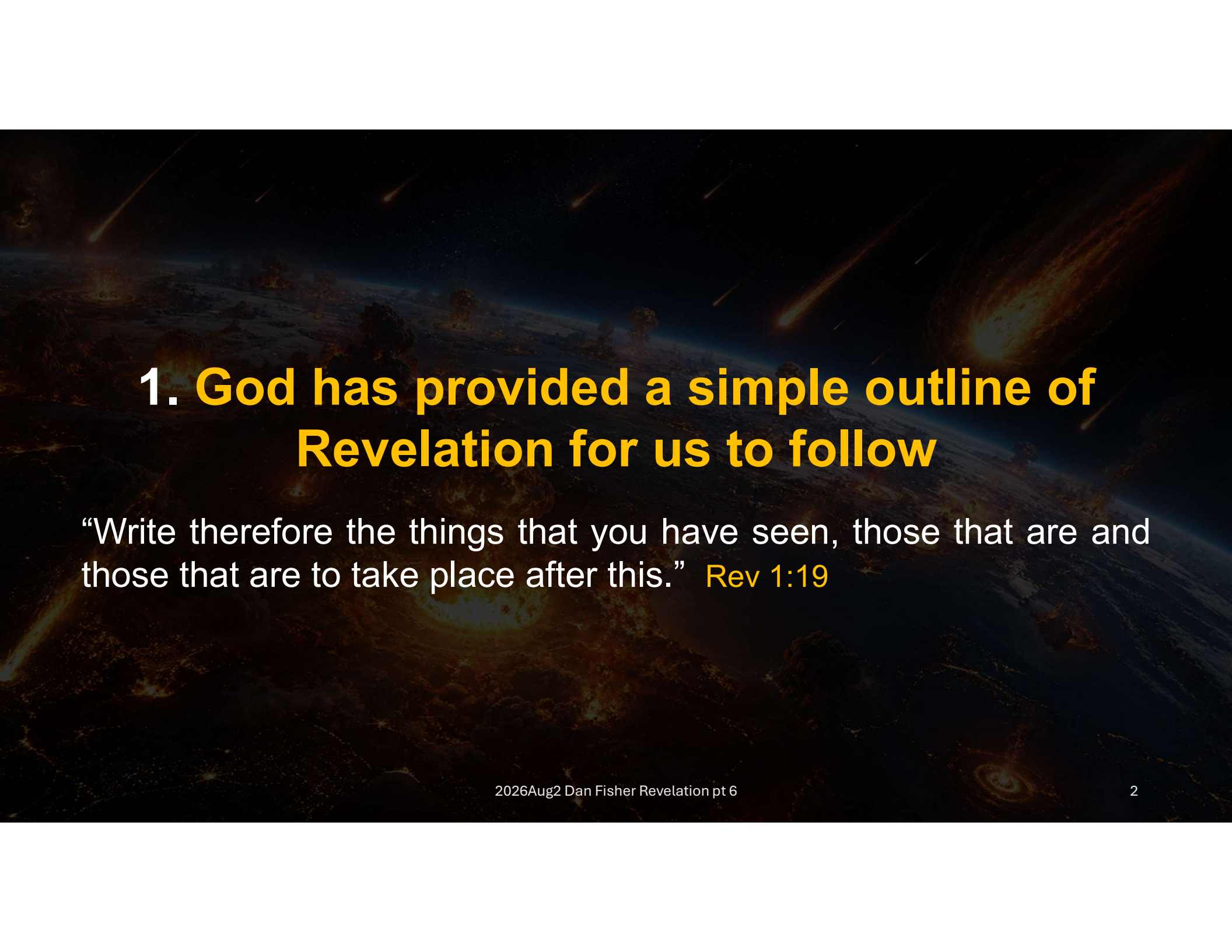

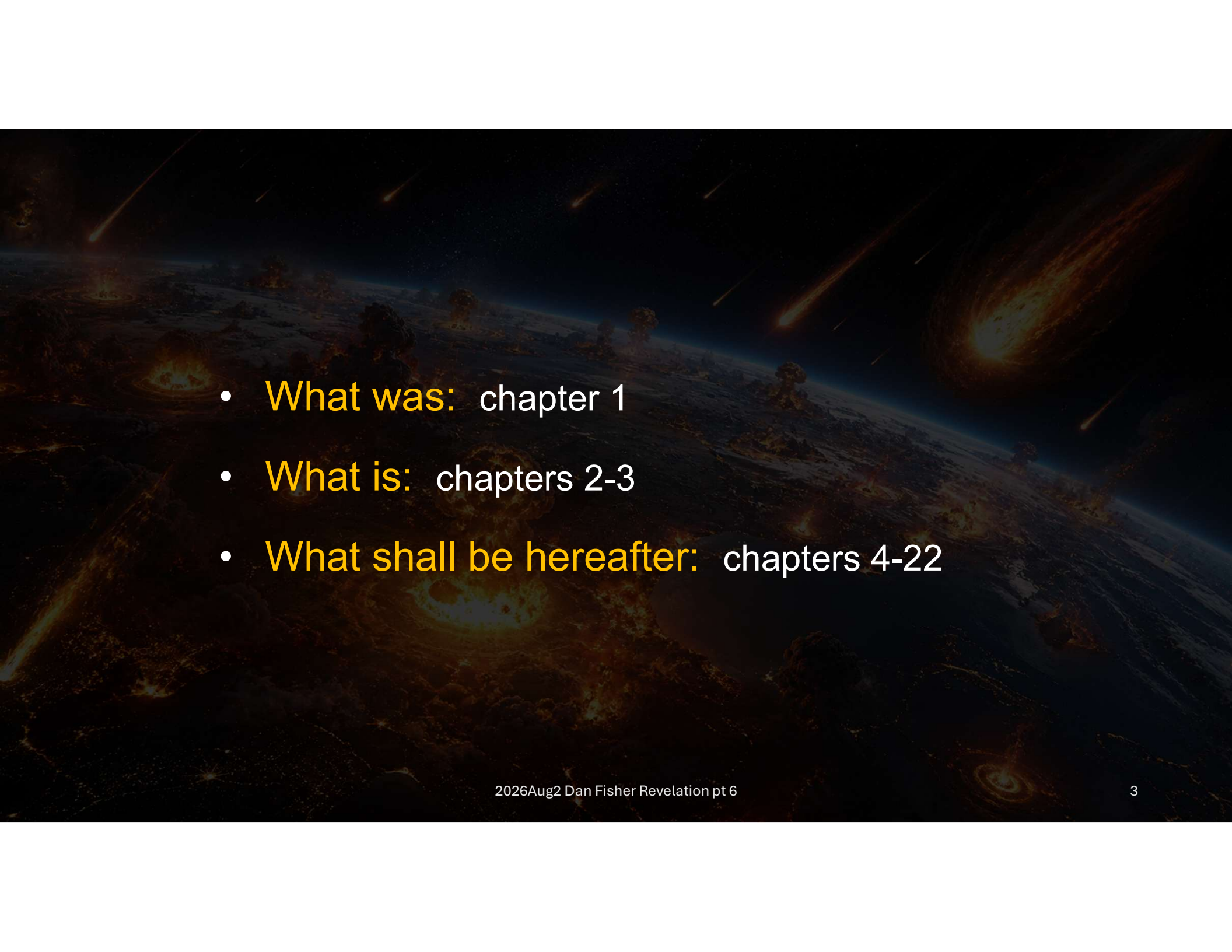

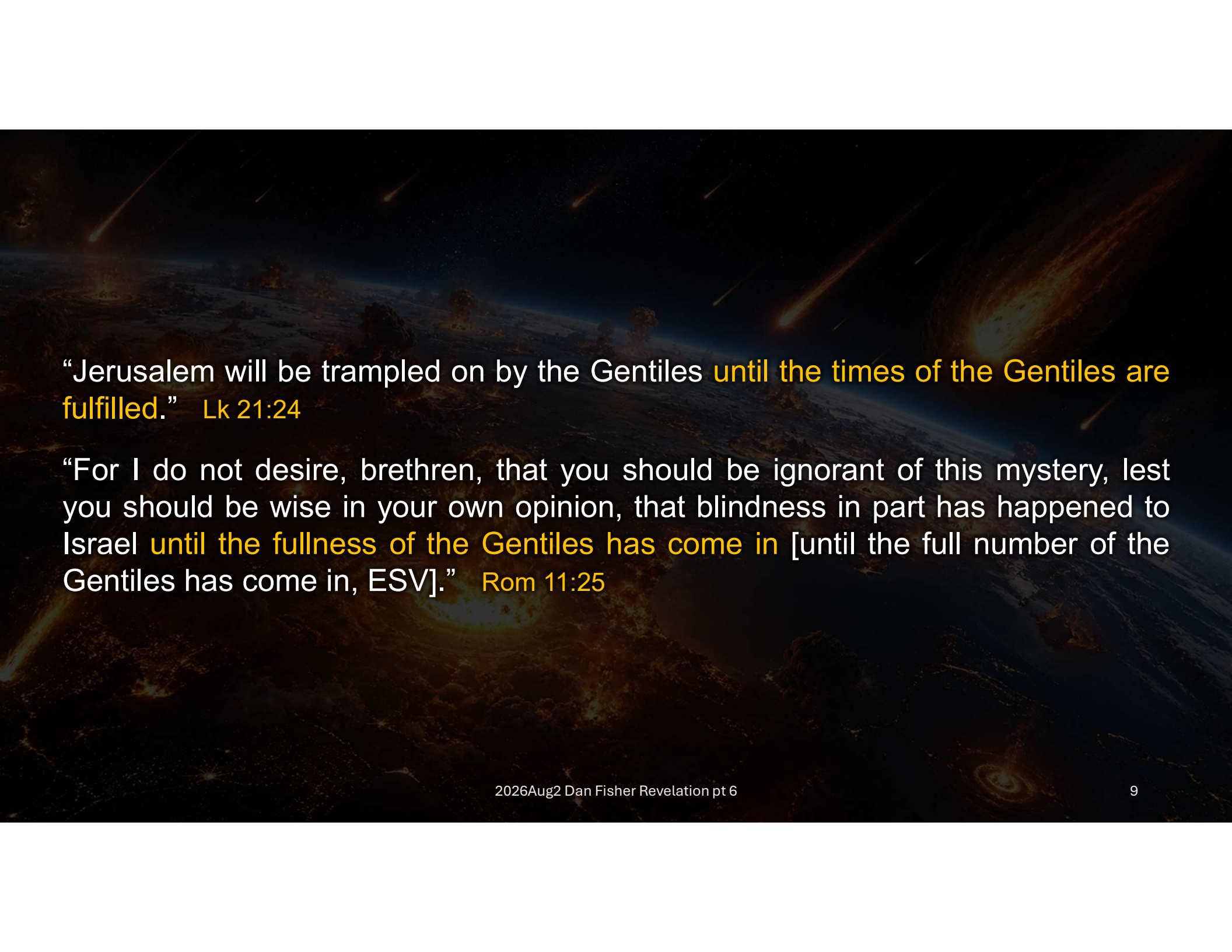
2. The messages to the seven churches can be understood in three ways:

“Jerusalem will be trampled on by the Gentiles **until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled.**” Lk 21:24

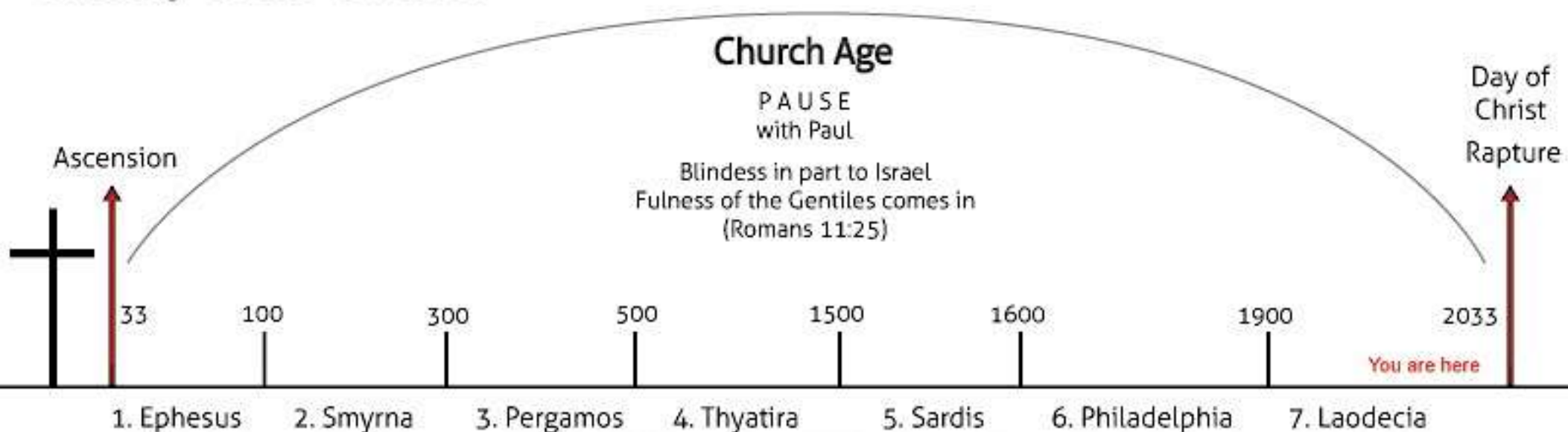

4. The churches seen dispensationally – the church age at a glance?

- **Ephesus:** 100 (church of the apostles)
- **Smyrna:** 100 – 300 (persecuted church)
- **Pergamos:** 300 – 500 (church married to Rome)
- **Thyatira:** 500- 1500 (church of middle ages)
- **Sardis:** 1500 – 1700 (reformation church)
- **Philadelphia:** 1700 – 1900 (great awakening church)
- **Laodicea:** 1900 – present (lukewarm church)
