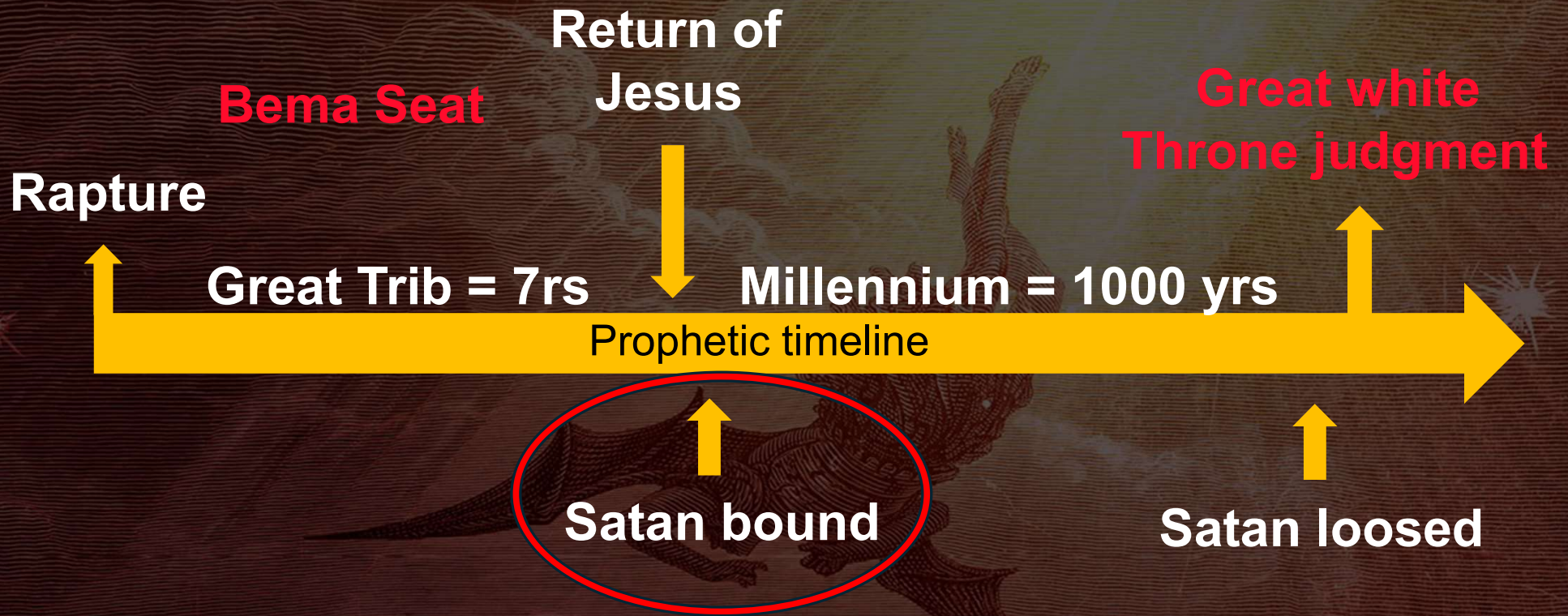

Part 4: “The Fall(s) of Satan”



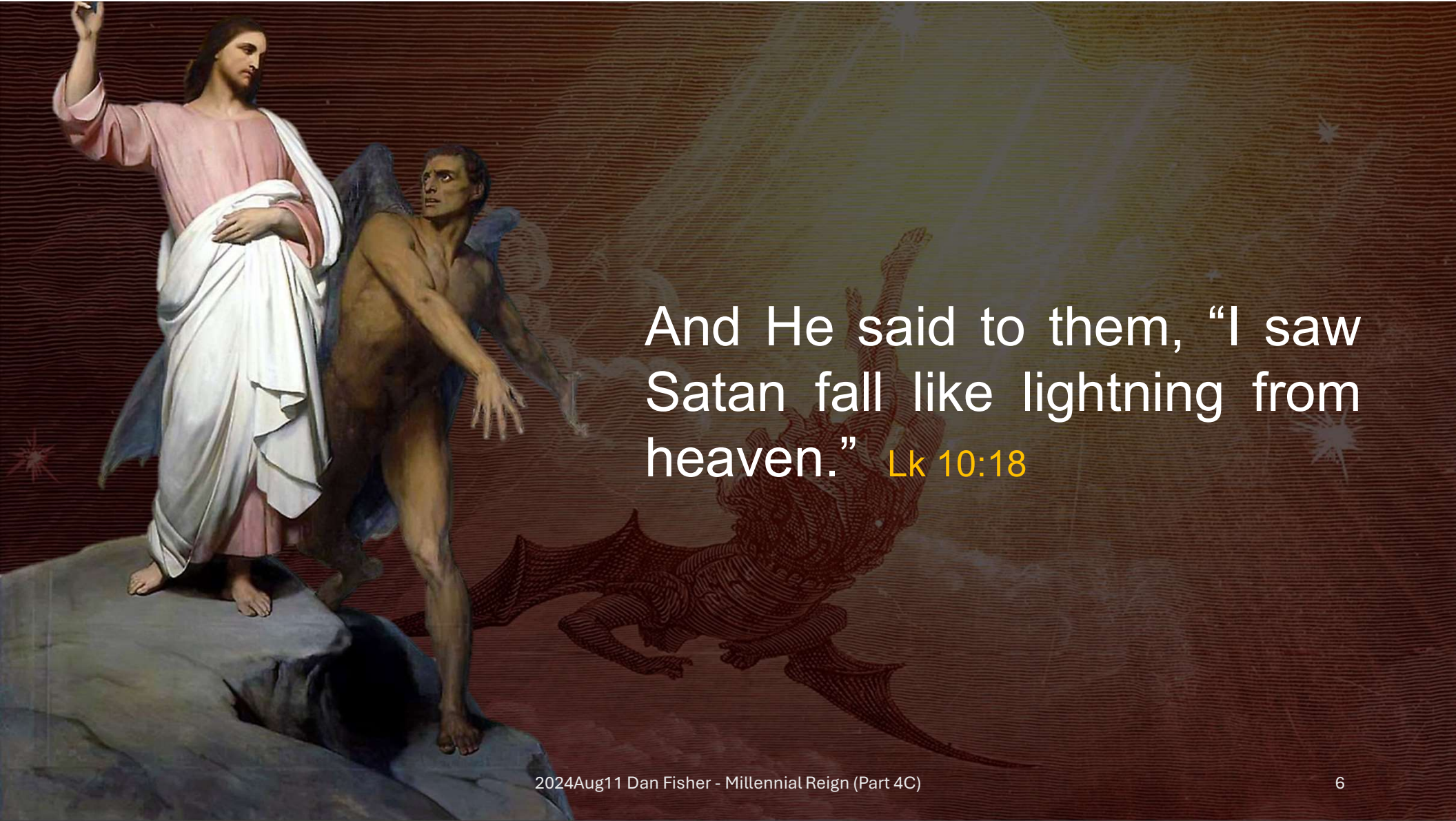


Satan is bound for the entire 1000 yrs

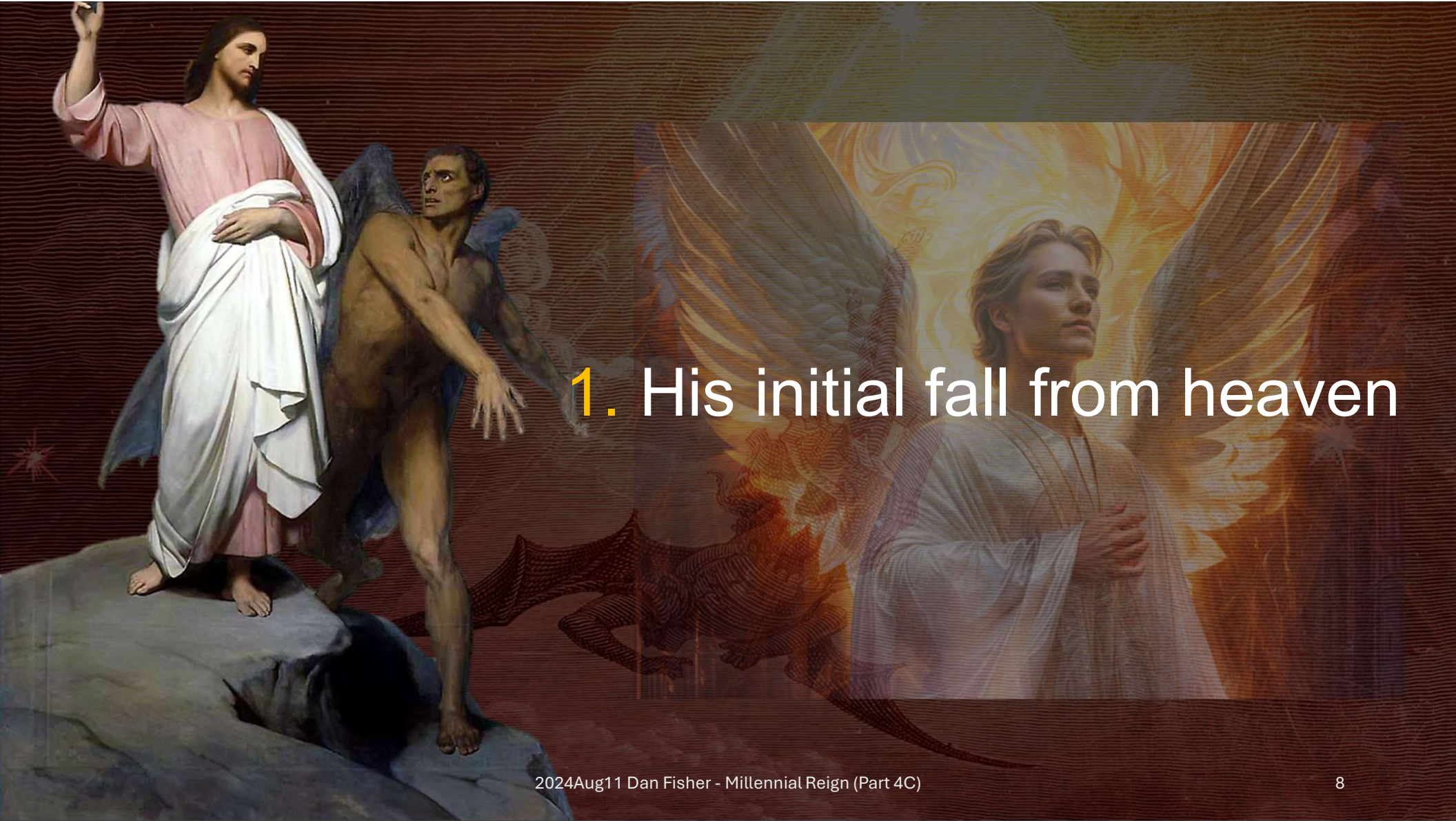

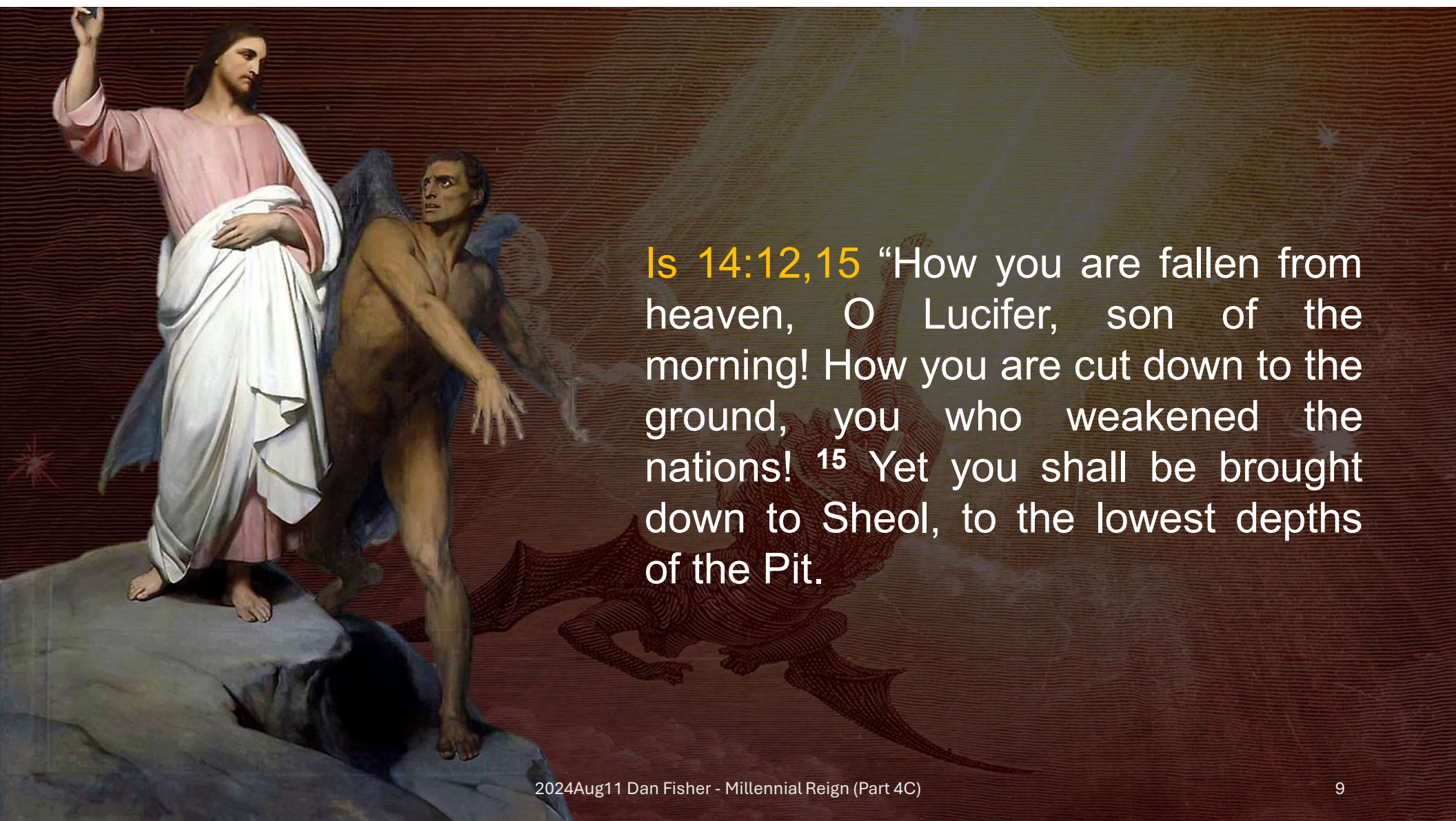


And He said to them, “I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven.” **Lk 10:18**





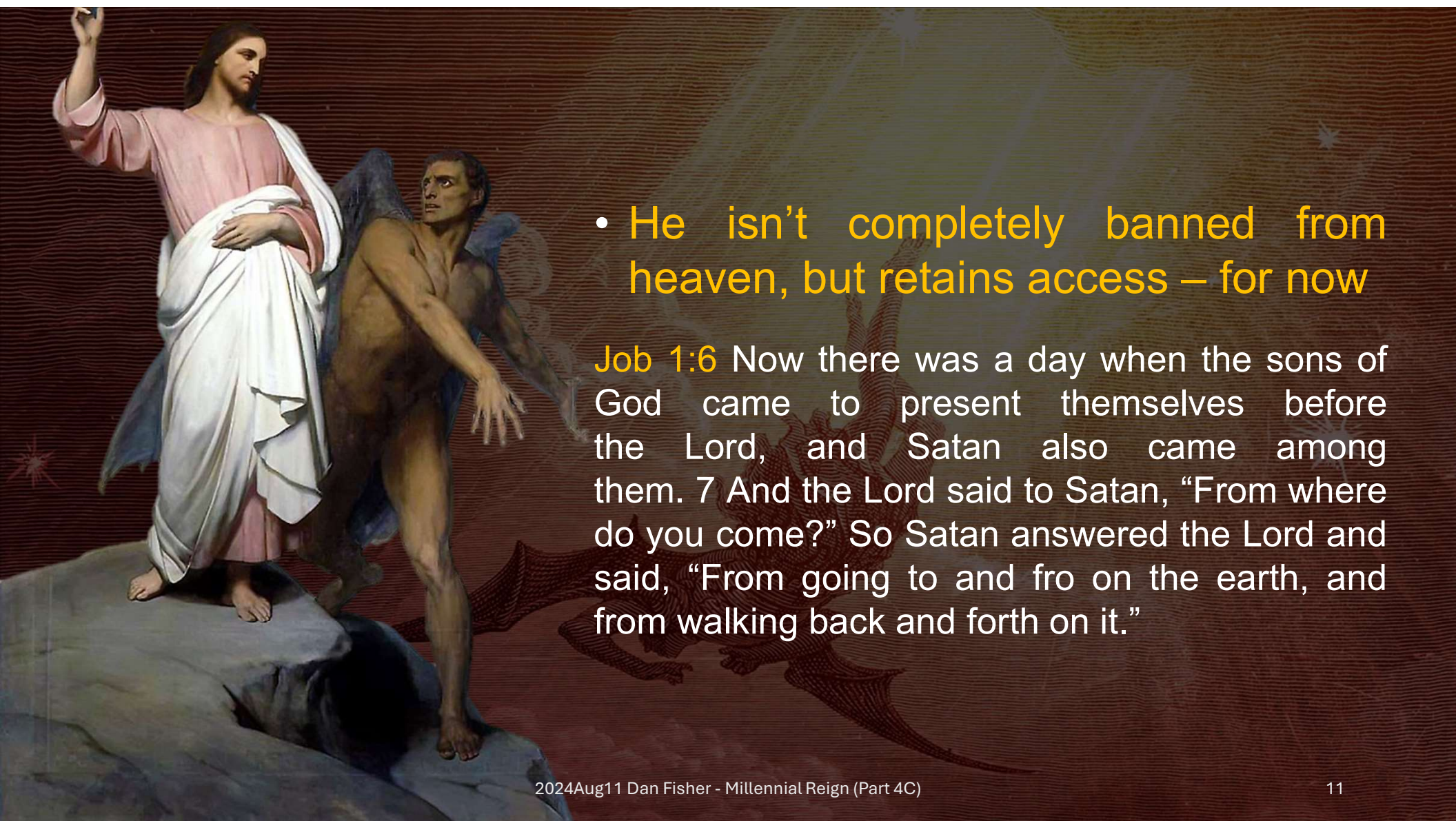
1. His initial fall from heaven



Is 14:12,15 “How you are fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! How you are cut down to the ground, you who weakened the nations! ¹⁵ Yet you shall be brought down to Sheol, to the lowest depths of the Pit.

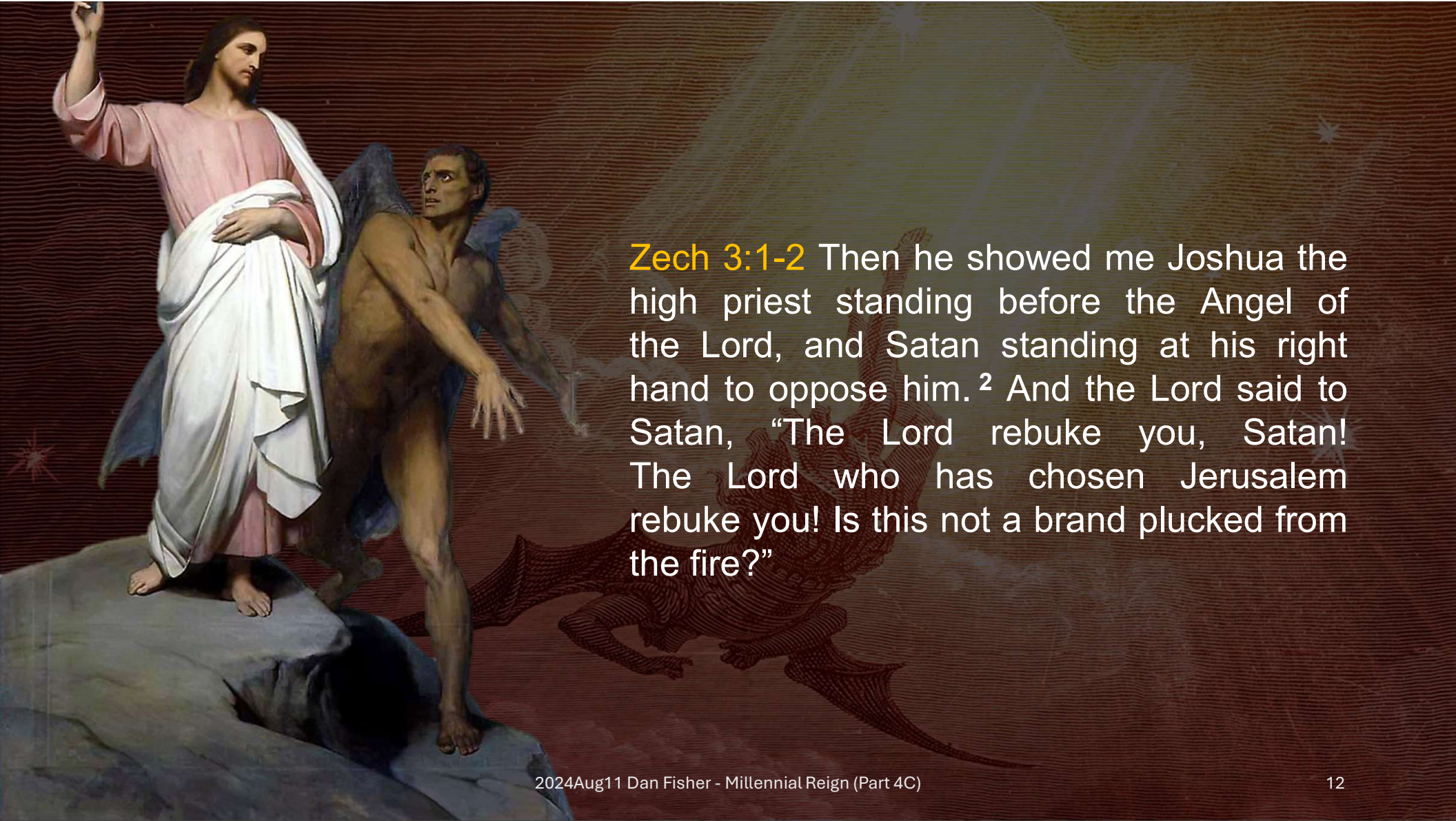


Ezk 28:16-18 Therefore I cast you as a profane thing out of the mountain of God; and I destroyed you, O covering cherub, from the midst of the fiery stones. ... ¹⁷ I cast you to the ground, I laid you before kings, that they might gaze at you. ¹⁸ Therefore I brought fire from your midst; it devoured you, and I turned you to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all who saw you.

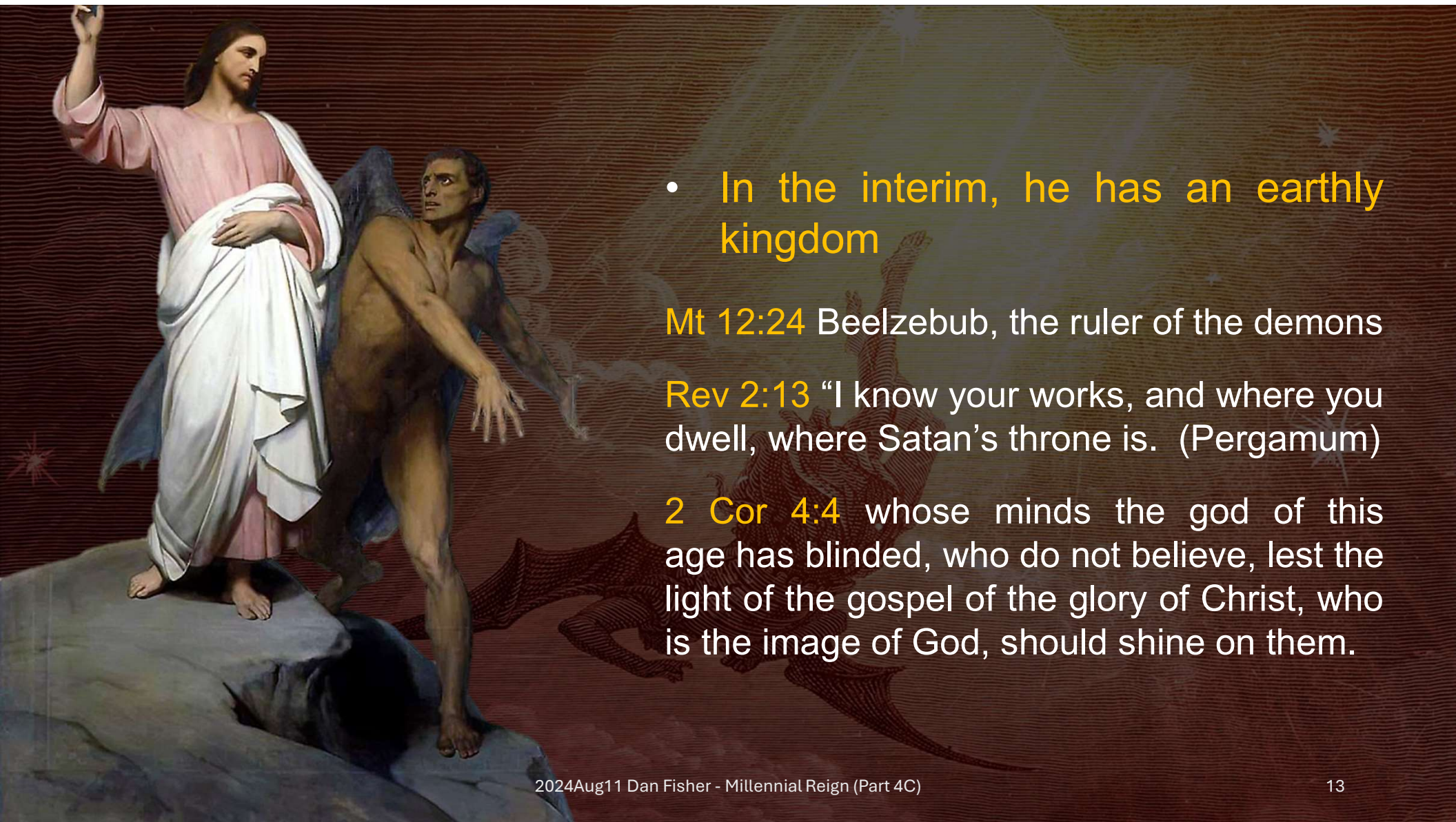


- He isn't completely banned from heaven, but retains access – for now

Job 1:6 Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the Lord, and Satan also came among them. 7 And the Lord said to Satan, "From where do you come?" So Satan answered the Lord and said, "From going to and fro on the earth, and from walking back and forth on it."



Zech 3:1-2 Then he showed me Joshua the high priest standing before the Angel of the Lord, and Satan standing at his right hand to oppose him.² And the Lord said to Satan, “The Lord rebuke you, Satan! The Lord who has chosen Jerusalem rebuke you! Is this not a brand plucked from the fire?”



- In the interim, he has an earthly kingdom

Mt 12:24 Beelzebub, the ruler of the demons

Rev 2:13 “I know your works, and where you dwell, where Satan’s throne is. (Pergamum)

2 Cor 4:4 whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them.



2. His defeat at the cross



Jn 10:10 The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.



1 Jn 3:8 He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.

Col 2:15 Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.

Heb 2:14 that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, ¹⁵ and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.




Rev 1:18 I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. And I have the keys of Hades and of Death.



Rom 16:20 And the God of peace will crush Satan under your feet shortly.

1 Pet 5:8-9 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. ⁹ Resist him, steadfast in the faith,

2 Cor 2:11 lest Satan should take advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his devices.

2 Cor 11:3 But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.

Eph 6:11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles [schemings] of the devil.

Js 4:7 Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

1 Jn 5:18 We know that whoever is born of God does not sin; but he who has been born of God keeps himself, and the wicked one does not touch him.

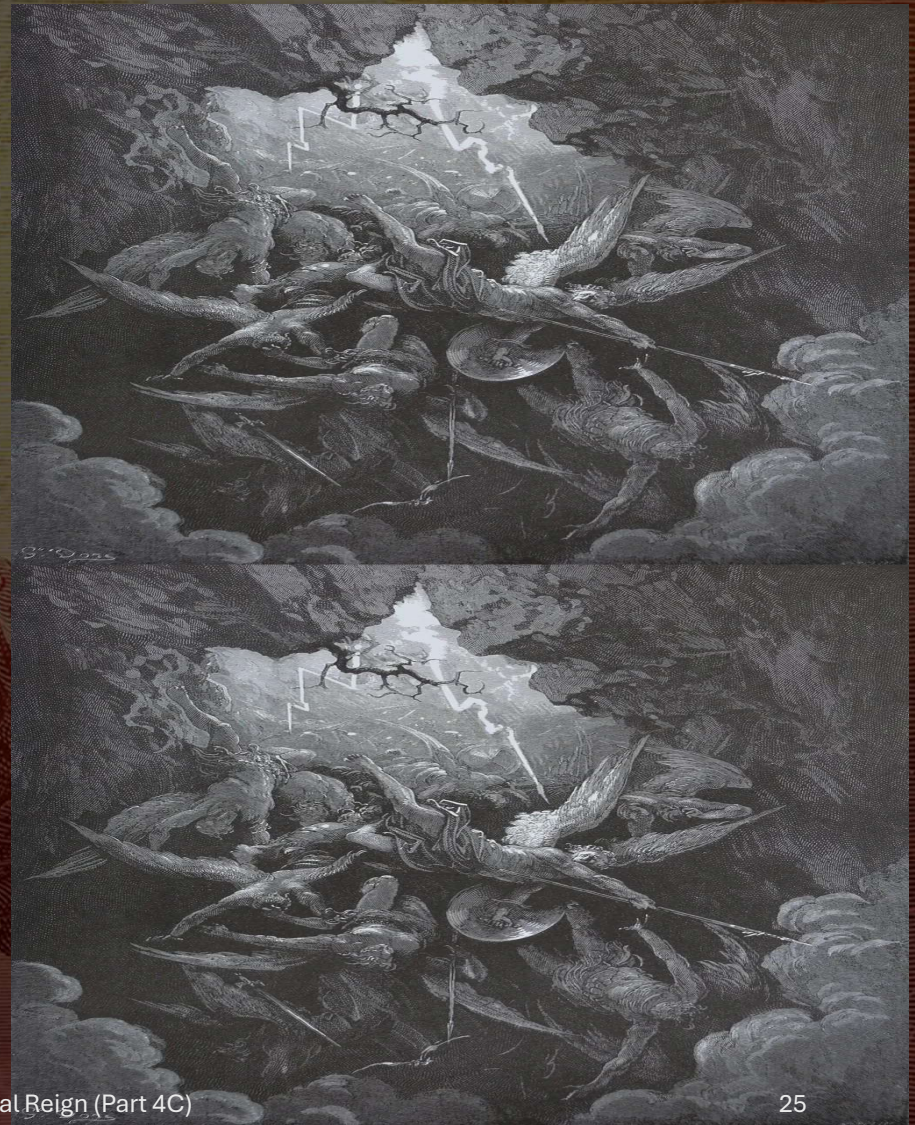

4. His incarceration in the bottomless pit


