


Consistently every year, Blacks commit almost 50% of violent crimes in the US

Official numbers from the FBI, found on the Statista website show that, when looking at the black and white populations only, in 2022, there were:

- 9655 murders committed by blacks (59.30%)
- 6629 murders committed by whites (40.70%)
- 225 blacks killed by police (36.65%)
- 389 whites killed by police (63.35%)


12.6% of the US population is Black




 All truth claims are absolute, narrow, and exclusive & therefore exclude their opposites.

If C [Christianity] is true, then anything opposed to C is false.




Gravity existed prior to Newton – Newton just discovered it.

 Truth is unchanging even though our beliefs about truth change.


When we began to believe that the earth was round instead of flat, the truth about the earth didn't change, only our belief about the earth changed.




Someone can sincerely believe the world is flat, but, that only makes that person sincerely mistaken.


Truth is not affected by the attitude of the one professing it.

An arrogant person does not make the truth he professes false & a humble person does not make the error he professes true.






- While most religions have some beliefs that are true, not all religious beliefs can be true because they are mutually exclusive.
- A self-defeating statement is one that fails to meet its own standard.




"It's true for you but not for me." See how that works with the bank, police, teacher.






- False ideas about truth lead to false ideas about life.
