


IN CONGRESS.

The Framers were not rebels, ignoring proper governmental authority & spoiling for a fight

They did not want to separate from England - their "mother country"

They believed they had exhausted all options for a peaceful solution

They believed they had a right and a responsibility to stand against tyranny

They believed that submission & cooperation are not always the biblical options

They were convinced that the real issue was not submission, but unlimited submission

They did not understand Paul to be teaching unlimited submission in Rom 13

The founding preachers did not preach unlimited submission

They appealed to the "Laws of Nature and of Nature's God"

Sir William Blackstone & John Locke identified "Nature's God" as the God of the Bible & "The Laws of Nature" as His laws


They presupposed a Creator rather than a universe formed by random chance/evolution

They believed God designed both natural laws and spiritual laws into creation


