Weekly Study: The Always God - Who Is, Who Was, and Is To Come



### Overview

God is not limited by time, surprised by circumstances, or shaken by the events that unsettle us. He has always existed in perfect power and authority, long before creation or any challenge we face. He remains fully present and active in everything that is happening in our lives today. This study invites us to place our confidence in the eternal and unchanging nature of the One who holds our past, our present, and our future with complete faithfulness.



### Scripture

*Paraphrased* **Revelation 1:8 (NLT)** “I am the Alpha and the Omega.. the beginning and the end... the one who is, who always was, and who is still to come” **Psalms 90:2** “From everlasting to everlasting, You are God” **Hebrews 13:8** “Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.” **Isaiah 43:2 (NLT)** “When you go through deep waters, I will be with you...” **Joshua 1:5 (NKJV)** “As I was with Moses, so I will be with you... I will not leave you nor forsake you.”



### Key Points

#### He Was God Before It Started

- **God existed before any problem, diagnosis, crisis, or fear ever appeared.** Before light existed, He was the Light. Before oceans formed, He was Living Water. Before mountains rose, He was the Rock of Ages.
- **Because He existed before it began, He will remain after it ends.** He was in the fire before the Hebrew boys arrived and in the lions’ den before Daniel ever touched the ground. He reminded Joshua of this truth when He said “As I was with Moses, so I will be with you... I will not leave you nor forsake you.” (Joshua 1:5)

#### He Is God While It Is Happening

- **God is not retired or inactive.** He did not stop performing miracles after the Bible was written. He is the same God today who parted seas, healed the sick, raised the dead, and delivered the bound. He is present and active in the middle of every storm and struggle we face right now.
- **Faith does not mean the storm disappears. Faith means God is present in it.** He is Alpha at the beginning, Omega at the end (Revelation 1:8), and everything in the middle. He shows up in the

impossible places and reveals Himself in the very situations that feel overwhelming.

## He Will God When It Is Over

- **God is already in the future we fear.** Whatever is coming, He is already there. He stands outside of time and sees our beginning and breakthrough at the same moment. While we panic in chapter three, He has already written chapter twelve.
- **We can rest today because He is already in tomorrow.** He is already in the exam room, the decision, the provision, the opportunity, and the outcome. Rescue is not a possibility. It is a promise, because the Always God is already waiting for us in every tomorrow.
