Weekly Study: The Always God - He's Always Speaking



### Overview

This week's study explores the central truth that **God is always speaking**, but His people often miss His voice because we are distracted, misaligned, or expecting Him to speak in a different way. Through Scripture, the Spirit, and even seasons of shaking, God continually calls His people to tune their hearts to Him. This message helps us slow down, pay attention, and respond to the God who is speaking more than we realize.



### Scripture

**Paraphrased: Matthew 11:15 (NKJV)** "He who has ears to hear, let him hear!" **Job 33:14 (CEV)** "God speaks in different ways, and we don't always recognize His voice." **Isaiah 40:8 (NLT)** "The grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of our God endures forever." **2 Timothy 3:16 (NLT)** "All Scripture is inspired by God".. **Psalms 119: 11, 15, 16 (NLT)** "I have hidden your word in my heart"... **John 16:13 (NKJV)** "However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth" ... **Revelation 3:22** "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches." **Hebrews 12:26-27 (NLT)** "When God spoke from Mount Sinai His voice shook the earth"... **Matthew 24:** "There will be wars and rumors of wars.. As in the days of Noah.. so shall it be when the Son of Man returns."



### Key Points

#### God Speaks Through the Scripture

- **His Word is the primary, unchanging voice of God.** Scripture reveals God's will, character, and direction. Feelings shift, culture changes, and opinions fade but *"the word of our God endures forever."* Every other voice must be filtered through the Word.
- **Access isn't the issue, appetite is.** We have Bibles everywhere, yet many believers are spiritually starving because the Word is not being read, studied, or hidden in the heart. God is speaking, but we must commit to opening the Scriptures, reading and studying to hear Him.

#### God Speaks Through the Spirit

- **The Holy Spirit is always guiding, prompting, and revealing truth.** Jesus promised the Spirit would "guide you into all truth" and "speak what He hears." The Spirit is not silent but is active,

present, and speaking daily to believers.

- **We often miss His voice because we're tuned to the wrong "frequency".** In today's world, distractions, noise, busyness, and competing voices drown out the Spirit's leading. When we tune our hearts to Him, clarity comes, wisdom flows, and God's direction becomes unmistakable.

### God Speaks Through the Shaking

- **Shaking exposes what is unstable and reveals what is eternal.** Just as God shook Mount Sinai, He still shakes things to reveal what is inside us like our faith, fears, priorities, and foundations.
- **Shaking is not punishment but preparation.** Seasons of disruption refine us, awaken us, and call us back to dependence on God. In global shaking and personal shaking, God is speaking, aligning, and readying His people for His return.
