



## PRAYER GUIDE

### I. **“Our Father / which art in heaven, / Hallowed be thy name.”**

- A. Picture Christ on the cross and thank God you can call Him Father by virtue of the blood of Jesus.
- B. Focus on the names of God corresponding with the five benefits in the New Covenant, and make your faith declaration.

- D. IN Nation (city, state and national political and spiritual leaders, a specific nation)

### III. **“Give us this day our daily bread.”**

- A. Are you living in the will of God (prayer life, church, work habits, obedience in giving)?
- B. Believe it is God’s will to be your provision and protection.
- C. Be specific.
- D. Be tenacious.

### IV. **“And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.”**

- A. Ask God to forgive you.
- B. Forgive and release others.
- C. Set your will to forgive those who sin against you.

V. **“And lead us not into temptation, but DELIVER US FROM EVIL.”**  
**Put on the whole armor of God, the Lord Jesus Christ. Eph. 6:10-18**

1. **The belt of TRUTH.**

**John 14:6** Jesus answered, “I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.”

**Exodus 20:16** “You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.”

**John 8:32** “Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.”

2. **Breastplate of RIGHTEOUSNESS.**

**Rom. 1:16-17** “For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile. <sup>17</sup> For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed—a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: “The righteous will live by faith.”

**I John 3:7-10** “Dear children, do not let anyone lead you astray. The one who does what is right is righteous, just as he is righteous. <sup>8</sup> The one who does what is sinful is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil’s work. <sup>9</sup> No one who is born of God will continue to sin, because God’s seed remains in them; they cannot go on sinning, because they have been born of God.<sup>10</sup> This is how we know who the children of God are and who the children of the devil are: Anyone who does not do what is right is not God’s child, nor is anyone who does not love their brother and sister.”

3. **Shoes ready to move toward PEACE.**

**Psalms 34:14** “Turn from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it.”

**Isaiah 26:3** “You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you.”

**I Corinthians 7:15** “But if the unbeliever leaves, let it be so. The brother or the sister is not bound in such circumstances; God has called us to live in peace.”

**Colossians 3:15** “Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful.”

4. **Shield of FAITH.**

**Galatians 2:20** “I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.”

**Habakkuk 2:4** “See, the enemy is puffed up; his desires are not upright— but the righteous person will live by faith—”

**Matthew 17:20** He replied, “Because you have so little faith. Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you.”

**Matthew 9:29** Then he touched their eyes and said, “According to your faith let it be done to you.”

**Romans 1:17** “The righteous will live by faith.”

**2 Corinthians 5:17** “Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!”

## 5. **Helmet of SALVATION.**

**Psalm 51:12** “Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.”

**Psalm 62:2** “Truly he is my rock and my salvation; he is my fortress, I will never be shaken.”

**Acts 4:12** “Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved.”

**Isaiah 25:9** “Surely this is our God; we trusted in him, and he saved us. This is the Lord, we trusted in him; let us rejoice and be glad in his salvation.”

## 6. **Sword of the Spirit = WORD OF GOD.**

**Psalm 119:11,105,160** “I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you. Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path. All your words are true; all your righteous laws are eternal.”

**Colossians 3:16** “Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.”

**Hebrews 4:12** “For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.”

**James 1:22** “Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.”

**Matthew 24:35** “Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.”

**John 6:68** Simon Peter answered him, “Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.”

## 7. **PRAY always in the SPIRIT.**

**2 Chronicles 7:14** “If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.”

**Matthew 5:44** “But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you,”  
**1 Thessalonians 5:17** “pray continually”

**James 5:13-16** “Is anyone among you in trouble? Let them pray. Is anyone happy? Let them sing songs of praise. <sup>14</sup> Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. <sup>15</sup> And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven. <sup>16</sup> Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.”

## 8. **PRAY for a HEDGE OF PROTECTION.**

**Job. 1:10** “Have you not put a hedge around him and his household and everything he has? You have blessed the work of his hands, so that his flocks and herds are spread throughout the land.”

(The Lord is your refuge, your fortress, your God; in Him will you trust.)

### 1. **MAKE THE LORD YOUR RESTING PLACE.**

**Psalm 91:2** “I will say of the Lord, “He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust.”

## 2. SET YOUR MIND ON THE LORD.

**Psalm 27:4-6** “One thing I ask from the Lord, this only do I seek that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life to gaze on the beauty of the Lord and to seek him in his temple. For in the day of trouble he will keep me safe in his dwelling; he will hide me in the shelter of his sacred tent and set me high upon a rock. Then my head will be exalted above the enemies who surround me; at his sacred tent I will sacrifice with shouts of joy; I will sing and make music to the Lord.”

**Psalm 91:10-11** “no harm will overtake you, no disaster will come near your tent. For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways;”

**Psalm 34:7** “The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear him and He delivers them.”

## 3. YOU KNOW HIS NAME.

**Proverbs 18:10** “The name of the Lord is a fortified tower; the righteous run to it and are safe.

## VI. “For thine is the KINGDOM, and the POWER, and the GLORY, forever.”

### A. HIS KINGDOM

**Psalm 22:28** “for dominion belongs to the Lord and he rules over the nations.”

**Matthew 6:13** “And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.”

**Luke 12:32** “Do not be afraid, little flock, for your Father has been pleased to give you the kingdom.”

**Colossians 1:12-14** “and giving joyful thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of his holy people in the kingdom of light. <sup>13</sup> For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, <sup>14</sup> in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.”

**2 Timothy 4:18** “The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and will bring me safely to his heavenly kingdom. To him be glory forever and ever. Amen.”

### B. HIS POWER

**I Chronicles 29:12** “Wealth and honor come from you; you are the ruler of all things. In your hands are strength and power to exalt and give strength to all.”

**Psalm 21:13** “Be exalted in your strength, Lord; we will sing and praise your might.”

**Psalm 66:7** “He rules forever by his power, his eyes watch the nations—let not the rebellious rise up against him.”

**Psalm 68:35** “You, God, are awesome in your sanctuary; the God of Israel gives power and strength to his people. Praise be to God!”

**Jeremiah 10:12** “But God made the earth by his power; he founded the world by his wisdom and stretched out the heavens by his understanding.”

**Deuteronomy 8:18** “But remember the Lord your God, for it is he who gives you the ability to produce wealth, and so confirms his covenant, which he swore to your ancestors, as it is today.”

**Isaiah 40:29** “He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.”

**I Peter 1:5** “who through faith are shielded by God’s power until the coming of the salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time.”

**I Corinthians 6:14** “By his power God raised the Lord from the dead, and he will raise us also.”

**Luke 10:19** “I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you.”

**Luke 24:49** “I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high.”

**Acts 1:8** “But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

**Ephesians 6:10** “Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power.”

**I Corinthians 4:20** “For the kingdom of God is not a matter of talk but of power.”

### C. HIS GLORY

**Psalms 24:8** “Who is this King of glory? The Lord strong and mighty, the Lord mighty in battle.”

**I Chronicles 16:27** “Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and joy are in his dwelling place.”

**Hebrews 2:9-10** “But we do see Jesus, who was made lower than the angels for a little while, now crowned with glory and honor because he suffered death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone.<sup>10</sup> In bringing many sons and daughters to glory, it was fitting that God, for whom and through whom everything exists, should make the pioneer of their salvation perfect through what he suffered.”

**Romans 8:17-18** “Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.”

**I Peter 5:10** “And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast.”

**I Thessalonians 2:11-12** “For you know that we dealt with each of you as a father deals with his own children,<sup>12</sup> encouraging, comforting and urging you to live lives worthy of God, who calls you into his kingdom and glory.”

**Psalms 145:10-13** “All your works praise you, Lord; your faithful people extol you. They tell of the glory of your kingdom and speak of your might, so that all people may know of your mighty acts and the glorious splendor of your kingdom. Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and your dominion endures through all generations. The Lord is trustworthy in all he promises and faithful in all he does.”

**I Chronicles 29:10-13** <sup>10</sup> David praised the Lord in the presence of the whole assembly, saying, “Praise be to you, Lord, the God of our father Israel, from everlasting to everlasting. Yours, Lord, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the majesty and the splendor, for everything in heaven and earth is yours. Yours, Lord, is the kingdom; you are exalted as head over all. Wealth and honor come from you; you are the ruler of all things. In your hands are strength and power to exalt and give strength to all. Now, our God, we give you thanks, and praise your glorious name.”

**Psalm 68:19** “Praise be to the Lord, to God our Savior, who daily bears our burdens.”

**Psalm 89:5** “The heavens praise your wonders, Lord, your faithfulness too, in the assembly of the holy ones.”

**Psalm 119:175** “Let me live that I may praise you, and may your laws sustain me.”

**Psalm 139:14** “I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well.”

**Psalm 145:21** “My mouth will speak in praise of the Lord. Let every creature praise his holy name for ever and ever.”

**Psalm 150:1-6.** “Praise the Lord. Praise God in his sanctuary; praise him in his mighty heavens. Praise him for his acts of power; praise him for his surpassing greatness. Praise him with the sounding of the trumpet, praise him with the harp and lyre, praise him with timbrel and dancing, praise him with the strings and pipe, praise him with the clash of cymbals, praise him with resounding cymbals. Let everything that has breath praise the Lord. Praise the Lord.”
