


A New Way to Live Hebrews

Hebrews 10:19-25

"Therefore, brothers and sisters, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, his body, and since we have a great priest over the house of God, <u>let us draw</u> <u>near to God</u> with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. Let us <u>hold unswervingly to the hope we profess</u>, for <u>he who promised</u> <u>is faithful</u>. And let us <u>consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good</u> <u>deeds</u>, <u>not giving up meeting together</u>, as some are in the habit of doing, but <u>encouraging one another</u>—and all the more as you see the Day approaching."

- You can hold onto the faith you profess, not because of your grip on it, but because of His grip on you.
