How to know the Will of God?

Is this decision consistent with the Word of God?

Is this a wise decision? What will be the consequences?

Do I have genuine peace about this decision?

Does it fit who I am as a follower of Jesus Christ? Language, actions, responses, testimony, witness, influence.

Will this decision honor God?

Will this decision result in unrest and regret.

Obstacles to Gods Will

Our own will An exalted view of God brings a clear view of sin, and a realistic view of self. A diminished view of God brings a reduced concern for sin, and an inflated view of self.

Influence of other people Let God speak to you learn to hear his voice.

Ignorance of God's Word You won't know Gods will if you don't know Him and His word.

Impatience - Learning to wait on God His timing is perfect Learning to trust God <u>and leave the consequences to Him</u> THAT'S LIVING BY FAITH

Sin in our life Deafens our ears to the voice of God Blinds our eyes to the vision of God Hardens our hearts to our awareness of God (God does not bless sin, disobedience and indifference to Him and His Word) Dulls our conscience to the Word of God Sin will take you farther than you wanted to go Keep you longer than you wanted to stay

Doubt God has a personal plan/will for my life He'll walk with us through that plan He'll provide everything we need There will be difficulty, hardship, pain, suffering and loss He will work all things together - Romans 8:28

Too Busy It takes time to be a Godly person He desires to spend time with you

Fears Fear of what God may require God will only require what He knows you can do with His help

Failure We all fail. We all sin. Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23 Failure isn't final Don't turn a moment into a monument
