Revelation 15 – The Last Judgments

“I saw in heaven another great and marvelous sign: seven angels with the seven last plagues—last, because with them God’s wrath is completed. And I saw what looked like a sea of glass glowing with fire and, standing beside the sea, those who had been victorious over the beast and its image and over the number of its name.” - Revelation 15:1-2

“They triumphed over him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony; they did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death.” - Revelation 12:11

“They held harps given them by God and sang the song of God’s servant Moses and of the Lamb: “Great and marvelous are your deeds, Lord God Almighty. Just and true are your ways, King of the nations. Who will not fear you, Lord, and bring glory to your name? For you alone are holy. All nations will come and worship before you, for your righteous acts have been revealed.” – Revelation 15:2-4

Reminder: Gods love includes glory and judgment.

The Seven Bowls of God’s Wrath - Talked about

“Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying to the seven angels, “Go, pour out the seven bowls of God’s wrath on the earth.” The first angel went and poured out his bowl on the land, and ugly, festering sores broke out on the people who had the mark of the beast and worshiped its image. The second angel poured out his bowl on the sea, and it turned into blood like that of a dead person, and every living thing in the sea died. The third angel poured out his bowl on the rivers and springs of water, and they became blood. Revelation 16 – Bowl Judgments - Delivered

Remember: The Ten plagues when Moses confronted Pharaoh with the wrath of God.

- (i) The water made into blood (Exodus 7:20-25).
- (ii) The frogs (Exodus 8:5-14).
- (iii) The lice (Exodus 8:16-18).
- (iv) The flies (Exodus 8:20-24).
- (v) The plague on the cattle (Exodus 9:3-6).
- (vi) The boils and sores (Exodus 9:8-11).
- (vii) The thunder and the hail (Exodus 9:22-26).
- (viii) The locusts (Exodus 10:12-19).
- (ix) The darkness (Exodus 10:21-23).
- (x) The slaying of the firstborn (Exodus 12:29-30).
