## Psalm 88 NIV

Lord, you are the God who saves me; day and night I cry out to you. May my prayer come before you; turn your ear to my cry. I am overwhelmed with troubles and my life draws near to death. I am counted among those who go down to the pit; I am like one without strength. I am set apart with the dead, like the slain who lie in the grave, whom you remember no more, who are cut off from your care.

<sup>6</sup> You have put me in the lowest pit, in the darkest depths. Your wrath lies heavily on me; you have overwhelmed me with all your waves. You have taken from me my closest friends and have made me repulsive to them. I am confined and cannot escape; my eyes are dim with grief. I call to you, Lord, every day; I spread out my hands to you.

10 Do you show your wonders to the dead? Do their spirits rise up and praise you? Is your love declared in the grave, your faithfulness in Destruction? Are your wonders known in the place of darkness, or your righteous deeds in the land of oblivion? But I cry to you for help, Lord; in the morning my prayer comes before you. ## 65 of the 150 psalms can be classified as laments

The Theological Purpose of Biblical Laments are to provide us blueprints for how we are to interact with God during these seasons of disorientation.

## Laments are prayers that follow a pattern of

- 1. Address to God
- 2. Description of complaint
- 3. Request for God's help
- 4. Expression of trust in God

#### 1. Address to God:

<sup>1</sup> Lord, you are the God who saves me;

Psalms of lament are prayers that orient us to stand face to face with God in the middle of whatever difficulties we are going through.
