pistos ΠΙΣΤΟΣ
pistis ΠΙΣΤΙΣ
pisteuo ΠΙΣΤΕΥΩ

pistos (πιστός) is a status
pertaining to being
worthy of belief or trust.

*“God is faithful (pistos),
who has called you into fellowship
with his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.”*

- 1 Corinthians 1:9

*"...if we are faithless,
he remains faithful (pistos)"*

- 2 Timothy 2:13

pistis (πίστις) is the commitment
of believing or being loyal.

pisteuo (πιστεύω) faith (general sense)
