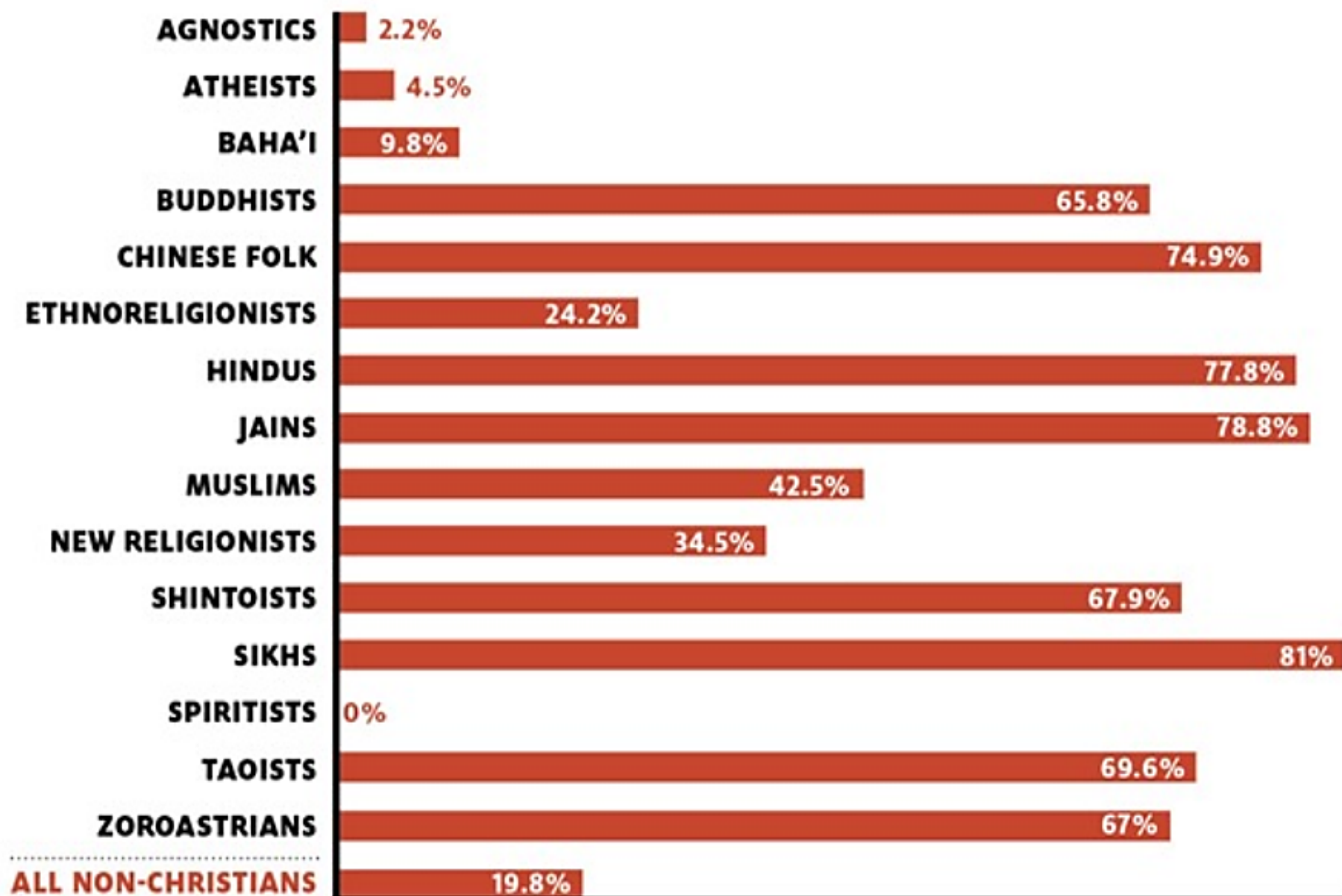

His purpose was for the nations to seek after God and perhaps feel their way toward him and find him—though he is not far from any one of us.

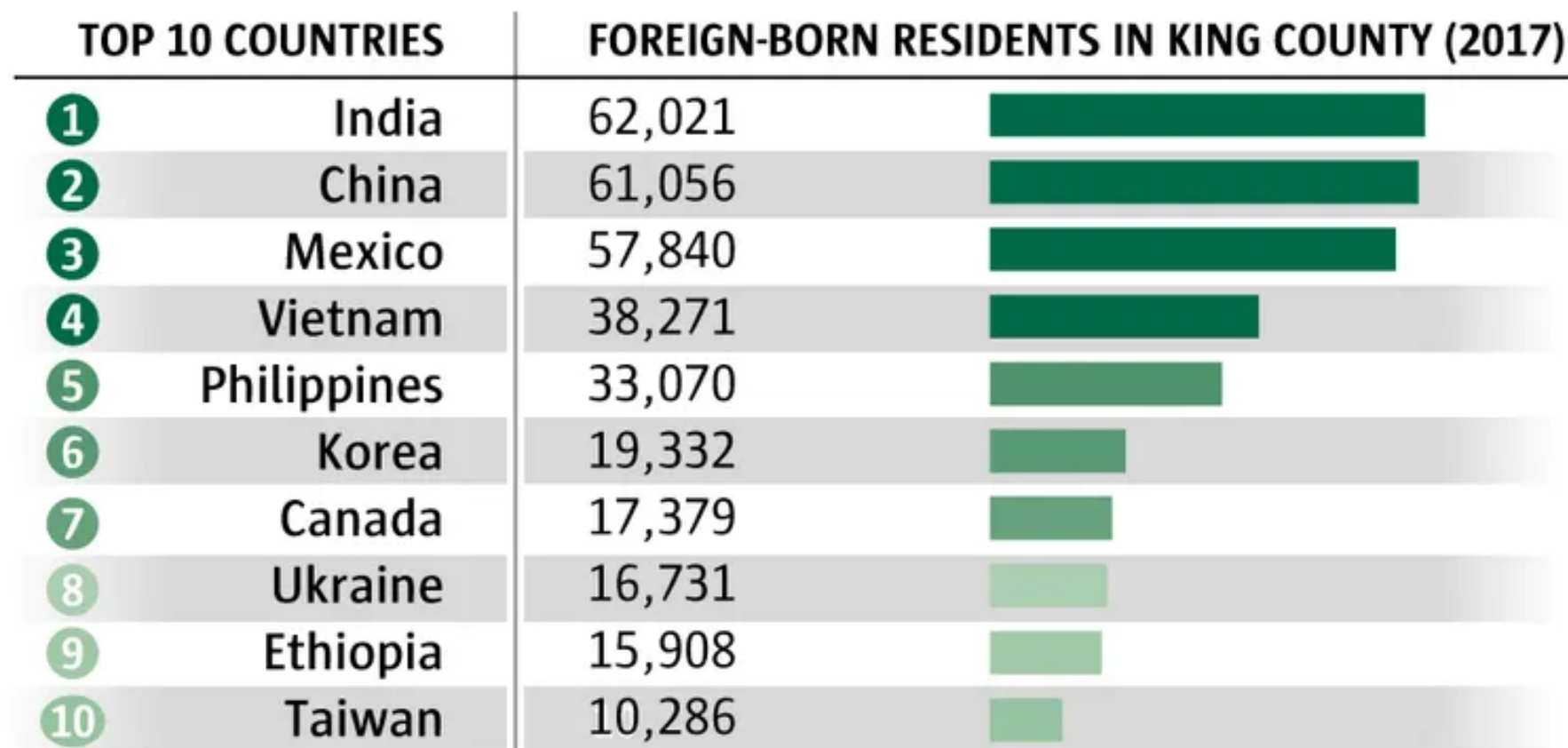

The top 10 countries for King County's foreign-born population represent Asia, Africa, Europe and the Americas.



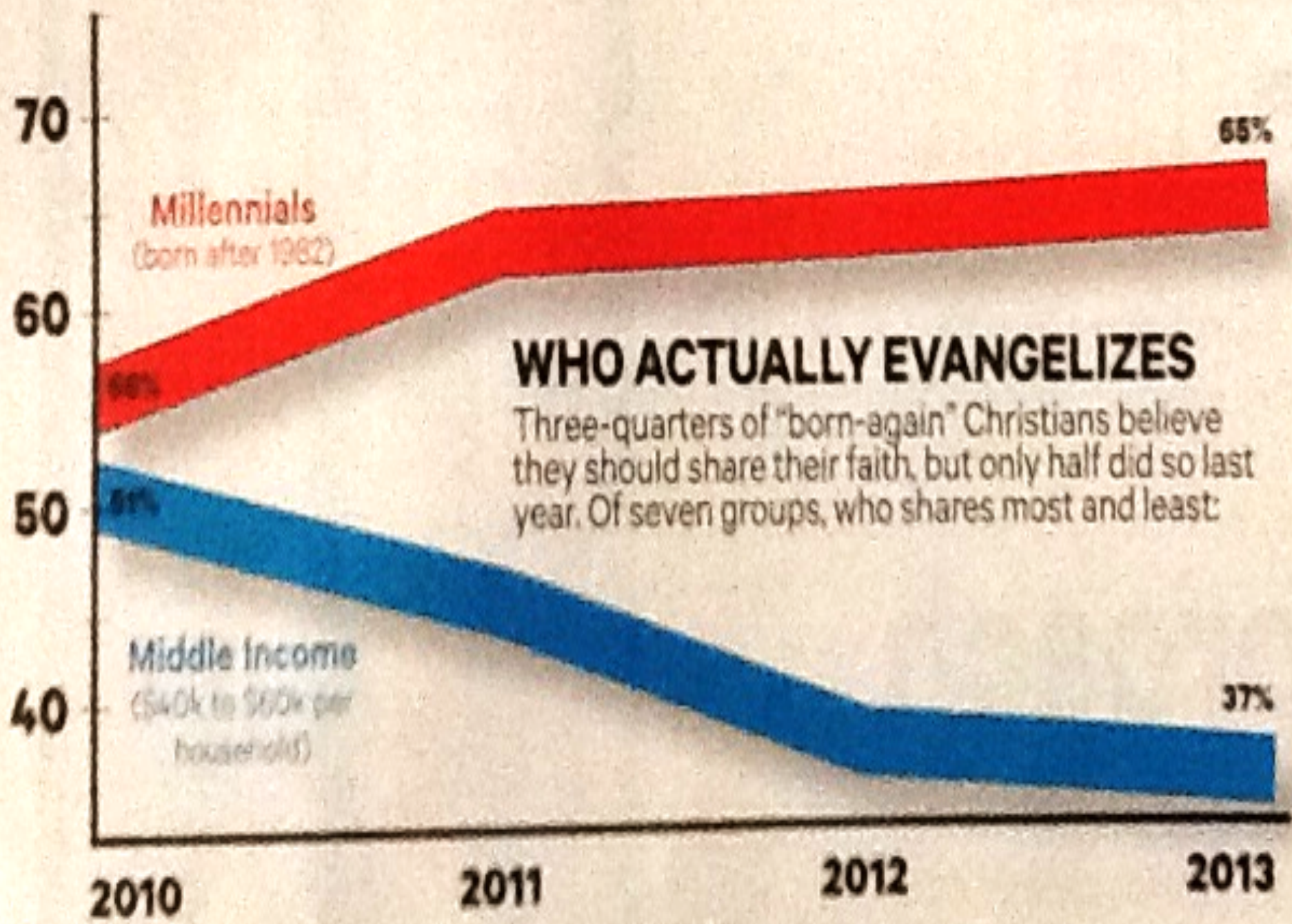

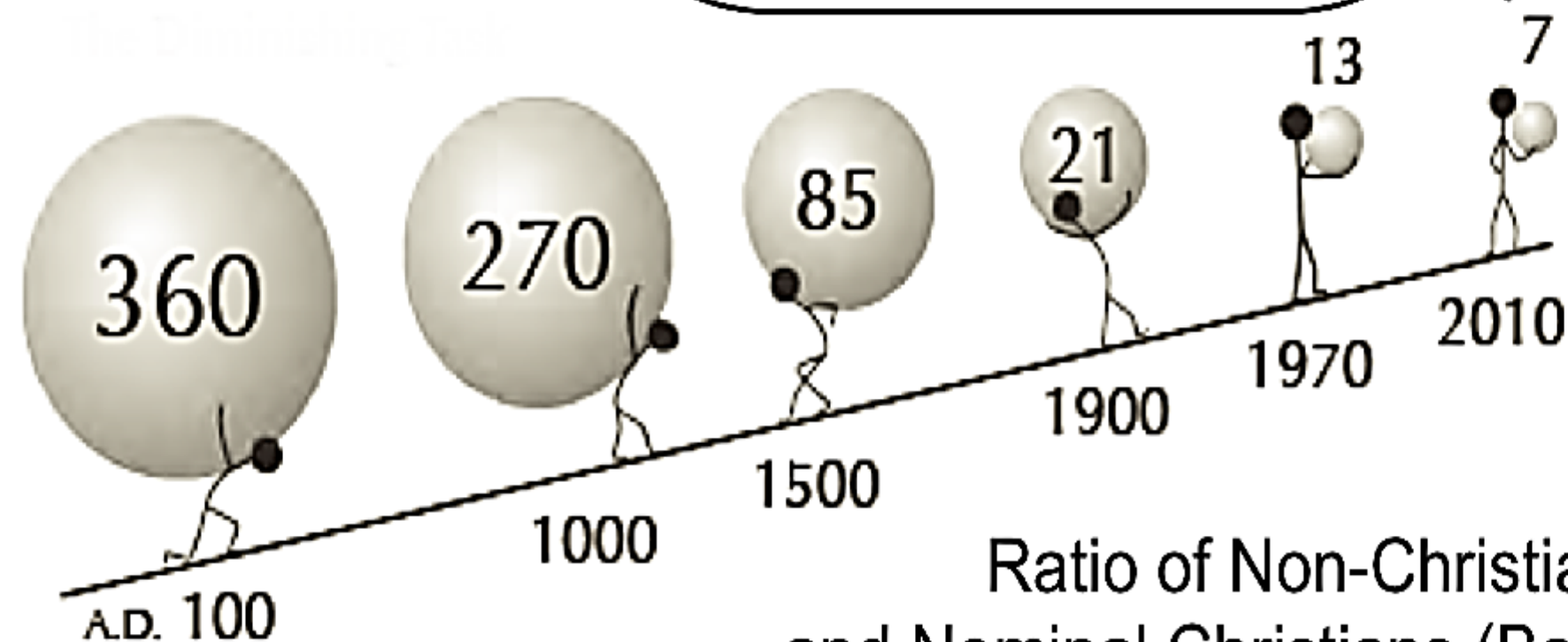
How many “ethnos” are there?

- 17,300 estimated people groups worldwide
- 7250 estimated unreached* people groups (41.9%)
- Population in Unreached Groups:
3,400,000,000 (42.2%)

*unreached = less than 2% evangelical, or less than 5% Christians of any kind

Remarkable Growth

For every practicing Christian there are only seven non-Christians or nominal Christians.

The World in 10 People

If we were to use 10 people to represent the world's population, the state of Christianity would look something like this:



Jesus? – He is my Lord and Savior.

ONE person (10%) would be a true follower of Jesus.

Jesus? – He is a nice teacher, but I want to do my own thing.

TWO people (20%) might call themselves Christians, but their obedience to Jesus is doubtful.

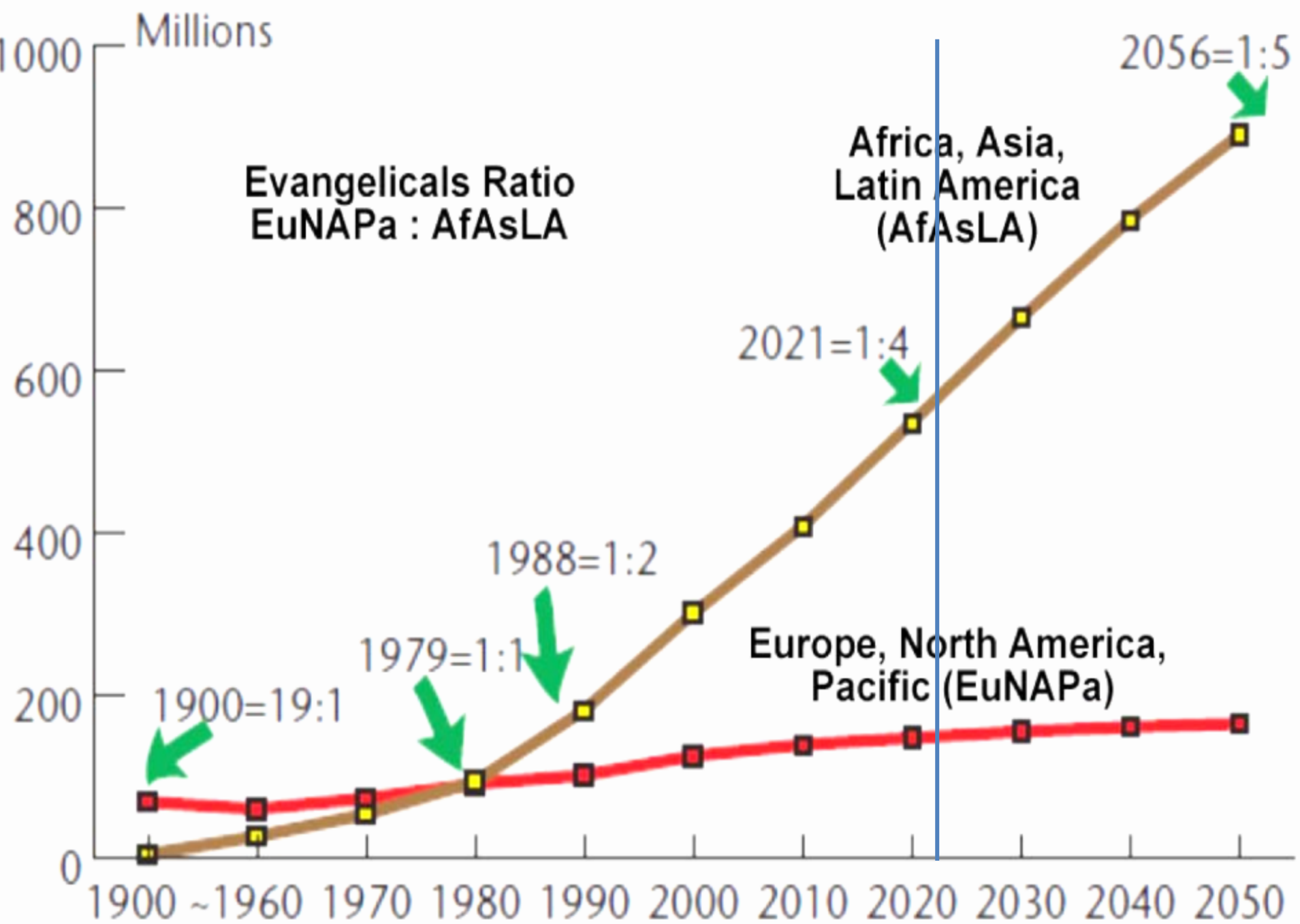


Jesus? – No thank you.

FOUR people (40%) have some access to the gospel, but they have not yet responded.

Jesus? – Who is that?
The last THREE people (30%) have virtually no access to the gospel.
