God Intends Us to Live Out of Fullness

- Fullness of grace John 1:16 And from His fullness we have all received grace after grace
- Fullness of hope Rom. 15:13,14 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope.
- Fullness of the fruit of righteousness Phil. 1:11 ... filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

- Fullness of the goodness of the Lord Jer. 31:14 I will feast the soul of the priests with abundance, and my people shall be satisfied with my goodness, declares the Lord
- Fullness of the knowledge of God in wisdom and understanding Col. 1:9 And so, from the day we heard, we have not ceased to pray for you, asking that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding...

- Fullness of joy 1 Peter 1:8 Though you have not seen Him, you believe in Him and rejoice with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory...
- Fullness of peace NASB Phil 4:6, 7 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus

• Fullness of love - Eph. 3:17b – 21 NASB - ... that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints, what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up to all the fullness of God...

• Fullness of the Spirit – Eph. 5:18 NASB – And do not get drunk with wine ... but be filled with the Spirit.

God Intends Us to Engage Out of the Overflow of His Fullness

• Colossians 2:6, 7, 9, 10 - As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving... For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily, and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power.

 Ephesians 1:22, 23 – And He put all things under His feet and gave Him as head over all things to the church, which is His body; the fullness of Him who fills all in all (everything in every way) • Ephesians 4:11-13 (NKJV) – And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying (building up) of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ...

 Haggai1:6 – You have sown much, and harvested little. You eat, but you never have enough; you drink, but you never have your fill. You clothe yourselves, but no one is warm. And he who earns wages does so to put them into a bag with holes.

Fullness is Not Based on How We Feel

• Luke 1:53 – He has filled the hungry with good things, and the rich He has sent away empty.

Invitation to be Filled

- •Ps. 81:10 I am the Lord your God, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt. Open your mouth wide, and I will fill it.
- •Ps. 107:9 For He satisfies the longing soul, and the hungry soul He fills with good things.
- •Matt. 5:6 Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied (filled)

•Is. 55:1 – 3a - Come, everyone who thirsts, come to the waters; and he who has no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without price. Why do you spend your money for that which is not bread, and your labor for that which does not satisfy? Listen diligently to me, and eat what is good, and delight yourselves in rich food.
