1 Corinthians 13:8-13

Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away. For we know in part and we prophesy in part, but when completeness comes, what is in part disappears. When I was a child, I talked like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. - Transformed to make a thorough or dramatic change in character or condition.
- External following the rules
- Internal changed thinking in a changed heart

Ephesians 4:17-24

So I tell you this, and insist on it in the Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their thinking. They are darkened in their understanding and separated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them due to the hardening of their hearts. Having lost all sensitivity, they have given themselves over to sensuality so as to indulge in every kind of impurity, and they are full of greed.

That, however, is not the way of life you learned when you heard about Christ and were taught in him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus. You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

5 Unhealthy Mindsets That Inhibit Our Spiritual Growth

- 1. Focusing on the external
 - 1. 1 Samuel 16:7-But the Lord said to Samuel, "Do not consider his appearance or his height, for I have rejected him. The Lord does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart."
- 2. Giving God our leftovers
- 3. Trusting in my own strength
 - 3. Psalm 127:1-Unless the Lord builds the house, the builders labor in vain. Unless the lord watches over the city, the guards stand watch in vain.

- 4. Failing to learn from hardships
 - 4. James 1:2-3-Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance.
- 5. Waiting to be perfect to respond to God's call

Transformed Mindsets

- Focused on internal
- Giving to God from our first fruits
- Trusting God
- Learning from trials and hardships
- Obeying God and trusting Him to lead and guide us
