PSALM 23 (NLT)

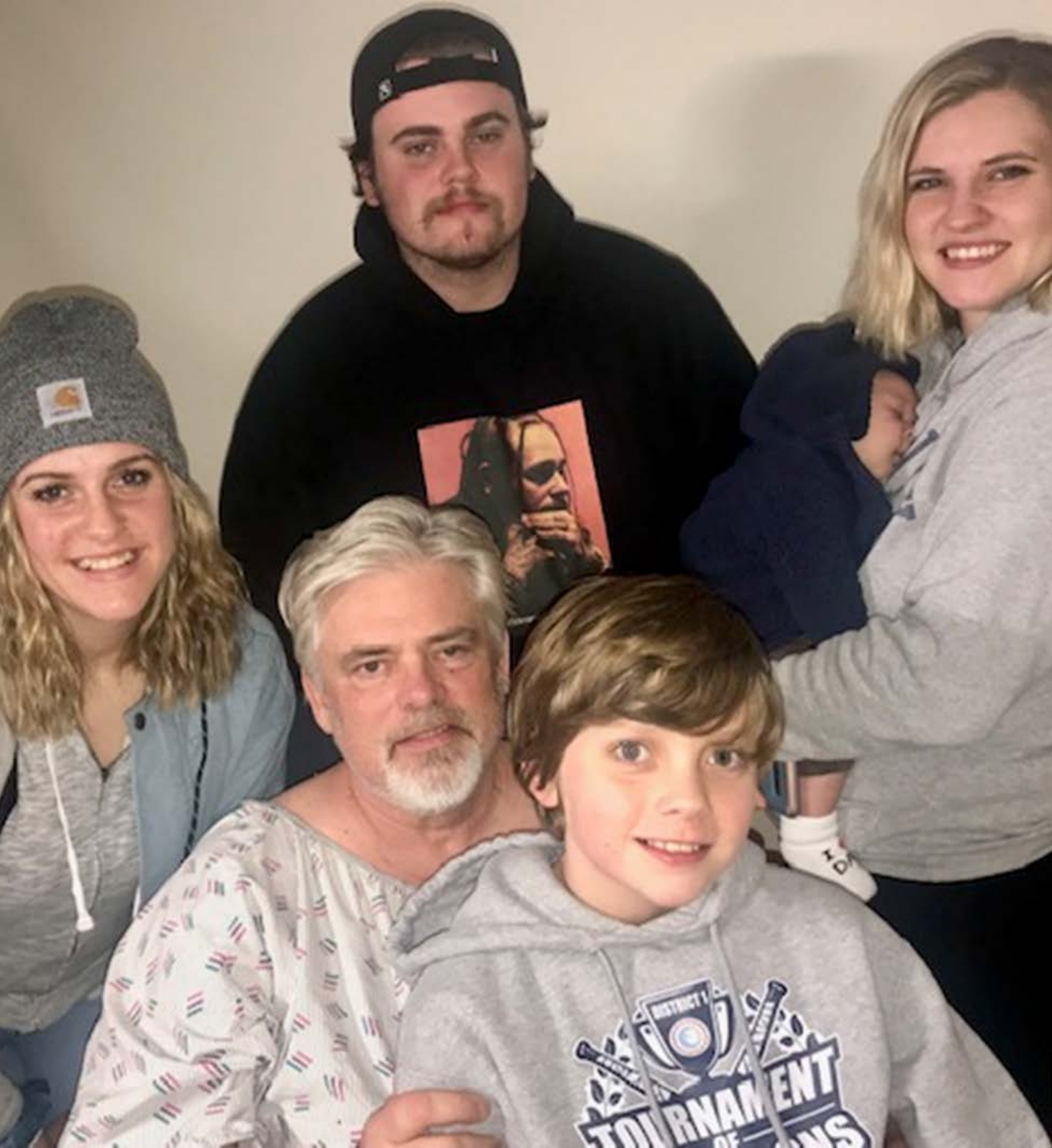

ROD AND STAFF COMFORT:

- **Staff:** something to lean on or rest on
