**“Dwell” – to inhabit, remain,
settle as a permanent place
of residence**

DEFINITION

**“Shelter” – a covert,
secret place; a hiding place
of protection; a sanctuary**

You preserve me from
trouble; You surround me
with songs of deliverance**



DEFINITION

Elyon – transcendent God of all
majesty who cannot be rivalled –
high above every other power
