Proverbs 3:5-6

5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; 6 in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.

Hebrew Meaning

- Trust- put confidence in, find refuge in.
- Heart- inner part, Soul or conscience.
- Lean- rely, rest, trust in.
- Direct- to make right, smooth or straight.
- Paths- way of living.

Psalm 20:6-8

6 Now this I know: The Lord gives victory to his anointed. He answers him from his heavenly sanctuary with the victorious power of his right hand. 7 Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the Lord our God. 8 They are brought to their knees and fall, but we rise up and stand firm.

Practical Ways to Trust God

- 1- don't be self-reliant
- 2- surrender to Him
 - Psalm 55:16-17 As for me, I call to God, and the Lord saves me. 17 Evening, morning and noon I cry out in distress, and he hears my voice.
- 3- put God first
- 4- evaluate ourselves through His word
- 5- be sensitive to the Holy Spirit
 - John 14:26 26 But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.
