Five Biggest Peace Stealers

1. **WORRY-** obsessing about health, my family's choices, the economy, education and wars.
2. **FEAR-** What ifs, kids, marriage, health, harm or danger.
3. **SHAME-** bad choices, bad things happened to me, I failed, I quit too early and character flaws.
4. **REGRET-** I should have been a better____. I should have listened. I wish I could do it all over again.
5. **BUSYNESS-** I am so busy. I don't even have time to rest. I am burdened by everything that is happening in my life.

Matthew 14:25-33 NKJV

Now in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went to them, walking on the sea. ²⁶ And when the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, “It is a ghost!” And they cried out for fear. ²⁷ But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, “Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid.” ²⁸ And Peter answered Him and said, “Lord, if it is You, command me to come to You on the water.” ²⁹ So He said, “Come.” And when Peter had come down out of the boat, he walked on the water to go to Jesus.

Fear- John 14:27 NKJV

**Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you;
not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not
your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.**

Fear- Psalms 34:4-7 NKJV

I sought the Lord, and He heard me, And delivered me from all my fears. ⁵ They looked to Him and were radiant, And their faces were not ashamed. ⁶ This poor man cried out, and the Lord heard him, And saved him out of all his troubles. ⁷ The angel of the Lord encamps all around those who fear Him, And delivers them.

Shame- Romans 8:1 NKJV

Regret- Romans 8:28 NKJV

Busyness- Matthew 11:28-30 NKJV
