## **FEEDING TROUGH:**

Jesus said in John 6:48-51 "I am the bread of life. Your ancestors ate the manna in the wilderness, yet they died. But here is the bread that comes down from heaven, which anyone may eat and not die. I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats this bread will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world."

Sheep herding was a hereditary occupation, and generations of shepherds were trained to care for these <u>special lambs</u>. ... The newborn lambs would be wrapped tightly... swaddled... in specially designated temple cloths, and they would be laid in a manger to keep them contained while they were being examined for blemishes.

WHAT ARE THE SPECIAL LAMBS?

The lambs without blemish used for sacrifice to atone for their sins.

**EXPECTED END:** Hope, expectation


"Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart."
