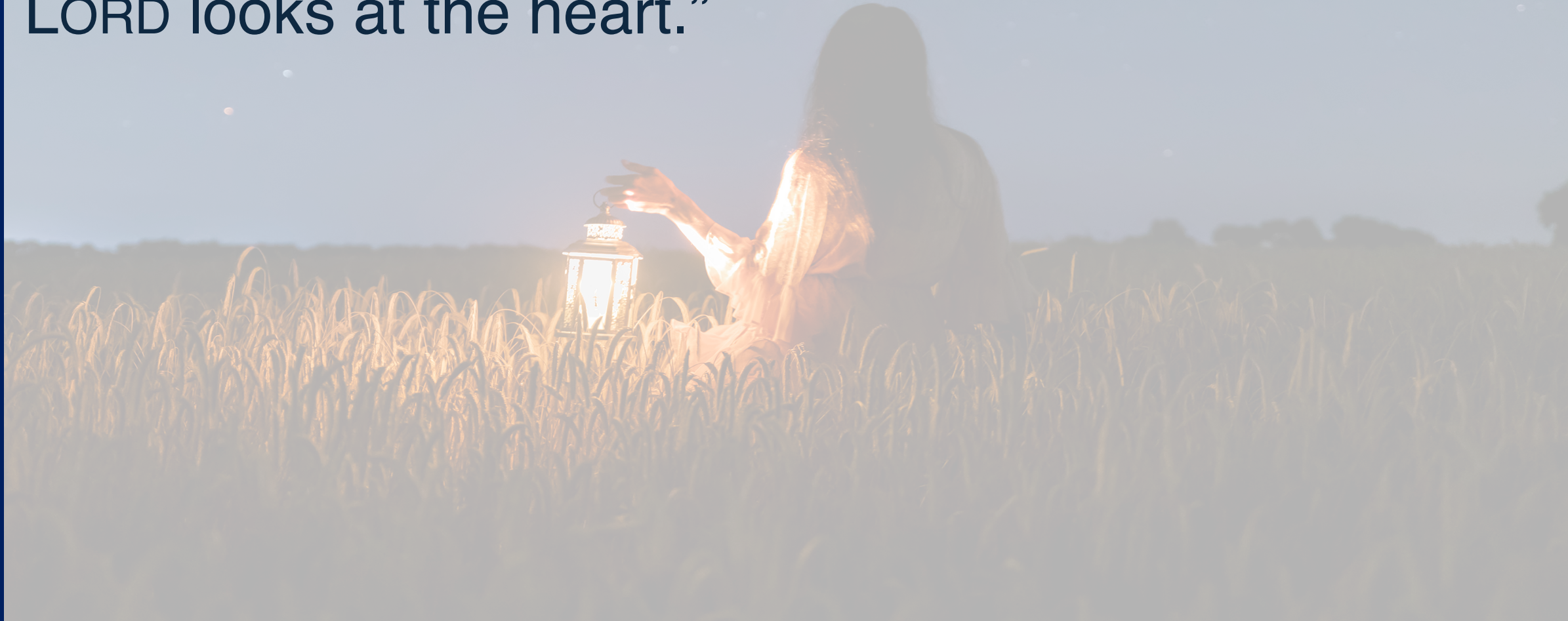

Areas to Change:

1. Changing our prayers from what we need to prayers of knowing the Lord more deeply.

James 1:22
4. Wanting God's peace but trying to control the outcome.

5. Spending Time with God but not inviting Him fully into our hearts.

Legalism - ignoring God's grace with adherence to rules and laws rather than the intent of the laws.

Mysticism - focusing on private experiences and angel worship rather than acknowledging Christ as fully sufficient.
