How would you describe the difference between God's contribution to our salvation and our contribution to our salvation in this passage?

**EQUIPPING**: How do we live this out?



What is the difference between seeing the gospel as "good news" instead of as "good advice?"
ACCOUNTABILITY: How am I personally doing in this area?
Donnie said, "The Gospel is not "keep the rules so that God will love you, the gospel is, "keep the rules because God so loves you!" Have you ever felt in your relationship with God that you were less loved when you were less obedient, or more loved when you were acting more morally?
How is that mindset contrary to the gospel, and how can we remind ourselves that it is a lie?
MISSION: Going out with the Gospel
Who in your life are you praying that God would raise from death to life?
