EQUIPPING: How do we live this out?

Based on 1 Peter 5:1-5, how would you describe how a good pastor should lead?

Based on Hebrews 13:17, how would you describe how a good church member should follow?

ACCOUNTABILITY: How am I personally doing in this area?

Do you find it difficult to submit to authority? How have you usually related to people in positions of leadership over you? Have you ever prayed for your leaders?

Every single one of us is susceptible to becoming divisive in our churches. If the enemy was successful in sowing seeds of division in your heart, what would that look like for you?

MISSION: Going out with the Gospel

How can a divisive person derail the mission of the church and impact the witness of the Gospel in a community?

SUPPLICATION: Praying for what only God can do

Ask God to help you have a heart that is surrendered first of all to Jesus as your chief shepherd, and secondly that encourages and respects the pastors in your life who are seeking to lead like Jesus.
