Read the scripture passage to familiarize yourself with the story. Dorcas (Tabitha) - Acts 9:36-42

Known for her compassion and selfless acts, Dorcas (Tabitha) dedicated her life to serving the poor and needy in Joppa. This inspiring tale of faith, love, and resurrection will remind you of the power of service and God's amazing grace.

Schedule:

Warm Up Question (3 min.):

What do you like to do when you have free time?

Giving Song (3 min.)

Bible Story (15 min.)

Preteach the story of Dorcas. Tell students that Dorcas was a lady who was very good at making clothes for people. She used her time to give to other people. She made clothes for people who could not afford to buy them from her.

Review questions:

- 1. Ask the kids what they remember from the story.
- 2. Why did Dorcas/Tabitha want to help people?
- 3. What did the people in the village do when Dorcas/Tabitha got sick?
- 4. How can you use your time to help others?

Time worksheet (5 min.)

Help the kids think of ways that they can use their time to serve God and help others. They can draw pictures or write out descriptions.

Bible verse review (5 min.)

Konnect: Divide group into teams and race to get the verse cards in the correct order.

Crosstown: Divide into two groups. Have the kids repeat the verse after you with motions.
