SUMMARY

As we continued in our series through the Gospel of John, Pastor Frank taught a message from John 8:48-59 entitled, "Vintage Humility". In this passage, we got see Jesus demonstrate His unwavering humility during a tense situation. In the end, we learned three important lessons about humility from Him.

- 1. Humility can be tough to define, but we all know it when we see it. In your own words, what is the essence of humility?
- 2. When you think of an example of someone who is truly humble, who comes to mind? Why do you consider them to be humble?
- 3. Pastor Frank shared three truths about humility from the life of Jesus. Of the three lessons shared, which one stood out to you the most? Why?
 - Humility is more powerful than pride (humble lions win the war)
 - Humility doesn't make of itself anything (humble lions can hold their roar)
 - Humility and boldness are not mutually exclusive (humble lions do roar)
- 4. The religious leaders had a lot of pride in the area of religion. What area of your life are you most prone to exhibit pride?
- 5. Though we each lean towards pride, what practical step can you take this week to pursue humility?
